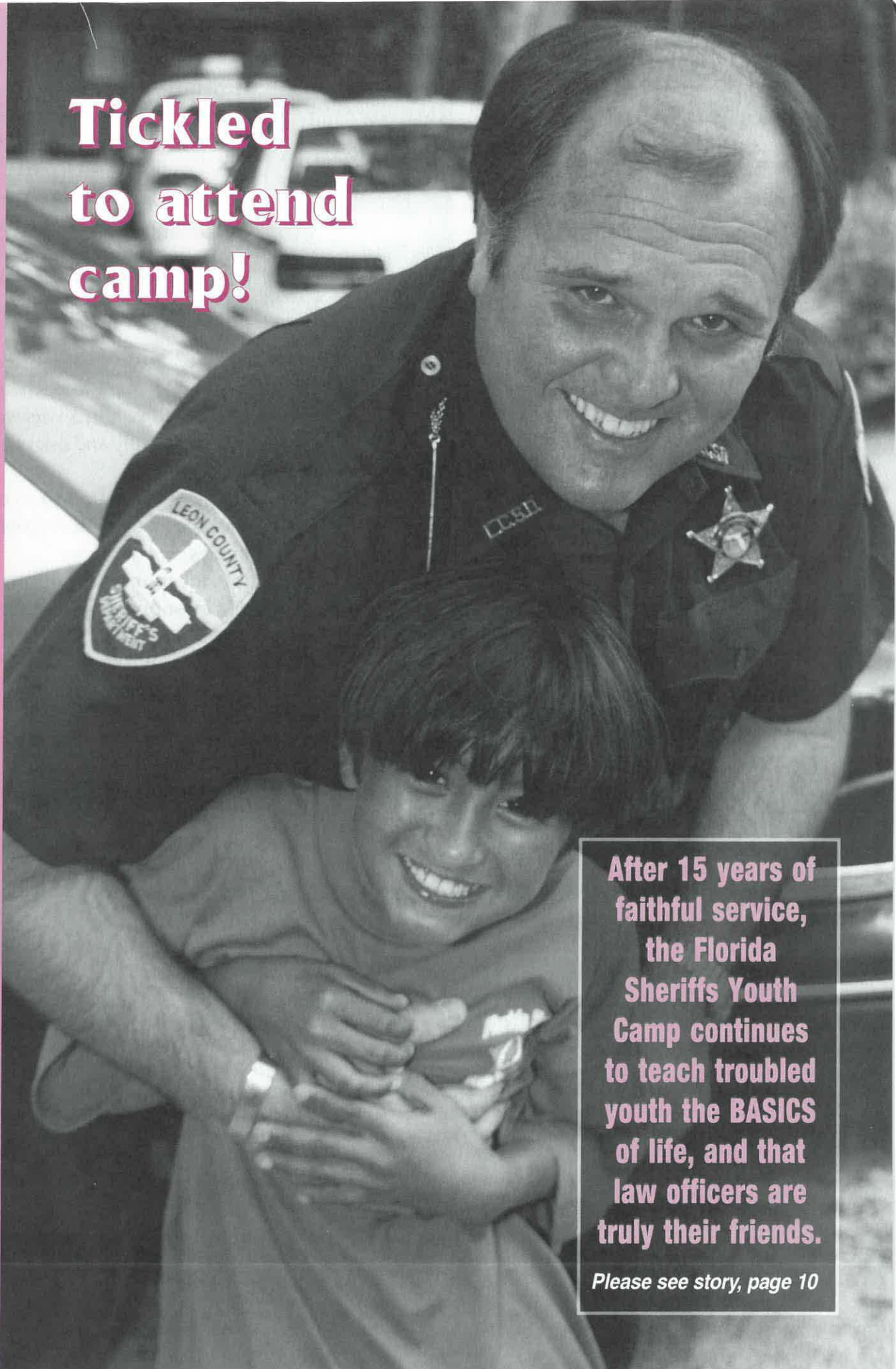

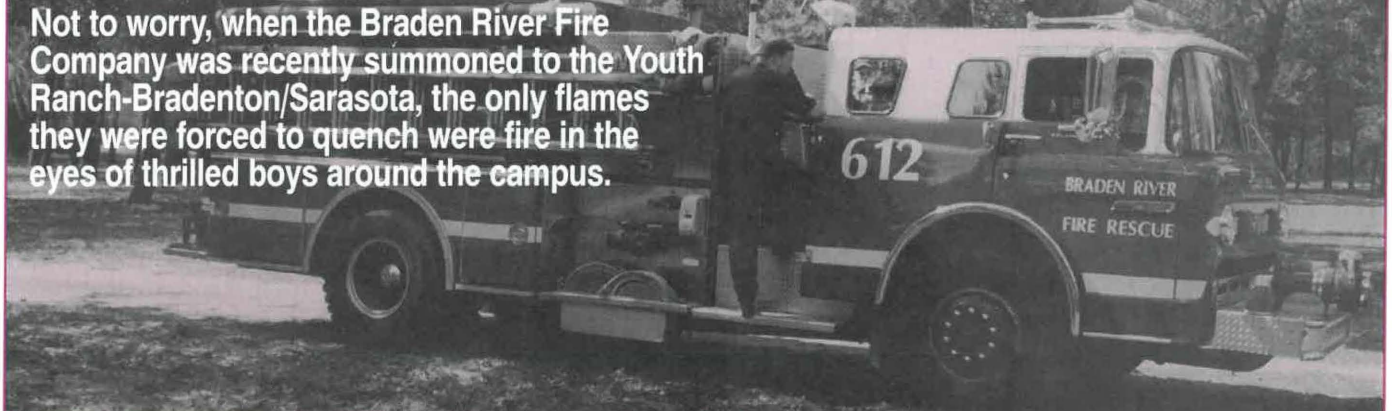

and precautions, proper equipment usage and technique, and extensive accounts of the truths behind what being a firefighter is all about.

"I didn't realize all the training and work they do," said Lacious, a fluorescent-yellow, fire-resistant jacket hanging from his shoulders. "I also learned that firefighters do other things . . . they help anyone that needs it, kinda like the Ranch."

The most important aspect of the Youth Ranches work with troubled and underprivileged children is to restore and rebuild self-esteem. One way to repair lost or forgotten self-confidence is in the establishment of both short- and long-term goals; to offer these youth an opportunity to dream again about the future, and wonder, "what will I be when I grow up?"

"We like to plan unique field trips and invite special guests to the Ranch," says Program Director Jim Laurent. "It gives us a chance to educate the boys, provide great memories, and present potential job alternatives that might otherwise go unnoticed or unrealized."

