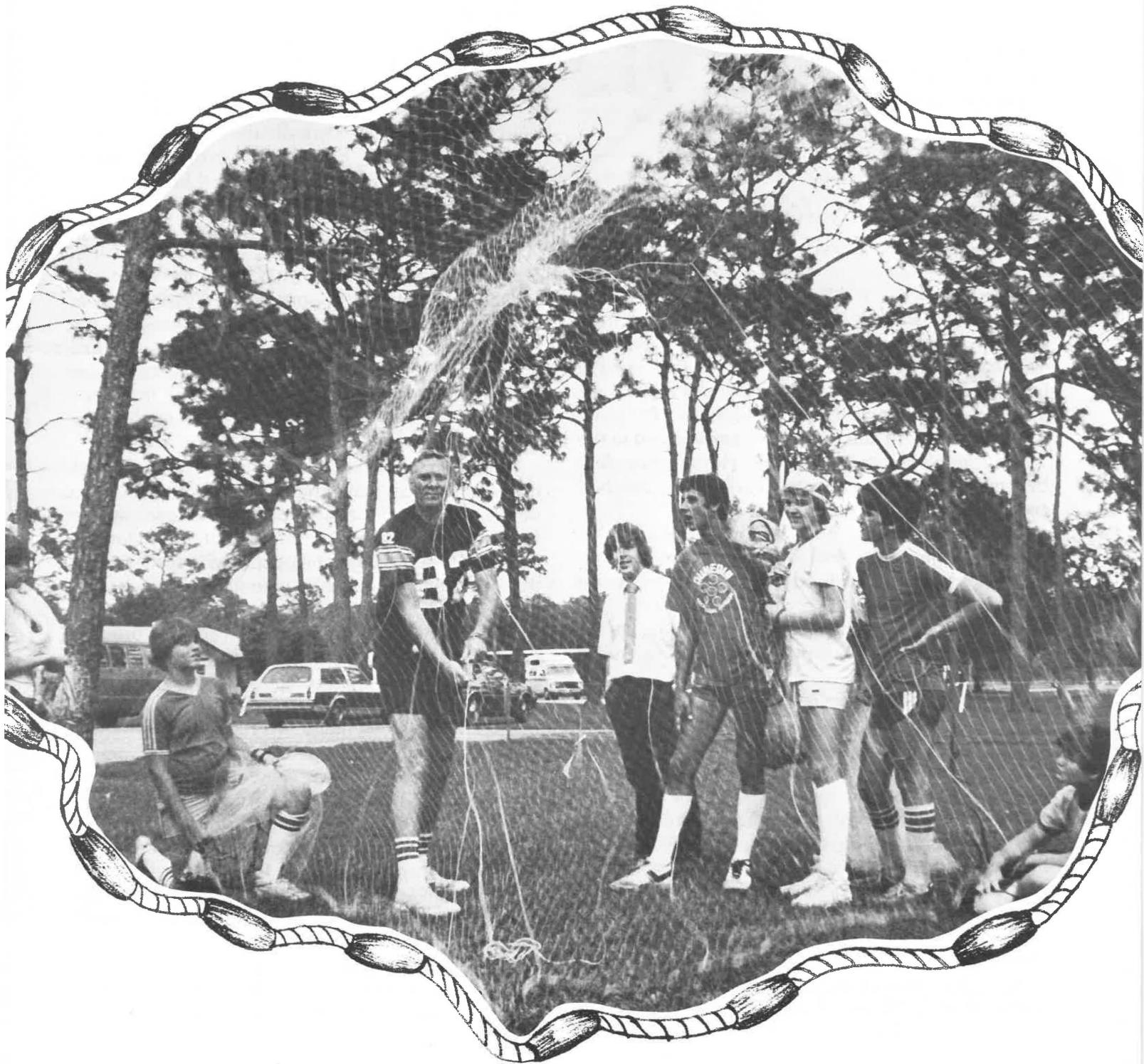

Planning Today for Tomorrow's Children

Since 1959, when the Boys Ranch accepted its first boys, a thousand boys have spent a part of their young lives there and have been helped. More than 400 other young people — boys and girls — have benefited from the residential programs at the Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, and Wilderness Program. Another thousand and more have participated in the Youth Camp's summer programs. Home counseling by Youth Fund Family Social Workers has touched countless other lives.

