Boys Ranch Birthday Celebration Set for October 6-7

ATTENTION WILL FOCUS ON NEW AUTOMOTIVE CENTER

Sixteen years in the boy raising business. That's what the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch will be celebrating on October 6 and 7.

Following traditional patterns, the annual anniversary celebration will open on Saturday, October 6, with a horse show in the Boys Ranch arena.

The Clay Mavericks, riding club from Clay County, will be in charge as usual. The Mavericks built the arena originally and each year they have been putting on a top notch show that draws riding enthusiasts from a wide area.

On October 7 an Open House from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. will focus attention on the Minella Cameron Automotive Center which is one of the newest additions to the Boys Ranch complex. A large gift from the late Minella Cameron, of Orlando, provided a major portion of the financing.

Located adjacent to the fire station, the Automotive Center includes a modern auto mechanics shop, a small motor repair shop, an equipment shed for Ranch vehicles and a service center.

Ranchers working under the supervision of trained technicians learn how to service and repair a wide variety of vehicles ranging from small power mowers and minibikes, to trucks, tractors and buses.

Thus the boys receive valuable vocational training, and the Ranch saves money on auto repairs and servicing.

The schedule of activities for Sunday, October 7, will begin with an outdoor worship service at the horse show arena at 9:30 a.m. The horse show will continue through Sunday morning.

A free barbecue will be held on the banks of the Suwannee River at midday, on Saturday, October 6. The public is invited to attend all of the events, including the barbecue.

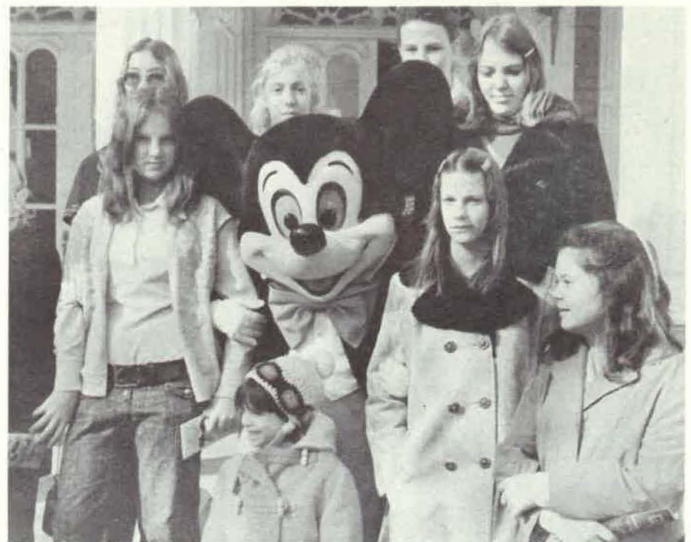

18 Inches From Trouble

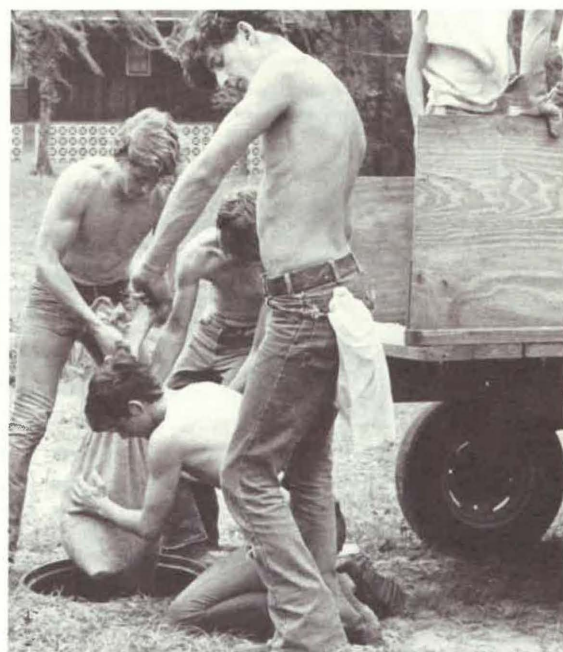
When the normally placid Suwannee River went on a rampage April 7, Ranchers and staff members spent many long hours sandbagging Boys Ranch facilities in an effort to prevent flood damage. Finally the flood crested at a record 57 feet, which was just 18 inches short of reaching the sewer treatment plant, the guest house, the cafetorium and the administration building.

