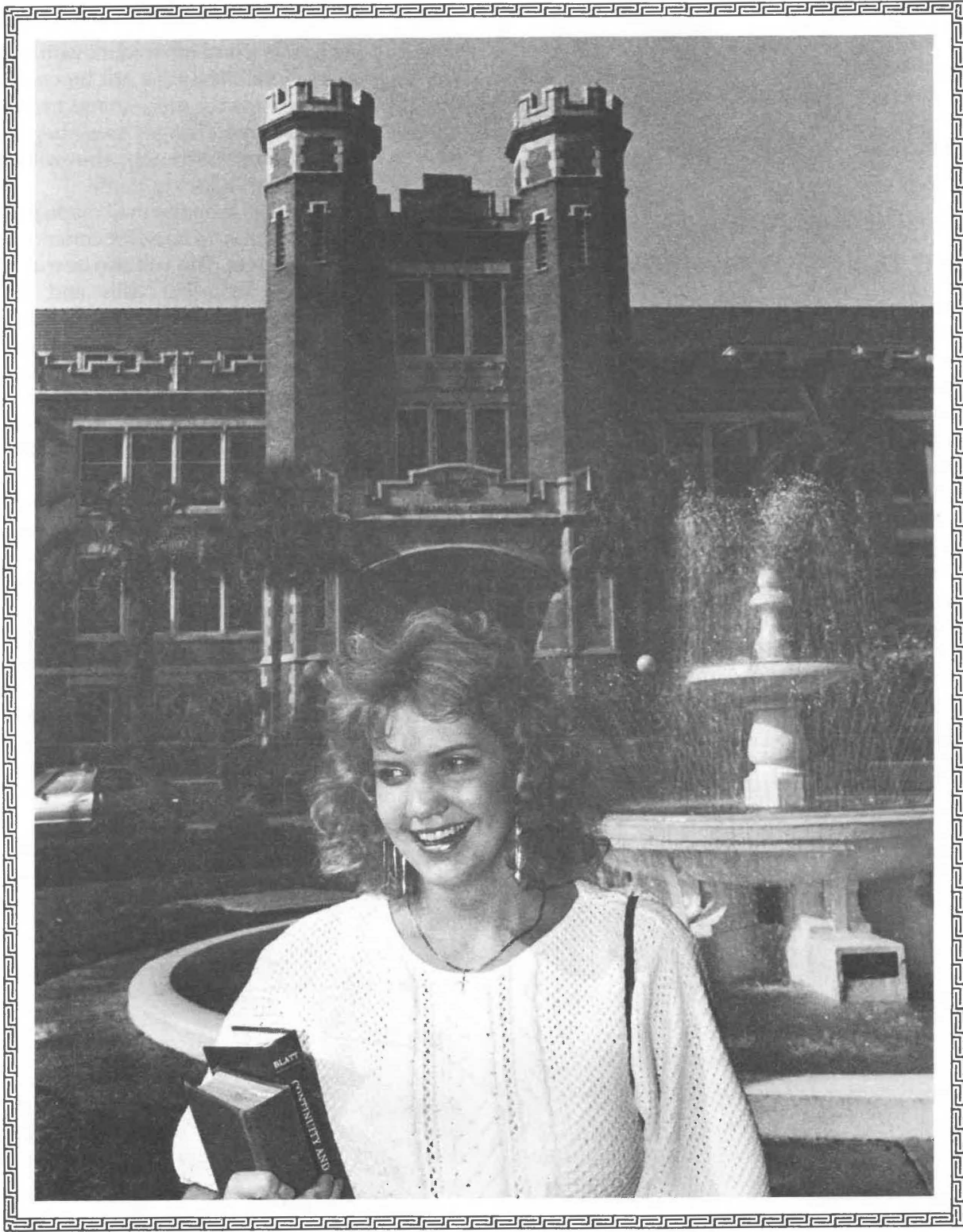

A message from Harry K. Weaver, President of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches



## We're still the same, but we have a new name

Did you notice anything different on the cover of *The Rancher* this issue. If not, don't be concerned. You'll be seeing it again and again as you go through the magazine.