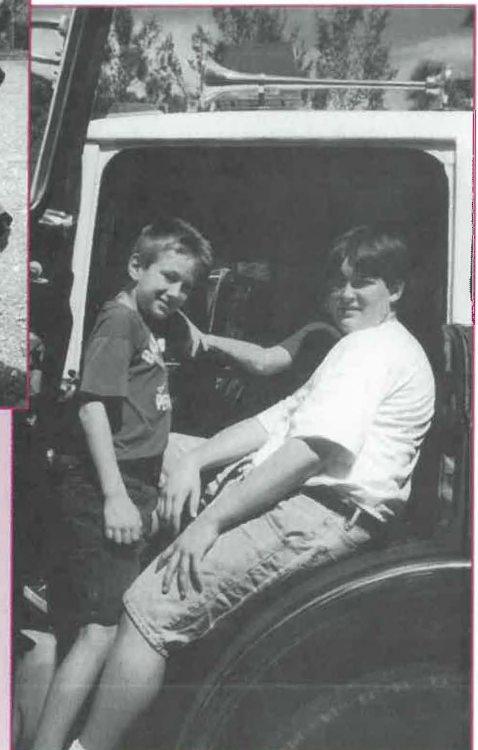

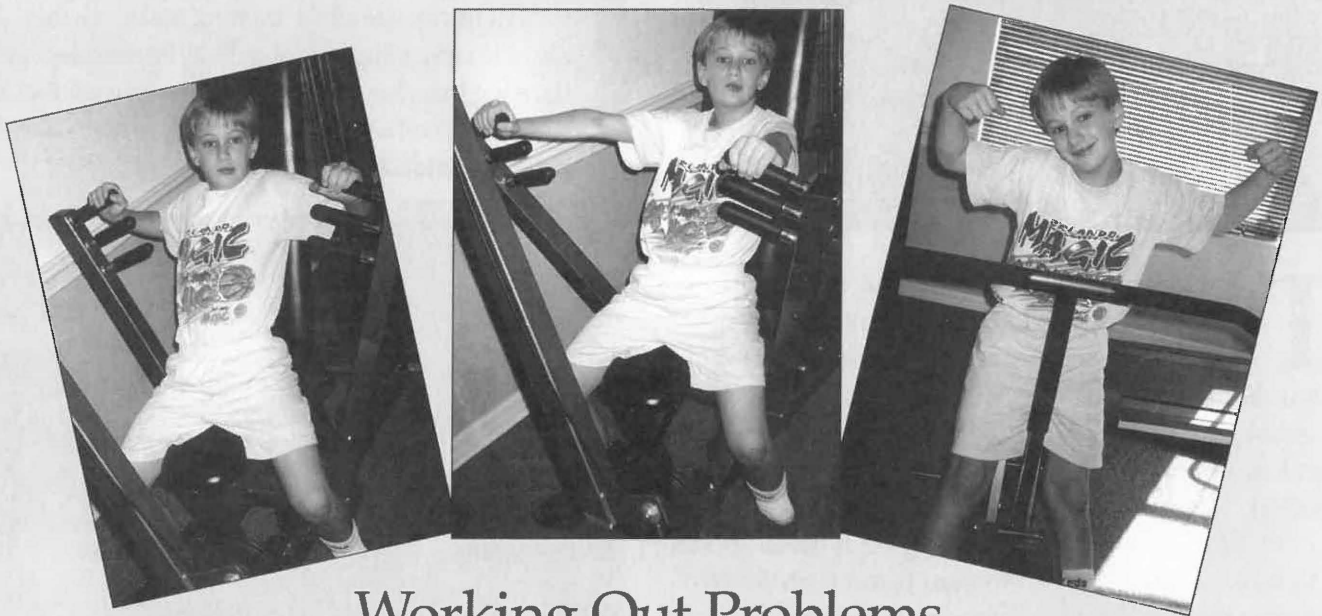
Much like a scholarship designed to help students in school, this very generous commitment will sponsor

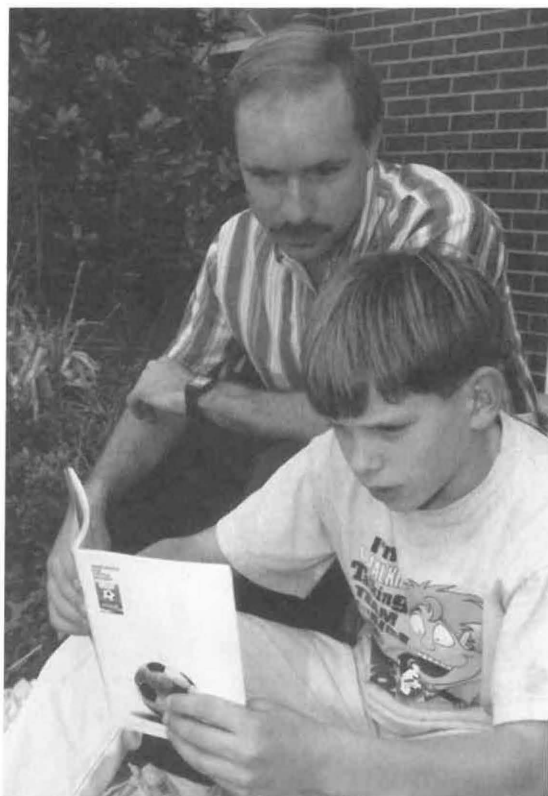

It's back to school time!

In some ways, the Learning Center located on many residential campus, resembles an old-fashioned one-room school. It promotes extensive teacher involvement with each pupil with several grade levels studying together, and a sound, basic educational curriculum.

Yet, at the same time, the Centers are a part of the "information age," equipped with computers to provide the opportunity for each student to learn at a pace compatible with their respective ability.

Outside the Learning Center, youth in residence acquire skills which will serve them throughout life. Through specific, individual work assignments, they learn valuable lessons like caring for personal property, important work ethics and "people skills," rewards



for productive effort, the importance of a proper attitude, and the value of thrift and saving.