It goes on without end. We help the troubled young people who come to us to the limits of our capability, and we do a good job, but there are always more — thousands more — who need our help. Our operating costs continue to escalate while, at the same time, fund raising is becoming more challenging.

Does it sound like we're ready to give up? Don't you believe it. As long as there are boys and girls in Florida needing help, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund will continue striving to provide it. What is needed at this point, however, is some planning for the future and some positive action to help secure the future for the benefit of those boys and girls who will be needing our services in years to come.

Toward this end, the Youth Fund has recently established a permanent endowment fund. This is nothing unusual. Colleges, universities, numerous child care programs throughout the country, and other types of organizations have them. We have always tried to set aside funds for emergencies, but we have never had a permanent endowment. We feel that it is very important that we begin building one now.

The Youth Fund has always stretched itself to care for as many boys and girls as possible and without any guaranteed source of income. It gets a little scary sometimes, because the costs of child care are con-

sistently on an upward trend while charitable giving can fluctuate dramatically from one year to the next. Think of us as a big family with all of the usual family expenses and then some, but with no regular paycheck. When you don't know what your financial resources will be, it is very difficult to make any commitments or projections for the future. The endowment will, in effect, provide "a salary" that we can pretty well count on, and the amount will grow as the fund grows. Our goal is to build the endowment fund to the extent that its earnings will eventually yield a substantial portion of our operational funding.

We hope that friends of the Youth Fund who are willing and able to make larger gifts will designate at least a portion of those gifts for the endowment fund. This will in no way lessen the need for all of our friends to continue supporting the Youth Fund as they have so generously in the past. Although, the endowment will eventually provide a regular source of income, it will never be sufficient to cover our operational budget. There will always be that need for people to care and share that is the very heart of the Youth Fund.

Whenever a worthwhile project is conceived, there are always champions who emerge to get things started. The champions of our endowment fund are Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Prescott, Jr. of Dunnellon. The Prescotts were the people who convinced us that we needed an endowment fund. Then they offered us a challenge. They gave us a \$200,000 gift to start our fund with the stipulation that, in order to keep it, we have to raise \$1,000,000 to go with it within a year. We accept the Prescott challenge with gratitude. We have faith in our friends and even in friends that we have yet to meet. We have no intention of giving back that very generous \$200,000 gift.

The first response to the Prescott's challenge came in a very unusual and heartwarming way. In April, Vito D. Petraitis walked into the office of Sheriff Pat Hartly, in Bronson. He informed the Sheriff that he was dying of cancer and that he wanted to leave his money to help young people. Sheriff Hartley contacted us and we sent one of our staff members to talk to him.

As the story unfolded, we learned that, as a young man, in Connecticut, Mr. Petraitis and a cousin of his attempted an armed robbery during which a grocery store manager was shot and killed. Convicted of murder, both he and his cousin were sentenced to death. The sentences were later commuted and Petraitis spent the next 17 years in prison.

Paroled in 1948, he worked as a baker, a trade he learned in prison. Throughout his productive years, he lived a life of self-imposed deprivation, saving his

money to "fulfill a dream" which was, in some way, to make amends for his crime by helping young people to avoid the mistakes that he had made.

Upon his retirement, in 1972, he moved to Bronson, Florida, taking up residence in a tiny trailer home and continuing his spartan existence.

After talking with Sheriff Hartley and a member of our staff, Mr. Petraitis had a will drawn up. Then, he set about to execute the provisions of that will while he was still living, because he wanted to see it happen.

On a day in June, he went to Sheriff Hartley's office and handed him a check for \$100,000 for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund's endowment fund. Although near death, he was a happy man, with only one further wish . . . to have his civil rights restored . . . to have the right to vote for the first time in his life. At present, a prisoner's civil rights are restored when they are released from prison, but such was not the case when Petraitis was incarcerated. An Executive Order from the Governor was required.

