





Planning has begun for the Youth Ranches 35th Anniversary

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches will celebrate its 35th anniversary during the first weekend in October and planning for the big doin's are already under way to make it a special year.

Planning began nearly two years ago, with the first objective of the Youth Ranches staff being to make certain that as many people as possible are aware of the coming celebration. Some of the proposed activities include preparation of anniversary billboards, scheduling speaking engagements for Youth Ranches staff at civic clubs around Florida, and designing commemorative coffee cups, stationery, envelopes, and seals.

In addition, a new Youth Ranches film is planned for production this year, new public service announcements are to be recorded and taped, and various informational material will be sent to the media statewide. An anniversary edition of *The Rancher* will be published in the fall, and posters will be distributed statewide to Sheriff's offices, banks, Youth Ranches programs, and other key locations.

A special project to raise about \$12,000 to replace the huge lighted star that once stood on a hillside at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch is underway. This Youth Ranches symbol was erected for the 30th anniversary in 1987, but was removed recently for safety reasons when the supports began deteriorating. Nearly \$1,000 has been raised so far.

Community breakfasts, announcements on hotel and motel marquees statewide, a proclamation by the Governor commemorating the anniversary, a trip by Youth Ranches youngsters to the state Legislature, and a trip to Washington, D. C. to see our government in action will be a part of the celebration.

Of course, the biggest event will be Open House at the Boys Ranch Oct. 2, 3, and 4. There will be many special guests, entertainment, a three-day open horse show, camping sites available under the pines, an alumni reunion, and much more.

Sheriffs will be urged to confirm speaking engagements at civic clubs, host fund-raising events, or contact the local media about running feature stories about the Youth Ranches.

We're asking our alumni and donor family members to spread the word about the anniversary, telling others about the Youth Ranches and its 35 years of caring for troubled boys and girls.

Great idea that refuses to die inspires a five-star fish fry

PINELLAS PARK — A great idea was born here 33 years ago. It had a very useful life, passed away in its prime, and was finally brought back to life with much success last fall. Here's how it happened:

In 1958, when the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch was a brand new project, the first major fund raising event was a fish fry sponsored jointly by Pinellas County Sheriff Don Genung and restaurant owner Johnny Leverock Sr.

It was a great idea. In fact, it was so successful that it became an annual event and raised thousands of dollars for the struggling Boys Ranch during the 1950s and 60s. It would have lasted longer, perhaps, but the crowds just got too big to handle.

After that it was given a place of honor in the Boys


Ranch history archives and placed on the shelf along with other pleasant memories of "the good old days." As years passed, it gathered dust there while many changes were taking place in Pinellas Park and at the Ranch.

Don Genung retired; Johnny Leverock Sr. and Johnny Leverock Jr. died; and the restaurant was acquired by a new owner. In time, it was not easy to find anyone in Pinellas Park who remembered the Leverock fish fries.


While all this was happening, the status quo of the Boys Ranch was also being altered. Changes began

brewing there in 1969 when a decision was made to establish a similar program for girls near Bartow. Further expansion followed between 1969 and 1992, as programs similar to the Boys Ranch were established in other areas of the state. Consequently, the Boys Ranch eventually became just one of six programs administered by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc., in a statewide network of youth care facilities and services.

Between 1969 and 1992, the old order certainly changed, and as a new era took shape, the 1958 Leverock Fish Fry became just a dimly remembered fragment of early Boys Ranch history.

Good food, a warm day, and . . . well . . . the fish fry was just too much for the son of Scott Powers, one of the sponsors. His firm, Powers Printing Corp., provided a large amount of printing, and charged only for the materials.

However, in May 1991, when funeral services were held for Bertha Leverock, widow of Johnny Leverock Sr., the good old days of fund-raising were discussed, and a suggestion was made that the Leverock fish fries ought to be revived as a memorial to Johnny Leverock, Bertha and Johnny Jr.

John Strauss, the present owner of Leverock's Seafood House agreed, and later discussed the idea with Jean Newell, Youth Ranches Vice President Planned Giving.

She was enthusiastic, and promptly arranged a meeting with Genung, Strauss, and Youth Ranches Regional Director Fred "Mac" Stones. This foursome gave the idea "thumbs up." Then Genung was persuaded to come out of retirement and serve as honorary chairman.

Pinellas County Sheriff Everett Rice helped the cause along by publicizing the coming event in his speeches and selling tickets.

The memorial fish fry was set for Oct. 26, 1991, but preparations began far in advance. Sponsors were signed up. Donations were accepted. Arrangements were made for publicity and entertainment. Volunteers were recruited. All of these details were familiar to Genung from past experience, but he claims that Jean Newell was the person who "really ramrodded" the project.