The Youth Fund has changed its name. We are now "Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.," a non-profit corporation just as the Youth Fund was.

Nothing else about us has changed. We are still the same organization doing the same kinds of work with Florida's troubled boys and girls and still looking to you, our friends, for the encouragement and support that you have always so generously given.

We made the change because we feel that the name "Youth Ranches" is more descriptive of the kind of organization we are and the kinds of programs that we operate, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls

Villa, Youth Ranch, and Youth Camp. As we continue to grow, there will be other Youth Ranches and Camps, and the parent organization name, "Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.," will become even more appropriate than it is now.

For a while at least, you will continue to see literature, bumper stickers, and other items with the Youth Fund name on them. Please do not be confused by this. It takes some time for these things to get out of circulation after a name change. As we begin to prepare new materials for distribution, they will carry the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches name.

If you have gift checks in the mail made payable to the Youth Fund, there is no need for concern. We will be able to deposit them. This will also be true of other legal transactions, including wills and bequests, trusts, etc., of which the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund was made a beneficiary. If you have some other reason to change them, you might wish to take advantage of the opportunity to also change our name to "Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc." There is no need to do this solely for the sake of the name change.

We would appreciate it very much if you would use our new name with any future gifts or other transactions.

We have come a long way as the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. When I say "we," I really mean "us," because it couldn't have happened without your concern, interest, involvement, kindness, and generosity.

Now, we begin a new and even more productive era of service to Florida's troubled boys and girls as "Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches." We ask for your continued involvement and support.

## We are watching the progress of Mary because she is so very extraordinary

When Mary Braunagel was a young girl, her number one ambition was to make good grades and go to college, but, somewhere between the eighth grade and the ninth grade, because of circumstances she was not able to control, her dreams of a college education just sort of evaporated, and she dropped out of school.

For a long time she drifted — a non-achiever with no goals on the horizon. Life was just a bummer, month after month, until she was accepted to live at the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, near Bartow.

Encouraged by the people at the Villa, she not only resumed her schooling, but also began “hitting the books” at a furious pace to catch up. It was obvious that her childhood ambition had been revived.

In the daytime she went to the public school in Bartow, and signed up for more than the normal number of subjects. At night and during weekends she worked on correspondence courses provided by the Villa. During two summers, while many of her pals were loafing and going on vacation trips, she attended summer school.

It was hard work, but it paid off. She not only caught up with her contemporaries by completing high school in 2½ years, but she also graduated with honors.

Bartow Senior High School officials and supporters were impressed, and their admiration prompted them to give Mary the first David Mundy Memorial Scholarship — an award established in memory of an outstanding 10th grader who died at 16 after a life-long fight with a defective heart.

“We wanted a student who had been successful despite various problems, and Mary fit this requirement well,” said High School Principal Henrie Sparkman. “There could not have been a better choice.”

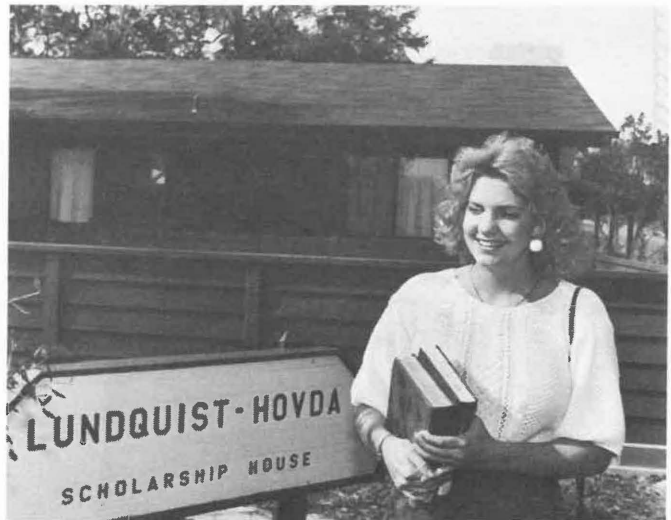
Aided by this scholarship, Mary made plans to enroll at Florida State University; and, because of her excellent scholastic record, she qualified to live in a house for honor students provided by the Southern Scholarship Foundation, Inc.

