New Youth Fund Movie to be Released in 1984

Youth Camp in High Gear Following a Fast Start

Although it is less than one year old, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp is now in high gear with a wilderness camping program and a summer camping program running simultaneously.

Located 14 miles north of DeLand on the fringe of the Ocala National Forest, the camping venture became a reality on November 17, 1982, when the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund purchased Camp Ticochee, a 132-acre Girl Scout reservation. Renovation work began immediately, and was followed by the hiring of a professional staff, acquisition of 22 additional acres, the launching of a wilderness type program early in May, dedication ceremonies on May 22, and the opening of the summer camping program on June 13.

While the summer camp is in session, the youngsters assigned to the year 'round wilderness program will be "on the road" to participate in varied camping experiences at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, and also at the newly-purchased site of a future Youth Ranch and Youth Camp in South Florida.

Pictured on this page are scenes from the opening day of the summer camping program which is expected to enroll some 500 boys and girls this year.

Camp is "Tremendous Challenge" Genung Tells Dedication

During dedication rites on May 22, former Sheriff Don Genung described the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp as "a tremendous challenge to every Sheriff in the State of Florida, as well as to the staff of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund."

And Genung, who has logged some 25 years of superb fund raising for the network of child care projects now operated by the Youth Fund, should know a challenge when he sees one.

Genung recalled that the Youth Fund got into the camping business in 1981 "as a means of reshaping the lives of dependent, neglected and homeless youngsters.

"It was a modest beginning," he said. "Some tents were pitched at the Boys Ranch and a few Youth Fund and Boys Ranch employees were diverted from their regular duties to head up a temporary staff. Deputy sheriffs, junior deputies and explorer scouts were recruited as counselors.

"Forty boys were enrolled in two one-week camping sessions. They swam and played games. They watched deputy sheriffs demonstrate law enforcement skills and techniques. They learned to love outdoor living.

"The officials also learned a thing or two. They discovered that camping not only provided wholesome recreation, but also fostered friendly relations between youngsters and law enforcement officers. They saw troubled kids developing desirable attitudes and casting aside the hostilities they had for-

merly harbored toward people with badges.

"In 1982, two hundred and fifty-six boys and girls attended eight one-week sessions of our camping program.

"Now, today, as we gather here on this 154-acre site of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp, our Florida Sheriffs and their Association, and the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund have plans for some 500 youngsters to attend a number of ten-day camping programs throughout the summer, with special attention to a wilderness program that will house 30 girls and 30 boys in separate programs to be operated throughout the year.

"This is a tremendous challenge to every Sheriff in the State of Florida, as well as to the staff of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. As one Sheriff stated: 'My desire to work with troubled youth has been strengthened. How could it be otherwise when a boy tells me I'm like the dad he never had?'"

Oldtimers Gather to Dedicate a Building in Memory of Don McLeod

Some oldtimers got together at the Boys Ranch May 23, to dedicate a building in memory of the late Don McLeod, former Marion County Sheriff and Director of the Florida Sheriffs Bureau.

The ceremony was low key, and the building itself was not the most impressive on the Boys Ranch campus (it was a metal warehouse that had been refurbished as a maintenance building), but the lack of ostentation would have suited the gruff Scotchman to a T.

The speeches and crowds that usually accompany a Boys Ranch dedication were oddly missing, but how much more fitting it was that friends traveled from many parts of the state to pay tribute to a man whose real breadth and depth and hidden sentiments were known only to those who were close to him.

There were six former Sheriffs in the group, including Ed Blackburn, Jr., who had been one of McLeod's closest friends, and who had also been a co-conspirator with this very private and complex man in the founding of the Boys Ranch.

Blackburn talked about those days, and so did John A. Madigan, Jr., the Florida Sheriffs Association's

General Counsel. Madigan had been the legal advisor, arbitrator and "anchor man" in a volatile quartet that included McLeod, Blackburn and the late Sheriff and State Senator John Spottswood. Madigan reminisced about this unlikely coterie — one that sometimes thrived on shouting matches and the clashing of strong wills, but nevertheless played a big role in nurturing the Boys Ranch from dream to reality.

Berwin Williams, Executive Director of the Florida Sheriffs Association, added his recollections to the melange of memories. He became a special agent of the infant Florida Sheriffs Bureau under McLeod when the staff was too small to field a baseball team, janitor and secretaries included.

In time, as the Bureau grew and became a highly respected law enforcement agency, Williams became one of its top officials. He was privy to the skills of McLeod the administrator, and also a close associate.

Others aired their memories of McLeod while looking at pictures and articles from the Boys Ranch archives.