With the help of R. "Ed" Blackburn, Jr., former Sheriff of Hillsborough County, former State Legislator, and one of the founders of the Boys Ranch, who currently lives in Tallahassee, Mr. Petraitis' case was brought to Governor Graham's attention and expedited through the Cabinet (which sits as the Pardon Board in the State of Florida). The Executive Order restoring Mr. Petraitis' civil rights was issued on June 15, 1985. Mr. Petraitis was bedridden when the order was shown to him, and his response was a simple, but very meaningful, "Oh my!" On the evening of June 30, Vito D. Petraitis died. With the help of Sheriff

Hartley, he had made his peace with God. His dreams were fulfilled, and he was granted his wish to breathe his final breath at home in his little trailer.

We don't run into a Vito D. Petraitis every day. It's a most unusual kind of story. We are grateful that he chose the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund as the vehicle for his good work, and we were pleased that we could be a part of his life's fulfillment. Through his very generous gift to the endowment fund, his name and his kindness will always be remembered.

Cast net training begins on dry land . . .

Youngsters are being taught the “Creed of the Cast Net”

. . . and it goes something like this . . .

*A young'un will never be
Financially up the creek,
As long as he understands
The cast net mystique.*

If Fred E. “Mac” Stones is sentimental about cast nets — those venerable contraptions dear to the hearts of wade-and-throw fishermen — there’s a reason. Cast nets helped to provide his livelihood when he was attending Stetson University, and they have provided many hours of pleasure in later life.

Mac grew up on the Halifax River, at Daytona Beach, and earned money for college by catching and selling seafood. He became adept at spearing flounder and plugging for speckled trout with a lure and line. One summer he also went into commercial shrimping, selling his catch for one-cent apiece. But, through it all, his favorite piscatorial pursuit was using the cast net.

Perhaps the way it flared out in free-form symmetry, or the way its filaments flashed in the sunlight when he flung it out across the water, appealed to his poetic nature. Or . . . maybe he simply got a bang out

Whatever the reason, cast netting is a skill Mac has preserved and nurtured from his youth, and lately he has given it a measure of respectability by adding it to the recreational and vocational spectrum at the Youth Ranch.

Mac has been teaching the lore and lure of his specialty to the youngsters who are under his supervision, and the rationale seems to be that one never knows when one of these kids will hit a spell of hard times in future life. If that happens, the reasoning goes, cast netting could make the difference between getting by and getting on welfare.

Furthermore, cast netting is more fun than cutting grass or raking leaves. Anyone who isn't aware of that has failed to really study the pictures on these pages. They were taken during one of Mac's training sessions.

The object was to circle the bat without losing contact, and Clint Edwards, son of former Rancher Wally Edwards, mastered the technique (with a little coaching).