She started her college career in August, 1985, and when she was interviewed recently she was striving mightily to live up to the expectations of her friends at the Girls Villa.

“The people at the Villa supported and encouraged me,” she said, “and even though I have moved



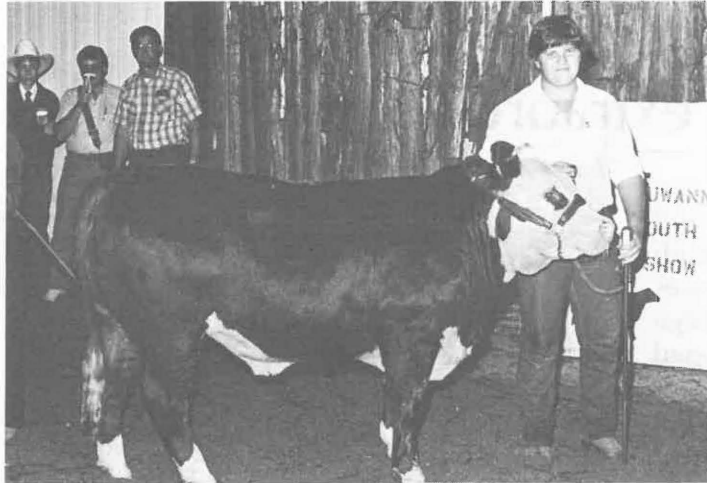

away, I do not feel abandoned by them. They have made me feel that I am welcome to come back at any time. This has given me a real sense of security, and has made me want to make them proud of me.”

With Christmas and New Year's approaching, Mary said she was planning to spend part of her holiday break at the Girls Villa. “It's my home,” she said. “That's what going home means to me.”

## Sheriff recalls last days of "great little guy"

The following tribute was prepared by Levy County Sheriff Pat Hartley and presented at a Boys Ranch chapel service honoring the memory of Vito "Barney" Petraitis.

"The one we honor today was one of my shortest acquaintances, yet those few days of knowing Vito 'Barney' Petraitis enriched my life. Here was a man who had made a terrible mistake early in his life. Through our system of justice he had paid his debt to society for this crime, yet in his heart he could not pay for the life that he had taken in the commission of an armed robbery.

"Barney could not forgive himself and he did not know Christ, the Great Forgiver. After he got out of prison he sentenced himself to a life of working in hot kitchens as a baker; saving and doing without any luxuries of life. You see, he had a plan: he wanted to use his life's savings to help young people. He didn't want them to make the mistake of getting involved in lawlessness. He wanted them to become productive and responsible citizens.

"We are all so thankful that he had heard of the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch and Camping Programs, and the work that we are doing for the needy and worthy young people, giving them a second chance to make something of themselves. By now you know that he selected the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches to receive his life's savings. He requested, and was assured, that only the income from his gift would be used, making it perpetual.

"I'm sure that his gift will not have been made in vain, and that each of you, and those who follow after you, will grow up to responsibility, making his sacrifices worthwhile.

"The best part of my short acquaintance and deep friendship with Mr. Petraitis, I must share with you also. He advised me as we were working out the details of his gift to you that he had a terminal illness and a very short time to live.

"At this time God placed the burden on my heart to ask Mr. Petraitis about the greatest of all gifts: the gift of eternal life. I was shocked when he told me that he did not believe, and that when he died it would be the end for him. I told him that he had a living soul that would live somewhere in eternity and that I wished he would spend it with me and our Heavenly Father.

"Again, he said 'I don't believe! Why do you bother me about this?' I said 'Because I love you, and you are a great little guy with a big, big heart, thinking not of yourself, but others.' He grinned and said 'You are the kindest-hearted Sheriff I've ever met.'