Speaking of savings, even though Congress is currently considering a capital gains tax cut, the full impact

may not be realized for several years. Presently, the capital gains tax rate is more than the effective personal income tax rate. 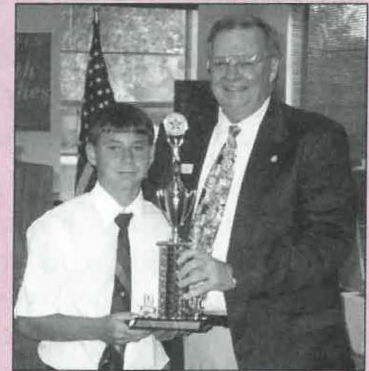

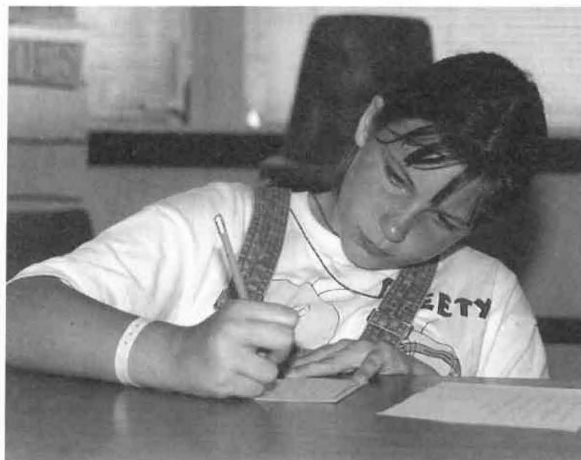
CITATION TO ACCOMPANY THE AWARD OF THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL TO RICHARD C. CHUCKREY, JR.

Senior Airman Richard C. Chuckrey, Jr., distinguished himself by meritorious service as Communications-Computer Systems Control Journeyman, 36th Communications Squadron, 36th Air Base Wing, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam, from 25 August 1994 to 20 August 1996. During this period, Airman Chuckrey diligently accomplished the duties and responsibilities of a position historically held by a Noncommissioned Officer. He constructed a new patch panel from excess equipment, expanding analog and digital access points to long haul communications by 211 percent. Airman Chuckrey saved 6,000 dollars by using existing equipment to reconfigure a circuit required for the 634th Air Mobility Support Squadron to receive mission essential aircraft maintenance data. He re-engineered a critical flight data link for the 36th Operational Support Squadron, bringing service availability to the war fighter up to an outstanding 98 percent. In addition, he provided career enhancement and broadcasting to other Systems Controllers by training them on circuit action functions and complex communications systems operations. The distinctive accomplishments of Airman Chuckrey reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.

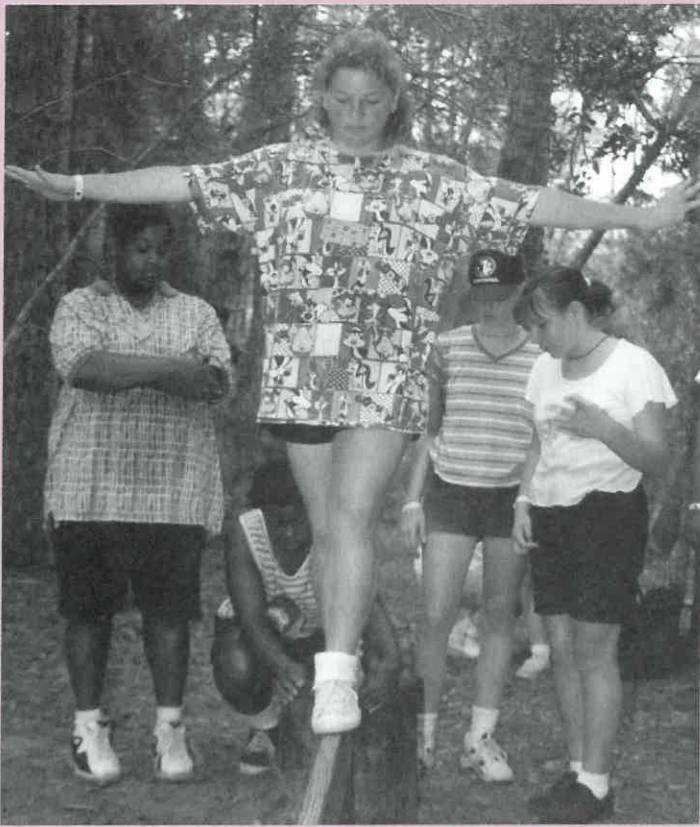

Walking the Tightrope of Life. At the summer Youth Camp, boys and girls realize balance is key to a successful and productive future.

