

n March 15, 1994, I will relinquish my responsibilities and duties as President and Chief Executive Officer of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. C. T. O'Donnell II, whom the Board selected to be my successor and who has been employed since August 16, 1993, will assume President and Chief Executive Officer responsibilities for the agency.

Mr. O'Donnell, with his experience and talent, will be able to guide the agency to yet another productive plateau. To do this, however, he will need all our donor family's help — I have had your support, and I know that you will continue to support him in the agency's continuing effort to care for as many troubled boys and girls as financially possible.

With your continuing support, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches will keep as many boys and girls as possible from entering the criminal justice system — Florida Sheriffs' continuing goal to prevent juvenile delinquency.

Together, we have helped over 8,000 troubled boys and girls.

The Boys Ranch Alumni has just conducted a 1994 planning meeting that addressed their activities for the coming year and beyond, and after having sat in on this meeting, I can tell the world that all of our effort is and has been worth it. You have helped to save thousands of lives, and I get teary eyed at how many more, with your help, that we will save now and in the future.

I shall always be grateful to the Board for giving me the opportunity to serve the Youth Ranches in a leadership capacity. We have always been blessed with committed and dedicated staff, and my job has been easier and made to look good as a result.

I have greatly needed and appreciated the great support of the Board, Sheriffs, and staff, but nothing would have been possible without you, our donor family, giving of your time, resources, and talent. You have been very generous, kind, caring, and responsive.

I do not want to forget the important part that the boys and girls have played in helping us to be productive and with great quality. They have always come through with constructive ideas and solutions to our many challenges.

In my journey since 1961, we have not been able to accomplish all of our goals, but we did make considerable headway.

We did stay on target in keeping with our mission serving and saving the lives of as many troubled boys and girls and families as possible and primarily with voluntary gifts.

My official retirement from the agency does not take effect until on or about October 1, 1994. Therefore, I will not say so long, but only that we may meet another day either in person or by telephone or letter.

Thank you for a very enjoyable, challenging, and satisfying nearly 34-year journey.

# A Young Man and His Music


hen I think of Keith now, the first thing that pops into my mind is music. The next thing is his quiet style of selfassurance and inner happiness which can be seen in his walk and talk.

This was not always the case. Thinking back to when Keith first arrived at the Boys Ranch, I recall that he could have been described as sullen and reserved; an angry young man who had difficulty accepting adult authority. He also had poor academic skills.

These issues and more were addressed in the goals Keith was encouraged to set for himself when he entered the Boys Ranch. On top of the list, was to become a leader, not a follower, and he has long since achieved this goal through the structure, guidance, and opportunities offered to him at the Ranch. He now seeks new opportunities to demonstrate his confidence and leadership skills.

Prior to coming to the Boys Ranch, Keith lacked adult male role models, but he found many at the Ranch such as his cottage father, a social worker, and teachers. However, he recently said that Harvey "Pop" Bues had the most significant impact on his life by giving him much encouragement, and by creating in him a desire to try harder.

Mr. Bues hired Keith for his first, and only, oncampus job in the Arts and Crafts Center. There Keith learned that commitment, patience, and determination pays off. Laughingly, he recalls that, "there were days, I know, Mr. Bues wanted to hang me out to dry. Sometimes I didn't like Mr.





Bues very much either, but we always worked through our differences. I learned I could count on him."


By the time Keith resigned his campus position



in order to take a part-time job in town, he was the Assistant Supervisor and had five other Ranchers working under him. His leadership ability — now refined — began to emerge in all areas of his life.

In his freshman year of high school, Keith discovered a love of music. He enrolled in the high school orchestra and band where he learned to play the trombone. Now in his senior year, Keith is the first chair and section leader of the trombones. He has participated in several district and state contests and has come away with medals for solo, ensemble, and marching performances.

Keith's love of music grew, and with that, a desire to tackle other instruments such as the piano and saxophone. Self-taught, he spends his free time picking out notes and fine-tuning scales in the



Ranch Chapel. He has tried his hand at writing music, but admits he "hasn't quite got it down pat."

Although Keith has other interests, music is his first love. His hectic schedule of school and study also includes band practices, playing in the band at football games, as well as holding down a part-time job. He has little time for relaxation.

When asked "What do you do to unwind?" Keith stated, "I listen to music. Classical is my favorite, but I enjoy other sounds too." He admits the guys in his cottage give him a hard time now and then about the classical thing. "But that's okay," Keith said. "I feel the emotion in music, and it motivates me. Music is a part of life and life is music."

Keith is also a leader at school. He is a peer counselor, and upon graduation this spring, plans to pursue his musical studies at a nearby universi-

The once angry youngster is now a happy, well-adjusted young man who has learned to meet challenges head-on. His years of work have paid off in terms of his current achievements and, hopefully, will lead him on to a successful career and family life.