"I prayed for God to help me find something to

make him understand that he had a soul, and needed to go into eternity knowing that Christ gave His all on the cross for his salvation. I found the book, *The 23rd Psalm*, and took it to him saying, 'Barney, I don't want to bug you or make you uncomfortable, but it's very important to me that you understand.' He grinned again and promised to read the book.

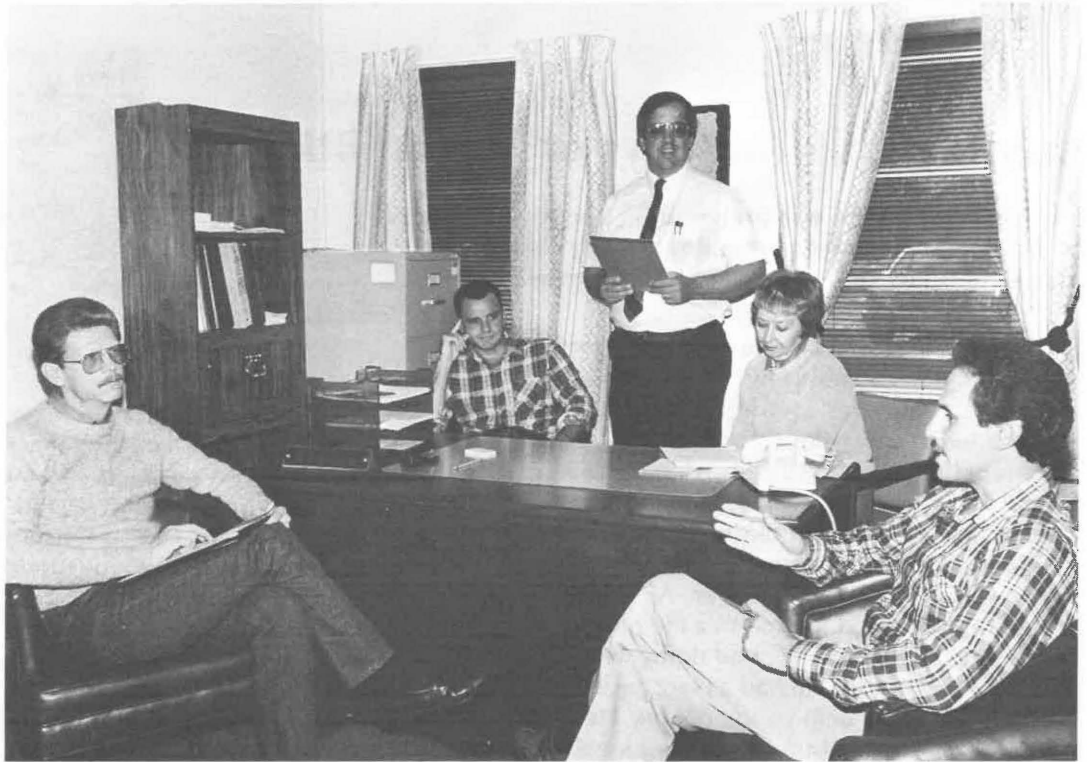
"A few days later Ed Waldron, a Youth Fund Vice President, visited Mr. Petraitis, and then advised me that he was very ill. Later that day as I was taking Mr. Petraitis to the hospital he looked as if something was heavy on his mind. I asked him if he was worried about the man he had shot [before going to prison]. He said he was. I said, 'God will forgive you if you only ask him to.' He looked at me and weakly said, 'these words, the 23rd Psalm, Jesus is all that matters now,' and repeated again, 'Jesus is all that matters now.' I was elated at his believing. We got to the hospital and I went by to see him the next morning. He'd had a good night and was comfortable.

"He smiled as I walked into his room, holding his hand up to me. After a short visit I asked if I could bring him anything. He requested I bring his book, *The 23rd Psalm*, and his glasses. As I returned with his book, he and another patient were talking about Jesus. I asked if he would like to talk with my minister, the Rev. Travis Hudson, and he said he certainly would and would also like to have a Bible.