Life itself is a cycle. A circle from birth to death filled with an endless series of ups and downs; a swinging pendulum carving identities and memories into sand. In our own culture, when we feel as though we are moving the sands of time forward, we are actually shifting from one generation to the next. Fads come and go, but come back again. Values change, revolve, evolve, then meet along that invisible circle for yet another revolution; another turn around the circle of life, returning:

Back to BASICS

It is the loss of simple family values that critics say are lacking from today's society and absent from the minds of America's youth. Many refer to a time in history when the comedy of "Burns and Allen" as well as the storied reports of journalist Edward R. Murrow graced grainy radio sets, while mothers and fathers and brothers and sisters spent each evening meal gathered around the family dinner table - a circle of generations - simply acting naturally; as a true family should act - together, united as partners, as friends.

Those were the "good ole days," the days when baseball was America's favorite past-time; when meals were prepared in an oven, not microwave; and rock 'n roll were words to describe the tides. It was a simpler time; a time of innocence and a time of pride that comes only through a strong sense of nationalism. It is these important and forgotten values the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp is consistently attempting to recapture. It is our daily objective to instill a feeling of esteem and pride in lost children, and strive to restore family values, even where families may not exist.

Balance

Giving troubled boys and girls a helping hand and a well-rounded gift of emotional and educational support are central as the Youth Ranches repairs broken dreams and reminds children to reach for their goals.

At the Youth Camp, youngsters must relearn - even learn for the first time - how to delicately walk the tightrope of life. It does not take long for them to discover that balance is the key - though, more importantly, if they happen to fall, they must get back up, dust themselves off, climb aboard the high

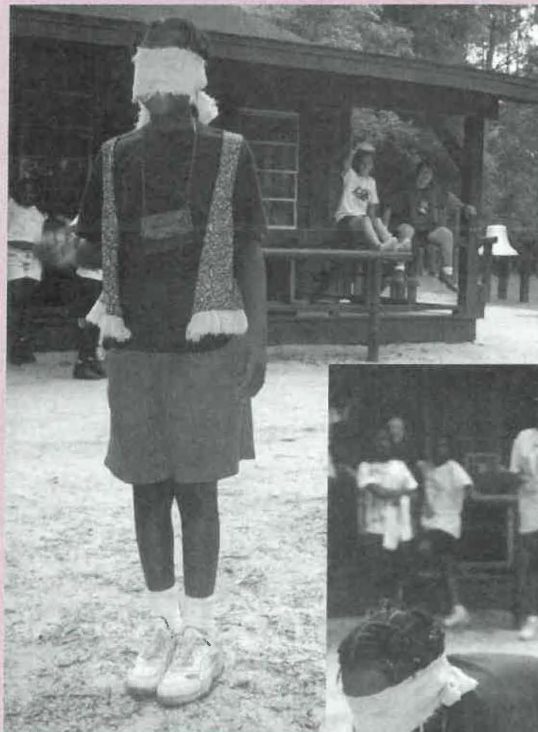
wire again to keep pace, overcome the obstacles they face, and challenge themselves to improve their own self-esteem, stretching closer and closer to lifelong aspirations, and the chance at a responsible adulthood.

"Our aim is to supply these children with the tools it will take to succeed in life," says Youth Camp Director Phil Shults. "They learn a tremendous amount about life, friendship, facing challenges, and how to balance all of these factors as they grow and mature properly."

