To know the great joy of the Bethlehem shepherds,


it isn't necessary

Built at a cost of over \$100,000, Buena Vista Villa doubles our capacity from 8 to 16 girls.




Refreshments on the rain splashed atrium ended dedication festivities.

Circuit Court Judge Oliver Green, of Bartow, delivered the dedication address.








# *Interior Vistas at Buena Vista*



Because many years of planning and experience went into the building of Buena Vista Villa, newest residence cottage at the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, it is a model of comfort, convenience and efficiency. It's also a homey place, but the girls who live here are not pampered. They are required to learn basic domestic skills by doing their own laundry, cooking, baking and housework. These pictures were taken on August 26 during a public "open house" which preceded dedication ceremonies.





If our horses act unusually horsy, it's because they know how important they are.

This equine superiority complex is a sort of inherited thing that started back in 1958 when singer Elvis Presley and his manager, Col. Tom Parker, donated a pair of miniature ponies to the Ranch.

Those cute little devils were the first residents of the Ranch — nosing out the first boys by a few months — and ever since then gift horses and ponies have been coming to the Ranch by the hundreds from all over the state.

Our horse trailer has logged thousands of miles picking them up, and our boys have spent thousands of boy-hours grooming them, riding them — and yes, loving them.

Let's face it, horses are important in the success scheme of

the Boys Ranch.

Caring for them teaches boys responsibility.

Riding them is fun.

Entering them in horse shows is the best way we know to build up a boy's confidence and self-assurance.

We welcome them as gifts, but there is one problem . . . we can't possibly afford to keep all of the horses and ponies that are donated.

We try to maintain about 25 horses and ponies for the boys' pleasure and training, and we continually try to upgrade the quality of our herd. Consequently when a new horse is received, we let the boys try it, and if they like it better than one we already have, we keep the new one and sell another.

This enables us to limit the herd to a number we can afford to feed and care for properly; and the sale of excess horses helps the income of the Ranch.

We can accept an animal only if the donor fully understands that the gift is complete and unconditional. The care and possible future disposition of the animal must be left to the discretion of the Ranch.

Due to limited space for stables and pasture, the Girls Villa will be able to keep only a small number of horses and ponies. Therefore, we cannot accept animals specifically designated for the Villa. Horses for the Villa will be provided from the Boys Ranch herd as they are needed, and to the extent that the Villa is able to properly care for them.


We do want and we do appreciate gift horses; and we never say neigh to them, as long as they come to us "with no strings attached."

Injuries are bound to happen in an active program such as ours with its wide variety of outdoor work and recreation.

And then there's that streak of daring — that willingness to try anything once — running through the make up of most boys, and we wouldn't want to wipe that out entirely, even if we could.


The best we can hope to do is put reasonable restraints on adventuresome spirits, without stunting the development of some future explorer, aerialist or astronaut.

Hope springs eternal, even when a boy is on crutches. This one is looking at the daily schedule to see what sport he can participate in.




Which boy had the broken leg? Our photographer said it was the one on the left, and the other one seemed to be just faking it for the fun of it.




The traditional anniversary barbecue was served on the banks of the Suwannee River at noon, October 6; and an outdoor worship service was held in the arena on Sunday, October 7.