The oldtimers ate catfish in the Boys Ranch cafeteria, toured the McLeod building, rehashed a few "war stories," told some jokes, and then went their separate ways. It was a brief encounter, but for a few hours they had shared their memories of a man who, although he never had any children of his own, harbored a fierce determination to build a better life for the unfortunate offspring of others.

THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH FUND IS . . .



A charitable, non-profit corporation, sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, to manage and operate the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, Youth Camp, and any other Youth programs that might later be developed by the Florida Sheriffs Association. An important function of the Youth Fund is the raising, receiving, budgeting, and disbursing of funds for its programs. The Youth Fund and its programs are supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts. Gifts and bequests can be made to the Youth Fund for the exclusive benefit of any single program, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, or Youth Camp, or they may be made without restriction; to be distributed among existing programs as most needed or to be used for the development of new programs at the discretion of the Governing Board. BOYS RANCH IS . . .

A residential group child care program for dependent, neglected, or homeless boys between the ages of eight and eighteen. It is not an institution for juvenile delinquents. The Boys Ranch is sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. It was founded in 1957 and currently has approximately 108 boys in residence at any given time. The Boys Ranch is located in North Florida, about half-way between Jacksonville and Tallahassee and nine miles north of the town of Live Oak on County Road 795.

YOUTH RANCH IS . . .

The most recently developed residential group child care program of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. Also sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, it was founded in 1976 and opened in 1978. It is located just east of the intersection of the McMullen-Booth Road and County Road 102 near Clearwater, Florida. The Youth Ranch has approximately 30 boys and girls in residence at any given time. It provides care in a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are dependent, neglected, or homeless. Mailing address and telephone number are the same as for the Youth Fund.

GIRLS VILLA IS . . .

A similar program for girls located two miles east of Bartow, Florida, on Route 60. Originally conceived by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce of Madeira Beach, Florida, the Girls Villa was adopted as a project of the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1970. The first buildings were completed and the first girls admitted in 1972. There are approximately 50 girls in residence at any given time. Mailing address and telephone number for the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch are the same as for the Youth Fund.

YOUTH CAMP IS . . .

A Youth Fund operated camping facility which incorporates a summer program and a year-around wilderness program for boys and girls. The 154-acre campsite is located one mile northeast of Barberville. Campers are normally selected from among boys and girls who have had Requests for Service submitted to the Youth Fund on their behalf. Many of these youngsters are already on the waiting list for admission to Youth Fund residential facilities. The camping program was initiated in 1981 and acquired its present location in late 1982. Beginning with the birth of the Boys Ranch in 1957, the Youth Fund has piled up quite a record of dreams that have come true — the Girls Villa in 1970, the Youth Ranch in 1978, the Youth Camp in 1982, and so many other good things that were transformed from fantasy to reality with the help of God and a lot of good friends.

The magic is still with us — another long-standing dream has now entered the realm of feasible reality. We now have the opportunity to establish Youth Fund programs in South Florida and to bring Youth Fund services closer to the many youth and families in that area who need them.

On June 1, the Youth Fund acquired a 3,709-acre tract of land in Martin County, formerly known as Shannon Farms and located just a few miles northeast of Indiantown. The property is suitable for develop-

ment of a Youth Ranch and a Youth Camp, including a wilderness program. It also has the potential for development of certain productive enterprises which would help raise needed funds.

We have been dreaming the South Florida dream for a long time and, for the past two years, an active search for property has been under way. The establishment of childcare facilities near the communities from which our boys and girls are referred makes it much easier to maintain contact and work with their families, thus enhancing the helping process. The youngsters themselves are normally more comfortable being in residential care if they are not moved too far from family and familiar surroundings.

We are not able, at this time, to give you a timetable for the development of the new South Florida facilities, but you may be sure that we will begin development of them as quickly as funds become available for construction and staffing.

We urge you to share this new opportunity and challenge with us, just as you have always been such an important part of making dreams come true for the Youth Fund and the children it serves.

The young man you sent me (for a visit) is no longer the hurting, mixed-up, confused, misled, resentful child I once knew. I can talk with this young man. He told me about his life on the Ranch, and we talked about him coming here to live. We even had a family council about that. All of us want Bart with us here. I feel a new town, new people, a different way of life, a family with God as their leader, a new chance . . . I think we could all use that in our lives sometimes.

Gentlemen, I want — as any parent should — all I can get for all my children. I'm asking for a second chance for my son and for me. I love my son and I want to be with him.

The Lord said of Jesus, “This is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased.” (Matthew 3:17) I know of no other words that could express my feelings better.