"The Rev. Hudson came immediately, bringing a Bible, and spoke words of comfort and prayer. Mr. Petraitis appreciated the visit and said 'Jesus is the answer.'

"Mr. Petraitis got to feeling better and went home, but lived only a few more days. At his death he was attended by his kind and loving neighbors, Mr. and Mrs. James Baker, who had cared for him through long years of illness.

"We are all grateful for our gift from Vito 'Barney' Petraitis. More important is his receiving the gift of eternal life, and the spiritual comfort it brought him in his last days. I am humbled and grateful for the opportunity to have known him, and to have had a small part in both gifts received. His favorite book, *The 23rd Psalm*, will be a gift that you may wish to place in your library."

**A new deal:**

# Youth Camp to become a haven for youngsters in crisis situations



Rewiring, winterizing and other improvements began before the end of 1985.

DELAND — For boys and girls whose living arrangements are in crisis, the news coming from the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp is encouraging.

Under a recently completed contract that broadens its outreach, the Camp has agreed to accept from the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services (HRS), seriously troubled youngsters (not adjudicated delinquents) who have failed to find remedies for their mistakes and bad breaks in foster homes, emergency shelters, detention facilities, and other conventional child care programs.

Accepting these boys and girls whose severe problems create a special challenge, will add a new dimension to the Youth Camp program — a program that has been featuring successful summer camping sessions as well as unique wilderness camping activities.

Summer camping sessions, which offer many important benefits to neglected, unsupervised and troubled youngsters from all areas of Florida, will continue as usual; but the new contracted-care project, with its more intense therapeutic approach, will operate throughout the year.



Tent camping is the lifestyle, but each campsite will have a utility building with toilets and showers; also a meeting area that can be used as a temporary shelter during stormy or extremely cold weather.



Improvements at the multi-purpose dining hall (always referred to as the "chuck wagon" by campers and staff) include interior paneling, ceiling fans, new kitchen equipment and a heating system. This building is used as an activity and meeting center, as well as a dining hall.

Young people who have been adjudicated delinquent, or who have severe personality problems that could result in violent, destructive or psychotic behavior, will not be accepted. Targeted for help will be boys and girls who can best be described as dependent, troubled, or pre-delinquent.

HRS will refer applicants to the Camp, but approval of the Sheriff of the county in which the applicant is residing will continue to be a basic requirement for admission.

During the final months of 1985, extensive preparations were made to accommodate 32 boys and girls,

12 through 16, in the year 'round contracted-care program. The Camp facilities, which are located near DeLand at the edge of the Ocala National Forest, were winterized and upgraded; a professional staff was hired; and an admissions committee began screening prospective campers.

At this writing, all preparations have been completed, and the staff has received the first young people. Available for these fortunate campers is a unique experience designed to help them achieve physical, social, emotional, spiritual, moral, educational, recreational and occupational growth.

### **BOYS RANCH IS . . .**

A residential group child care program for Florida's neglected, unsupervised and troubled boys between the ages of eight and eighteen. It is not an institution for juvenile delinquents. The Boys Ranch is sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. It was founded in 1957 and currently has approximately 108 boys in residence at any given time. The Boys Ranch is located in North Florida, about half-way between Jacksonville and Tallahassee and nine miles north of the town of Live Oak on County Rd. 795.

### **YOUTH RANCH IS . . .**

The most recently developed residential group child care program of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. Also sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, it was founded in 1976 and opened in 1978. It is located just east of the intersection of the McMullen-Booth Road and County Road 102 near Clearwater, Florida. The Youth Ranch has approximately 30 boys and girls in residence at any given time. It provides care in a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are neglected, unsupervised and troubled boys and girls. Mailing address and telephone number are the same as for the Youth Ranches.



