Ranch and Villa To Celebrate Anniversaries

It's birthday time again.

The Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch will celebrate its 17th Anniversary on October 5, and "little sister" The Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa will mark its fourth anniversary on August 25.

At the Ranch the celebration will include the traditional horse show staged by the Clay Mavericks, a Clay County riding club, in cooperation with the North Florida Horsemen's Club.

There will be an open house from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. for tours of Ranch facilities. Also, the traditional "Suwannee River" barbecue will be served at noon to all visitors.

The Villa Anniversary celebration, featuring an open house from 2 to 5 p.m., will be one of the highlights of a Bartow cele-

bration that runs for two weeks — from August 19 to September 2.

This well supported event is called the Bartow Girls Villa Classic, because it centers around golf and tennis tournaments, but it offers something for everyone including a Country-Western Show spotlighting George Jones and Tammy Wynette; a joint luncheon for civic clubs; a beauty pageant; a series of parties; an outdoor barbecue; and a ball featuring Danny Davis and the Nashville Brass.

When it's all over the entire community is likely to be in a state of happy exhaustion; and the Villa residents are likely to have a happy suspicion that somebody really cares.

It's a fun-filled celebration, but in three years it has also raised over \$30,000 for the Villa.







Survival on the Suwannee

Survival is mostly a matter of learning to cope with an empty stomach.

And that's rough for boys with hearty appetites, but 11 boys from the Ranch, accompanied by two adult leaders, survived for 2½ days completely isolated from hamburger stands, Coke machines, candy bars and other civilized necessities.

They traveled some 80 miles down the still wild and unspoiled Suwannee River in canoes, taking no supplies with them and scrounging for food along the way.

Each boy was allowed a canteen of water, a length of fish line and one hook, a knife and one blanket.

The first day was a lark — until nightfall came and supper turned out to be blackberries, a few fish and some freshwater

There was a slight delay when a little black and white dog jumped into the water and swam after the canoes. He had to be rescued and put ashore.



clams. Mosquitoes tried to add to the boys' discomfort, but they were too tired to notice, and slept soundly under the stars on damp blankets.

The highlight of the second day came when they encountered some campers and stretched their survival code enough to accept a watermelon and a half-filled bag of potato chips. This, however, failed to quell rumblings of mutiny, accompanied by rumblings of empty stomachs.

Another night of mosquitoes and dreams of plum puddings, and then a short paddle to the town of Branford. They beached the canoes, summoned a final burst of strength to sprint to the nearest restaurant, and voted unanimously to terminate the trip.

Sometimes survival is just a matter of finding a good restaurant at the end of the trip.

First of all, most of them are parents and have children — and sometimes grandchildren — of their own.



This puts them on a par with other parents. And, a constant in-service training program gives them an opportunity to rise to higher levels of parental know-how.

Staff members also enroll in child care courses at the Vocational-Technical School level, and attend professional seminars.


In recent months Sam Jennings, Area Manager of Dale Carnegie Courses, conducted a workshop in human relations, confidence building and effective communication for staff members.



Jonathan Livingston Rancher



"A movie?"


"Yes. The cameraman was here a few days ago, and the movie is going to be finished in January. So, if you can't come to the open house, you can see the movie."

Villa offices are temporarily housed in this building while the administration building is being completed. Later this will be a staff residence.



ADMISSIONS STREAMLINED

When Ranch and Villa staff members held a workshop to find ways of streamlining admissions procedures, they came up with a simple "Request for Service" form as a first step alternative to filling out the long, detailed Ranch-Villa application form.

This will eliminate delays in getting help to children who need it, and it will also enable us to give applicants some indication of whether or not we can help them before putting them to unnecessary trouble and expense.

The "Request for Service" form will contain the basic information needed for a social worker to begin an investigation of the case. After a preliminary evaluation is made, the social worker will be in a better position to tell the family or guardians of the applicant whether they should go ahead with a physical examination, psychological work ups and other requirements of the formal application form.

As another means of speeding up processing of applicants, some future admissions will be made by means of a family-agency agreement, rather than by means of a court commitment. This will ease the burden on Sheriffs, the courts, and relatives of the applicant.