Regardless of who did what, the important thing



is that by the time Oct. 26, 1991, rolled around, everything was shipshape, and the First Annual Leverock Memorial Fish Fry was unveiled as a reasonable facsimile of the 1958 original.

Between noon and 4 p.m., over 1,000 patrons were served a traditional menu of fish, hush puppies, french fries and cole slaw prepared by the Leverock restaurant staff. Grownups dined, chatted, soaked up the warm sunshine, or listened to entertainers; while youngsters, including 15 from the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch at Safety Harbor, lined up for pony rides provided by one of the donors. It was almost like old times, and the results were very gratifying — especially later on when a final tally revealed that over \$5,000 had been raised for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

Jean Newell was pleased with the outcome, especially when restaurant owner John Strauss told her he wanted to continue to sponsor the memorial fish fry as an annual event.

So what they say about great ideas must be true: "They never really die, they just hang around in limbo waiting to be reborn."





When we cannot use an item immediately within our programs, we often sell it at auction and use the money for day-to-day expenses such as food and clothing. The bidding was vigorous and most bidders expressed an interest in attending future auctions in Crystal River. Some folks volunteered to donate items for the next auction.

Proceeds from the auction totaled nearly \$3,000 to help troubled boys and girls.



In addition to providing the advertising, the cab company also supports the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa by providing a vehicle and driver to transport about 40 youth to the Florida Sheriffs YouthVilla's annual awards banquet off campus.



Summer Camp is just around the corner



Many of the campers come from homes where self-esteem is very low, and opportunities to excel are few. Some may have faced abuse. Most would never otherwise have the opportunity to attend a summer camp.

While at camp, the boys and girls will enjoy swimming, hiking, horseback riding, archery, boating, group singing, picnics, delicious and nutritional meals, demonstrations by law en-




forcement authorities, arts and crafts, and climbing "the wall." Our aim is to insure that every camper goes home with a positive memory of their camping experience so they will grow strong both physically and mentally.

As always, "Law officers are your friends" will be the theme during Summer Camp. We will stress to the boys and girls that law officers are friendly people whose job it is to protect the community. The officers wear casual clothing until the last night of camp when they dress in full uniform. Youngsters are often

surprised to see a person they have grown to admire as a counselor dressed in a law enforcement uniform they perhaps feared or distrusted. Goodbyes are said on the last night of camp during special ceremonies, and tears often flow freely from both officers and boys and girls.

Yes, Summer Camp is just around the corner, and we're anxious to see that first busload of excited boys and girls drive up.

A peaceful journey in time upon the Peace River

Editor's note: Caruth Camp youth often explore the rivers of Florida, Georgia and the Carolinas as part of their experiential education. This is an account of one of those explorations written by Caruth Camp staff member Terry Kelly who accompanied this group.

Nearly a dozen Caruth Camper youth explored the Peace River by canoe for four days during a three-week trip to South Florida. The trip began at Wauchula in Hardee County.

Loading five canoes with food, gear, and people is routine for these young woodsmen. As their teacher, it is my job to use non-traditional methods. Each camper comes from a troubled background

where traditional teaching methods are not usually effective.

Some have lived in many foster homes, been shuffled between divorced parents, or weathered multiple, unsuccessful adoptions. Their lives have been changed drastically for the better by the program at Caruth Camp, where emphasis is placed upon responsibility for one's actions, tackling and solving problems as they arise, learning to rely upon each other, and learning self-reliance at the same time. They are intelligent, immensely motivated lads who bubble over with energy and a great thirst for knowledge and love.

Caruth Camp staff are charged with channeling this energy and directing their quest so the productive, responsible adult inside can emerge like a butterfly from its cocoon.

Channeling this energy into productivity is no

small feat. Therefore, as their teacher and role model, I was keenly aware that a great, yet unconventional, classroom was opening up before us as we began to drift down this most intriguing river.

As a native of Hardee County, I was pleased to see the Peace River had changed very little. Wildlife was abundant. We spotted an armadillo on shore, captured it, and prepared it for a tasty meal. There was also plenty of freshly caught fish to quiet our hungry stomachs.

As we continued, turtles, sunning themselves on outstretched tree branches, splashed into the river. We passed small, beady-eyed alligators lurking in the underbrush. Curious raccoons waded along the shore, washing their prey while birds with diversified plumage flew overhead. It was the kind of peaceful setting that every person longs for, but few have the opportunity to enjoy.

The joy of seeing these troubled boys basking in the afternoon sun, laughing and singing, at peace

with themselves and the world as their canoes sliced through the waters, was almost overwhelming. I wondered what these youngsters would be doing today in their previous environment if it weren't for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. The question troubled my soul.