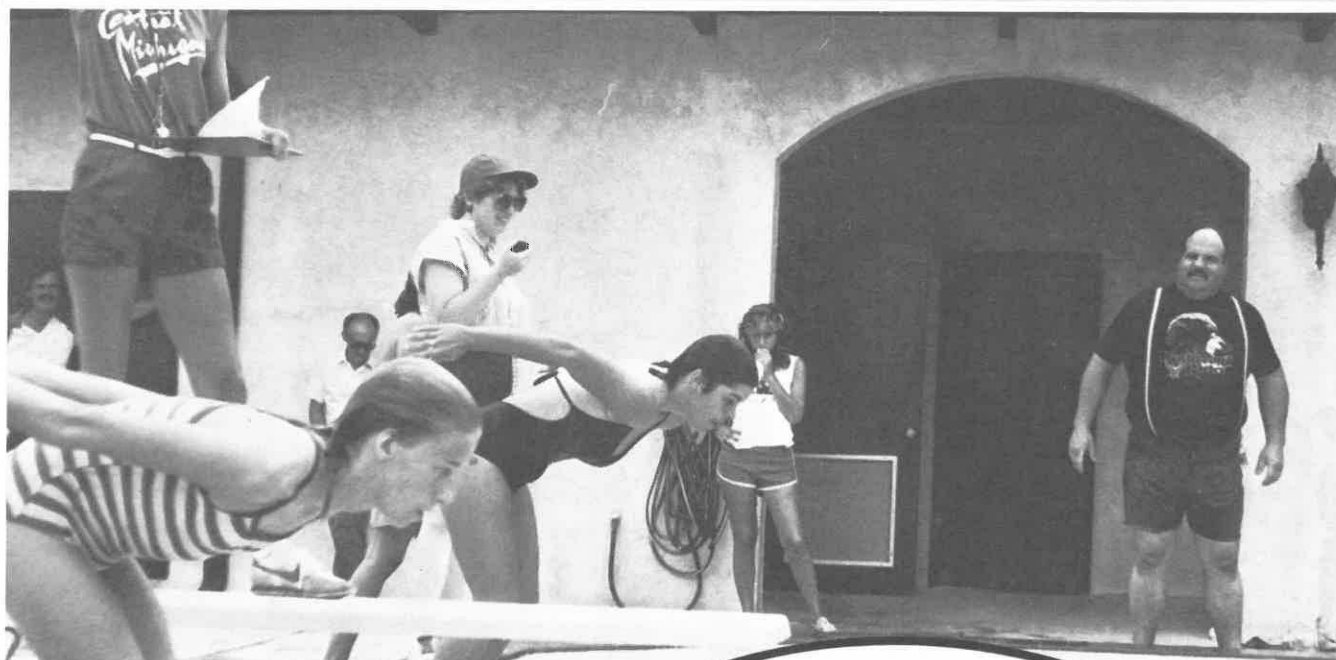

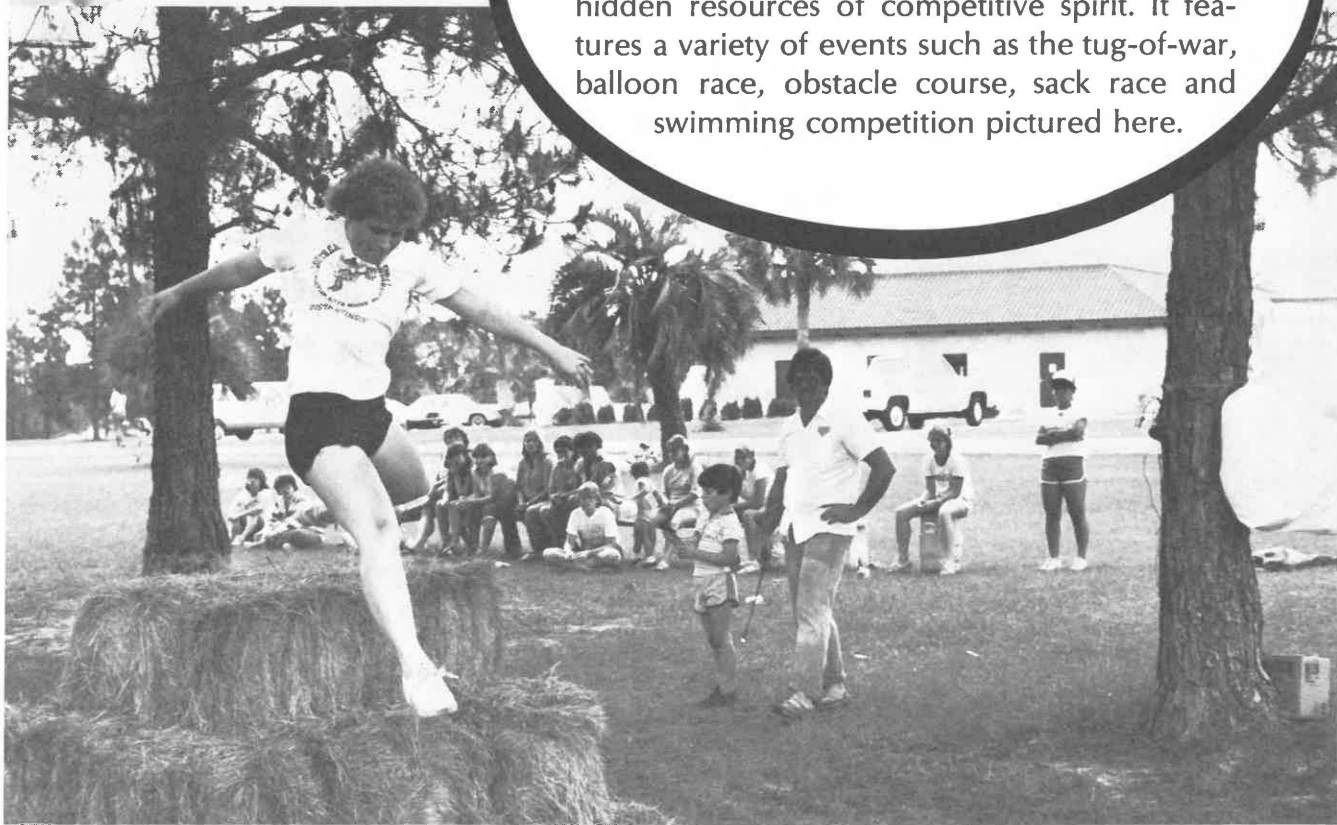

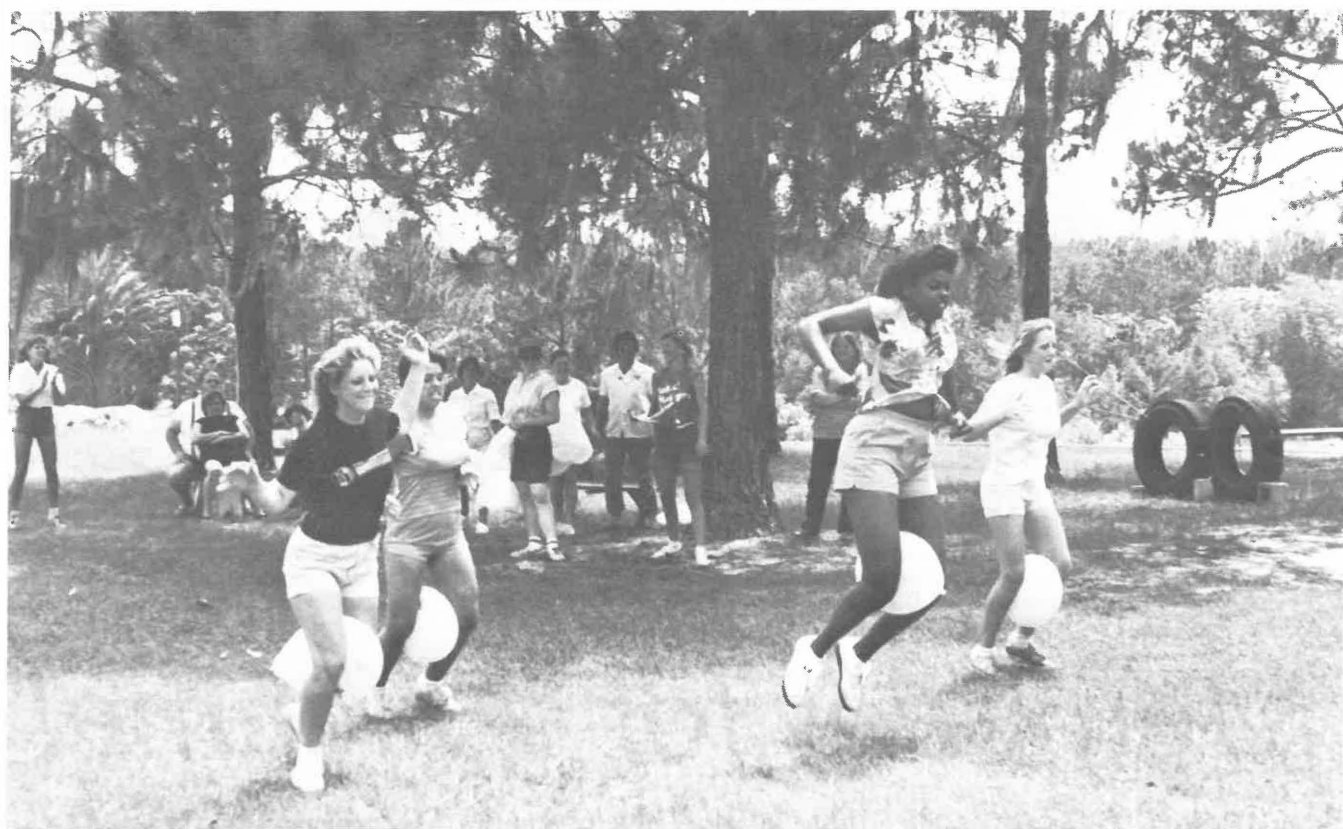




A time of keen competition

It offered them many unforgettable experiences and a wide range of enjoyable activities that included swimming, horseback riding, canoeing, archery, rifle marksmanship, arts and crafts, games and contests.

There were also unique opportunities to make friends with law enforcement officers in a casual setting. Many deputy sheriffs served as camp counselors. Others visited the camp to put on SWAT Team, K-9 and underwater rescue demonstrations.

Located near DeLand, the Youth Camp is operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund to serve neglected, underprivileged and troubled youngsters from all areas of Florida.

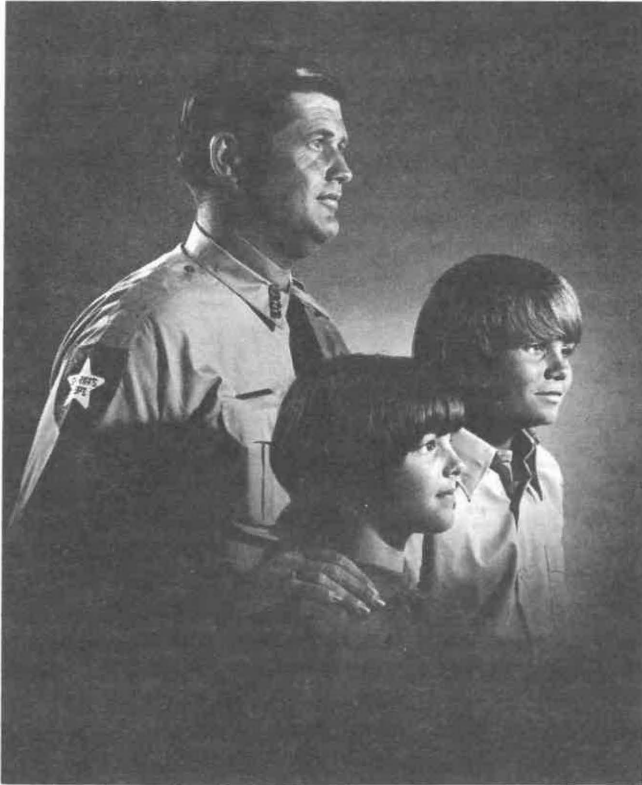

BOYS RANCH IS . . .

A residential group child care program for Florida's neglected, unsupervised and troubled boys between the ages of eight and eighteen. It is not an