## **THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH RANCHES IS . . .**

A charitable, non-profit corporation, sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, to manage and operate the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, Youth Camp, and any other Youth programs that might later be developed by the Florida Sheriffs Association. An important function of the Youth Ranches is the raising, receiving, budgeting, and disbursing of funds for its programs. The Youth Ranches and its programs are supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts. Gifts and bequests can be made to the Youth Ranches for the exclusive benefit of any single program, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, or Youth Camp, or they may be made without restriction, to be distributed among existing programs as most needed or to be used for the development of new programs at the discretion of the Governing Board. Youth Ranches Central Offices are co-located with the Boys Ranch.

### **GIRLS VILLA IS . . .**

A similar program for girls located two miles east of Bartow, Florida, on Route 60. Originally conceived by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce of Madeira Beach, Florida, the Girls Villa was adopted as a project of the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1970. The first buildings were completed and the first girls admitted in 1972. There are approximately 50 girls in residence at any given time. Mailing address and telephone number for the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch are the same as for the Youth Ranches.

### **YOUTH CAMP IS . . .**

A Youth Ranches operated camping facility which features a summer program for boys and girls. The 154-acre campsite is located one mile northeast of Barberville. Campers are normally selected from among boys and girls who have had Requests for Service submitted to the Youth Ranches on their behalf. Many of these youngsters are already on the waiting list for admission to Youth Ranches residential facilities. The camping program was initiated in 1981 and acquired its present location in late 1982. Please contact the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches for further information.

## The Great Gift Wrapping Gambol\* was rated a successful venture

Operating a gift wrapping booth at Clearwater's Countryside Mall 12 hours a day during the entire 29-day Christmas shopping season was a new experience for the Youth Ranch, and there came a time in the final hectic days when just the sight of boxes, ribbons and bows could make youngsters, staff members and volunteers downright bilious.

But, these symptoms were temporary rather than terminal, and they took flight with the speed of a Tums TV commercial when the success of the "Great Gift Wrapping Gambol"\* (GGWG) became apparent.

The aching backs, the tired feet, and the stress symptoms were quickly forgotten when Resident Director Fred E. "Mac" Stones announced that the GGWG had raised over \$7,000 for the Youth Ranch.

He said many patrons not only paid for gift wrapping, but also gave cash donations, and requested information about the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

"The project seemed to have excellent public relations and information benefits," he added.

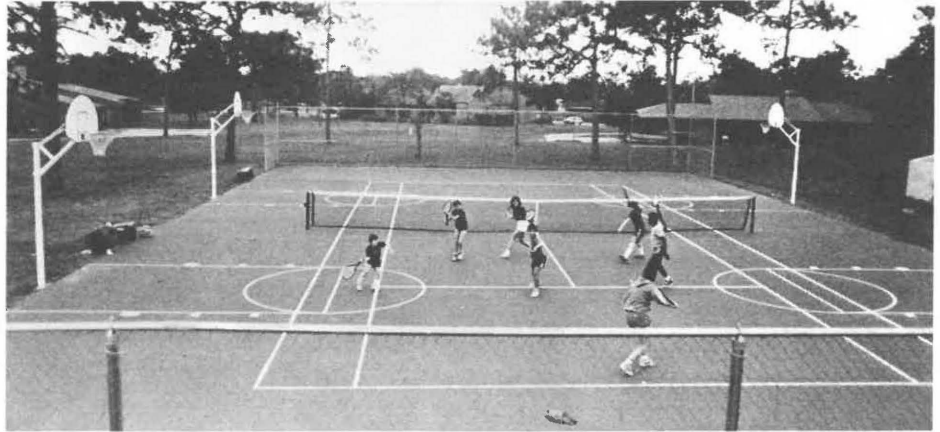
The gift wrapping booth was provided by Countryside Mall the Clearwater Sertoma Club. It was manned by approximately 300 volunteers in addition to Youth Ranch staff members, and some of the older Youth Ranch youngsters.

Stones said that the GGWG used up approximately 3,000 gift boxes, 15,000 feet of ribbon, 4,000 sheets of tissue, 4,000 bows, and 9,600 feet of colorful wrapping paper.