During our visit to Hardee County, we were treated royally by its residents, including Sheriff Doyle Bryan. After weeks of hiking, camping, canoeing, sightseeing, and cooking our own meals, we were delighted when the Kiwanis Club, in conjunction with the Golden Corral restaurant, provided a delicious steak dinner and all the trimmings to our group.

A tour of the Hardee County *Herald Advocate* offered another opportunity for our boys to arm themselves with knowledge. And, freshly made chocolate chip cookies provided by the *Advocate's* Jim and Jean Kelly topped an already stupendous trip.

Triathlon raises funds for Youth Ranches

Each October Fred Sommer brings some of the most fiercely competitive athletes in the world to the small community of Clermont to participate in THE GREAT FLORIDIAN TRIATHLON. At the same time, this athletic event gives substantial support to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

The 1991 triathlon attracted more than 200 competitors from 34 states and countries to test their endurance in a 112-mile bicycle ride, a 26.2-mile marathon run, a relay race, and a 2.4-mile swim. "It's the relay race that brings in the money for the Youth Ranches," said Mr. Sommer. He added that 100 percent of the proceeds from the relay event goes to the Youth Ranches.

During a recent visit to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch to present a check for \$2,000 from those proceeds, Mr. Sommer said when it came time to pick a charity to benefit from the fund-raiser, there was no question it would be the Youth Ranches. "We wanted to pick a good charity to raise money for," he said. "I'm partial to the kids because I used to work with youth."

Planning is now underway for the October 1992 Triathlon. It will take on a more festival-type

atmosphere, said Mr. Sommer, and will feature bungee jumping, paraplaning, and water sports in addition to the triathlon. The 1992 event will also include an open law enforcement competition category.




Mike Montgomery (right) and Jeff Surber (left) hold a hand-carved wooden eagle donated by a Youth Ranches friend.

Unusual gifts come our way to help a boy or girl today

Since the beginning of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches in 1957, many kind friends have chosen to assist troubled boys and girls in various ways that include cash gifts, wills, trusts, and non-cash gifts.

Along with the normal non-cash gifts of furniture, tools, and horses have come many unusual items. For example, a recent gift from a Marion County veterinarian consisted of the popular Vietnamese pot-bellied pigs and exotic chickens.

Not only do we get unusual gifts, sometimes the live ones are unruly. In the early days, a field representative went out early one morning to pick up a donated pony and spent the better part of the day chasing it through a swamp. He returned to the Boys Ranch tired and dirty, but a smile of satisfaction crept across his face as he unloaded the unruly character.

These days, we count among the animals that have been donated horses, cattle, goats, sheep, donkeys, ducks, geese, and hogs.

Our auctions often reflect the trend in non-cash gifts. The February auction at the Boys Ranch was an example with such items as a grandfather clock, carved figurines, collectibles, guns, a brass

bed, oriental rug, baby stroller, antique secretary, and electric organ.

Although the Youth Ranches holds four auctions each year at the Boys Ranch, our three Opportunity Stores are open year-round, six days a week. There, you can find many unusual gifts. A recent stroll through the Opportunity Store in Live Oak revealed an antique iron bed with scroll-work, vintage clothing, collectible glassware, executive's desk, and a film projector among thousands of items for sale.


One of the biggest fund-raising projects for the Youth Ranches is non-cash donations. Gifts of new or used items have been vital to the Youth Ranches from the very beginning. It has and will continue to be one of the easiest ways a donor family member can help the boys and girls.

The non-cash department has grown from one person using a pickup truck, to its present staff of four people and numerous trucks, horse trailers, car and boat haulers, and tractor-trailers! Two field representatives travel the state collecting these useful items. When necessary, staff at the programs pitch in to help.

The Youth Ranches appreciate each and every gift. When possible, we use non-cash gifts within our programs. If not, the items are sold and the money is used as operating funds such as purchasing food and clothing for the boys and girls.

Gift Annuity . . . A Gift That Gives and Provides Payments For Life



What is a charitable gift annuity?

A charitable gift annuity is a gift to help troubled boys and girls in Florida while providing a guaranteed lifetime income for the donor.

It is an irrevocable agreement by which you make a gift to a qualified charitable organization and receive fixed payments for life. It is also a gift since part of the payment is given for a non-profit cause. Charitable gift annuities are recognized by state and federal authorities as a way to make a gift, and they have been around for many, many years.

The amount of income one receives is based upon the amount of the gift and the age of the donor. The older the donor, the higher the gift annuity rate.

A portion of the gift is immediately tax deductible as is a portion of the income.

Organizations issuing gift annuities are required by Florida law to meet precise financial standards and be registered. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in Florida to be issued a permit to write charitable gift annuities. The Youth Ranches permit number is DAAP-74-1. The Committee on Gift Annuities meets every three years to set the uniform annuity rates and the Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.