institution for juvenile delinquents. The Boys Ranch is sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. It was founded in 1957 and currently has approximately 108 boys in residence at any given time. The Boys Ranch is located in North Florida, about halfway between Jacksonville and Tallahassee and nine miles north of the town of Live Oak on County Rd. 795.

YOUTH RANCH IS . . .

The most recently developed residential group child care program of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. Also sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, it was founded in 1976 and opened in 1978. It is located just east of the intersection of the McMullen-Booth Road and County Road 102 near Clearwater, Florida. The Youth Ranch has approximately 30 boys and girls in residence at any given time. It provides care in a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are neglected, unsupervised and troubled boys and girls. Mailing address and telephone number are the same as for the Youth Fund.



THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH FUND IS . . .

A charitable, non-profit corporation, sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, to manage and operate the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, Youth Camp, and any other Youth programs that might later be developed by the Florida Sheriffs Association. An important function of the Youth Fund is the raising, receiving, budgeting, and disbursing of funds for its programs. The Youth Fund and its programs are supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts. Gifts and bequests can be made to the Youth Fund for the exclusive benefit of any single program, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, or Youth Camp, or they may be made without restriction, to be distributed among existing programs as most needed or to be used for the development of new programs at the discretion of the Governing Board. Youth Fund Central Offices are co-located with the Boys Ranch.