Mention the flood and Ranchers will remember how tired their backs were after building a wall of sandbags around the sewage treatment plant.





The Suwannee River is normally about 300 yards away from, and about 57 feet lower than, the Boys Ranch guest house. When this picture was taken the flood waters were only a few feet away.



Flood waters backing up through large storm sewers created a lake that threatened to inundate the cafetorium. Emergency pumping failed to stop the rising water; but sandbags dropped through a manhole temporarily plugged the sewer line and solved the problem.

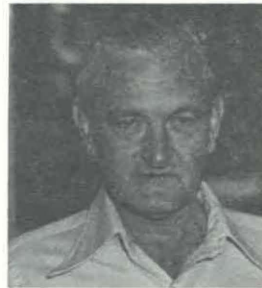

A Villa filly learns to cook and to sew, paint fences, do yard work, grow flowers and drive tractors.

After she masters these basics of domesticity, she can graduate to secretarial work, nursing and other vocational skills.

Work is not "kid stuff" here at this haven of human compassion. Staff members have developed a program designed to teach girls how to get and hold a job; the value of earning; and the fun of spending.

Each girl must apply for a job and submit a budget to show how much of her anticipated earnings she plans to put into savings, and how much she plans to spend for clothing, per-

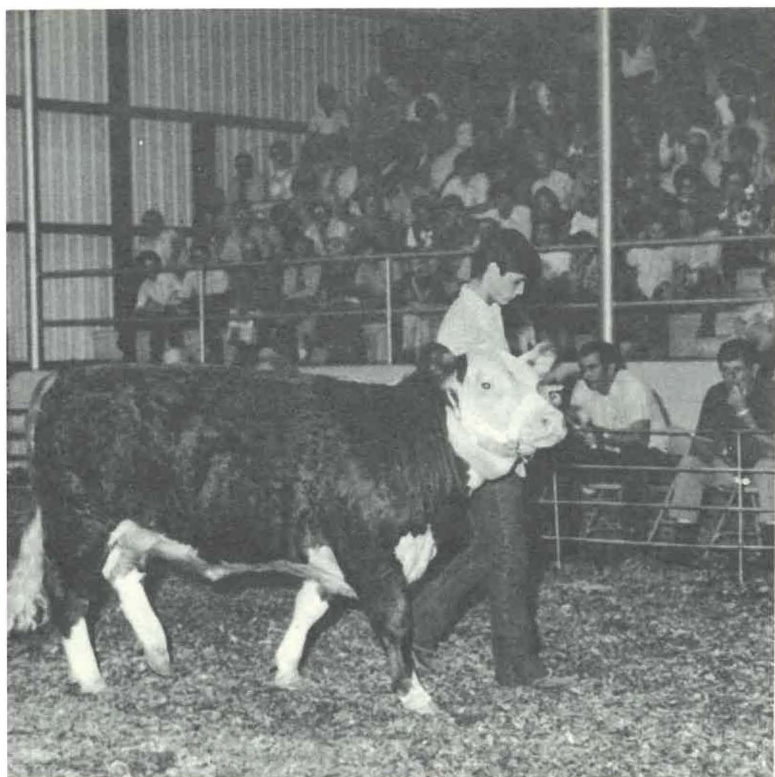


sonal items and recreation. These jobs are in addition to the normal daily chores of cooking, laundry and housework.

Each girl receives 50 cents an hour for a 15-hour work week. If she fails to do her job properly, she runs the danger of being fired. If she finds it necessary to quit her job, she must file a written resignation and give her supervisor sufficient advance notice.

These are the "facts of life" for every working girl, and our girls are being trained to face them. When they leave the Villa we want them to be self-sustaining and well prepared to cope with all eventualities.

It's always possible that a Villa graduate will marry a millionaire and never have to get involved in the working world, but her Villa training won't be wasted. She'll be fully qualified to supervise the servants and yard men on her estate.