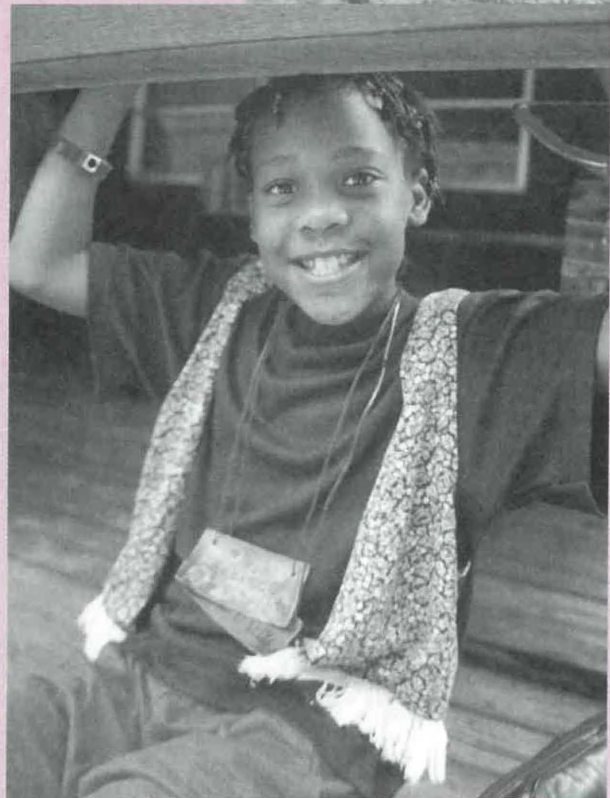
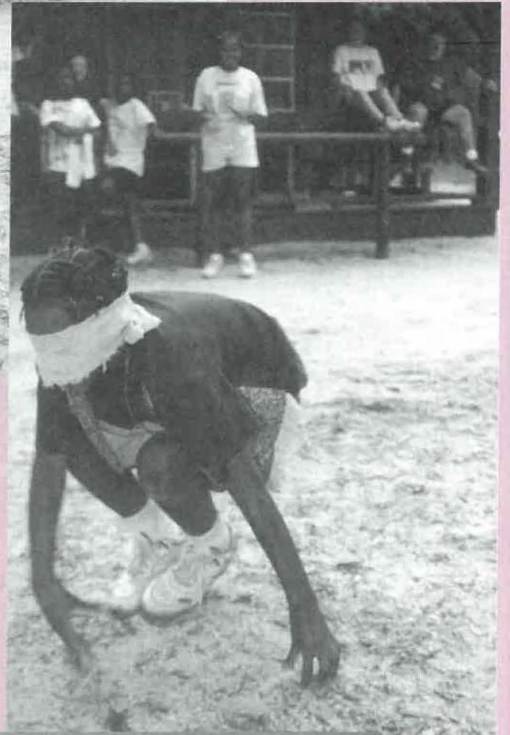
Attitude

"It's quite amazing really, what we can accomplish in only one week," says Program Director Bill Frye. "It's remarkable how children respond to the camping environment, how attitudes quickly change and mutual respect as well as friendships form."

The Youth Camp staff - counselors as well as volunteer Deputies - attribute the enormous success in "transforming" troubled children to the group activities developed with a keen sense of teamwork in mind. Exercises like the Challenge Course, where campers are required to use cooperation to meet team goals, provide boys and girls with the discipline and common respect which can turn negative attitudes into

smiles and support, applause and awards. Even the simple act of eating breakfast, lunch, and dinner as a "family," surrounded by caring counselors and dedicated Deputies, fellow campers can produce lasting memories and see a positive, practical example to carry home with them.

Self-Esteem

Another key ingredient in restoring lost self-esteem and self-confidence in underprivileged youth is to offer them simple, attainable short-term goals. Placing "hurdles" too high can be discouraging, even for adults. Instead, by placing obstacles in places where kids will assuredly overcome; or by giving them tasks which provide immediate and positive results, a camper can build self-esteem without fail.

In an activity like arts and crafts, youngsters paint porcelain and create colorful crafts in just hours. In the pool, basic swimmers receive careful instruction from certified lifeguards until they are able to conquer the deepest of waters. And, at the archery range, mere amateurs can learn the proper techniques on how to hit the target, perhaps even making a bulls-eye or two.

Individual Sacrifice

Year upon year, and summer after summer, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp has been blessed with dedicated, selfless, and compassionate counselors as well as volunteer Deputy Sheriffs – individuals who devote time, energy, and love to needy children from around the state. These caring individuals act as sterling examples as well as strong, posi-

tive role models for troubled teens.

But, perhaps the most important members of the Youth Ranches family are the generous, selfless, and compassionate donors who help support the efforts to prevent and end child abuse, neglect, and delinquency. Special individuals like Don Hawkins, who this year alone, donated enough funding to sponsor an entire session of summer camp. (Please see story on next page.)

Character

Building a child's self-esteem is only the first step, and merely one aspect of creating a strong sense of character within deserving youth. Many campers have never before experienced the delight in constructing a craft; the excitement

"The more you give, the more your wealth will grow," said long-time taxicab driver and Youth Ranches devoted donor Don Hawkins at a recent visit to the Youth Camp/Barberville. "I pulled that out of a fortune cookie at dinner not too long ago . . . great advice don't you think?"