GIRLS VILLA IS . . .

A similar program for girls located two miles east of Bartow, Florida, on Route 60. Originally conceived by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce of Madeira Beach, Florida, the Girls Villa was adopted as a project of the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1970. The first buildings were completed and the first girls admitted in 1972. There are approximately 50 girls in residence at any given time. Mailing address and telephone number for the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch are the same as for the Youth Fund.

YOUTH CAMP IS . . .

A Youth Fund operated camping facility which features a summer program for boys and girls. The 154-acre campsite is located one mile northeast of Barberville. Campers are normally selected from among boys and girls who have had Requests for Service submitted to the Youth Fund on their behalf. Many of these youngsters are already on the waiting list for admission to Youth Fund residential facilities. The camping program was initiated in 1981 and acquired its present location in late 1982. Please contact the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund for further information.

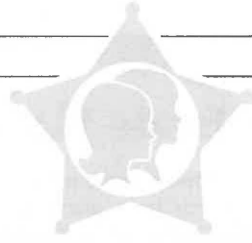

have been won.*

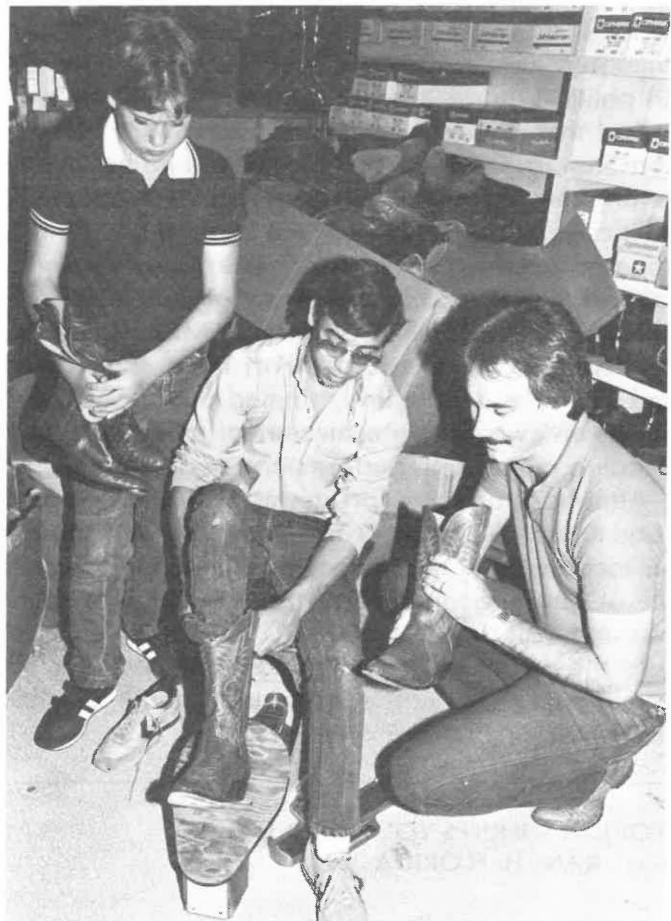
Trio of Winners

And that is exactly what he did. Currently he's at Fort Stewart, near Jesup, Georgia, and he has been getting the kind of media recognition that budding politicians dream about. His picture recently appeared on the cover of *Patriot*, the post newspaper for Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Airfield.

The photo was taken by Adolph Mallory during "Desert Sting" maneuvers at Fort Irwin, California, and Dexter was apparently singled out because he had been awarded an achievement medal for outstanding morale and performance of duty.

After he returned to Fort Stewart he wrote to Youth Fund Regional Director "Mac" Stones, who had been his mentor at the Youth Ranch. "The Army is a bundle of fun," he told "Mac," and then admitted this was only half true.

At the end of the letter he said "I can never thank you enough for what you did for me . . . kinda like the dad I wish I had."