Indeed, and for 15 years – after a brief visit to the city of Live Oak and the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, nestled less than a dozen miles to the north along the Suwannee River – Mr. Hawkins has been faithfully supporting troubled youth and the efforts of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches to end juvenile delinquency and neglect.

"I started getting *The Rancher* . . . gave some small donations, then read about the camp and wanted to truly help in that effort," recalls Mr. Hawkins. "I liked the idea that children were getting an opportunity to experience nature, spending the summer the way they deserve . . . I fell in love with the camp and have been giving ever since."

Through Mr. Hawkins' generosity and goodwill, 165 boys and girls over the last six years have been able to attend the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp, making lasting memories, meeting lifelong friends, and learning lifesaving wisdom from caring counselors and volunteer law enforcement officers. In fact, this year alone, in honor of his 65th birthday, Mr. Hawkins donated nearly \$10,000 to sponsor 65 underprivileged children – an entire session of summer camp, or "Don Hawkins Week."

While the Youth Ranches was eager to help celebrate his 65th birthday at camp, Mr. Hawkins expressed an interest in dedicating the session to the memory of a close friend L. J. (Joe) Brisbane. Mr. Brisbane, a retired United States Army Major, Airborne Division, and tenured member of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Department in Fayetteville, North Carolina, passed away after a lengthy battle with cancer.

"It means a lot to me to be able to help the lives of so many deserving kids as well as honor the memory of my friend. Thank you."

Thank you, Mr. Hawkins, for your wisdom, generosity, and compassion for the needy and neglected. And, once again, Happy Birthday!

Camp is not all fun and games.

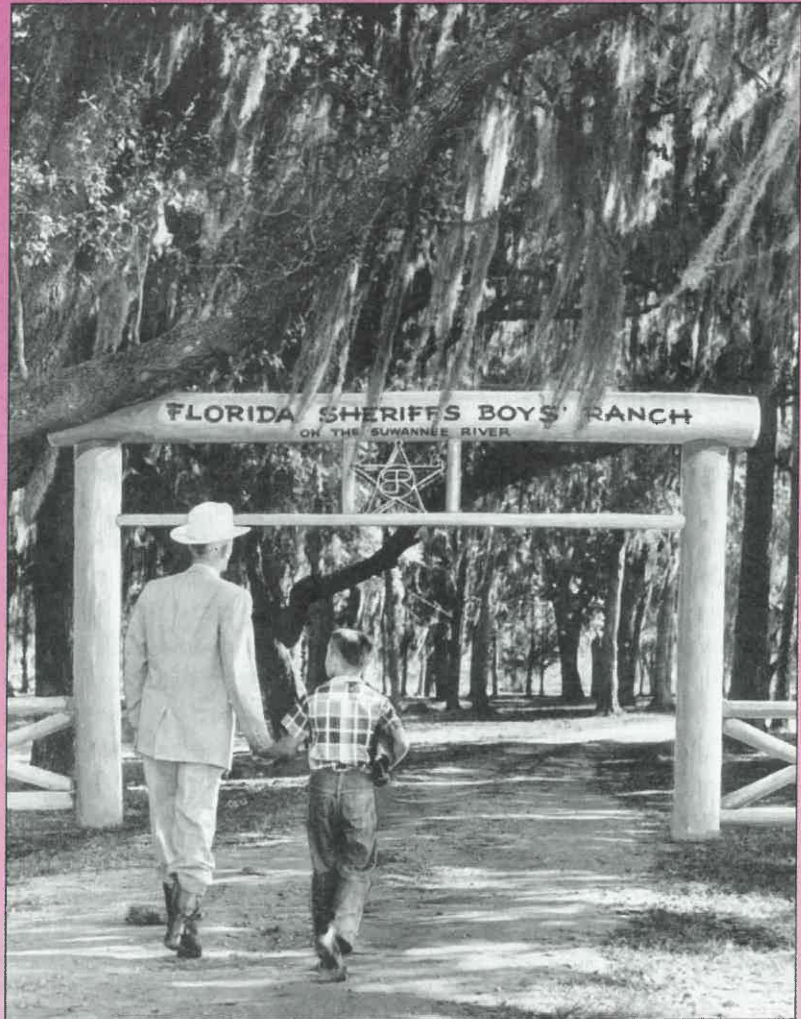
Although the primary function of the Youth Camp is to