## **GIVING HIS ALL**

hey say there's a special bond between a boy and his dog, but what about a girl and her cat? The answer is obvious once you have met Stacie and Tigger.

Stacie and Tigger are both residents at the Youth Villa near Bartow. Stacie is a tall, blond, 16-year old young lady who attends school, enjoys her friends and is working on the goals of her Youth Growth Plan. Tigger, on the other hand, is only about three. She's a grey and black tabby that loves to cat-nap, explore new places and purr to her heart's content.

No one is really sure whether Stacie has adopted Tigger or Tigger has adopted Stacie, but all agree that their "bonding" is the best thing that has ever happened to them.

Tigger was originally the responsibility of another Youth Villa resident, and when that relationship broke up, Stacie immediately seized the opportunity



to become Tigger's caretaker. She feeds her, brushes her, and plays with her.

"I just love this cat," said Stacie. "She's a part of my life, and I am responsible for her. I have never, not once, forgotten to feed her. She is counting on me and that makes me feel good."

Cats have always been an important part of Stacie's life. She believes they understand her,

> know what she's thinking, and always try to make her feel better. She recalled getting hurt as a child when she tried to break up a cat fight. She ended up crying, and the kitten she had rescued came to the door and cried too. "It was like she was saying she was sorry. She knew I was hurt, and wanted to make me feel better. Ever since then I have loved cats," Stacie explained.

> Stacie and Tigger really share a special bond. She truly loves animals and has developed a strong sense of responsibility for this critter. Unit Social Worker Kathy Waldrep recalls a night when it was "raining cats and dogs," and Stacie was quite worried about Tigger. She feared the cat was wet, cold, hungry and alone. Stacie finished her dinner, chores and homework; and kept waiting for the rain to


subside. Finally, she threw on her raincoat and crossed the campus calling for Tigger. Soon the cat ran out to meet her, knowing full well that safety, comfort, food and love were soon to follow.

"It's amazing," added Ms. Waldrep. "This cat only responds to her voice, and Stacie takes great pride in that. Whenever we speak of Tigger, a big grin just crosses her face. This cat has turned this kid around."

Tigger has "been there" for Stacie, too. Often, the attention and affection the cat demands is exactly what Stacie needs herself. When she is with Tigger,

she is not lonely. While taking excellent care of the cat, she is also taking better care of herself, and she is learning to control her temper, even when Tigger does something wrong. "I could never hurt her," Stacie explains. "She's too little and helpless. Most of all she needs me."

Stacie is learning to budget the money she earns on campus so she can buy special treats for Tigger. That's how Tigger got a new collar for Christmas. "Its green and has a little bell on it so I can find her faster," said Stacie. "She looks great in green! Tigger is my responsibility, and I will take care of her."



Raising Tigger is a chore, but Stacie's efforts are not wasted. If she continues to care for her pet the way she has in the past, there is a good possibility she will be allowed to keep Tigger when she graduates from the program. "Tigger is like a part of my family," said Stacie. "The only difference is she's here with me. No matter what I do, I know I'll always have Tigger."

Tigger has helped Stacie to learn about trust and commitment — to also develop self-confidence and a positive self-image. Moreover, she is determined to make the right choices and show responsible behavior. The "new Stacie" is motivated and enthusiastic about her future.

# **SUCCESS STORY**


quick glance at Charles Myers' background reveals that he graduated from North Miami High School with a 3.0 grade point average; received three meritorious promotions within the first three years of a 12-year career in the United States Marine Corps; and is currently the Dade County Marketing Director for Prudential Florida Realty. Quite an impressive background for this young, assertive executive who continues to scale the corporate ladder of success. His good nature and selfconfidence may lead one to believe that this was all a part of a well-orchestrated plan. However, a closer look reveals otherwise.

Charles recalls that his father walked out of his life when he was eight. In the following three years,

he was shuffled around like a checker on a checker board. He lived in many different places, including a foster home, and finally found his proper niche at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

By the time he arrived at the Ranch, he was angry and rebellious. He didn't trust anyone or anything. "When I first arrived at the Boys Ranch, I was constantly in trouble. I kept everything inside and was ready to explode," said Charles. However, the Boys Ranch offered him the stability and opportunity he needed. He soon calmed down and adjusted to the life of a Rancher.


In 1972, Charles was invited to spend Thanksgiving with the Grant Gravitt family in Miami. Proper arrangements and approvals were completed, and he was given an opportunity to experience

a typical family holiday. The visit went so well that he was invited back for Christmas, but fate and his unhappy past intervened.

Shortly before Christmas, his natural mother (whom he had not seen since he was three) resurfaced. She wanted him to join her family for Christmas in New York. He agreed, and spent ten days with her family in New York. At the end of the visit, when they asked him to stay with them, he declined. Things just didn't feel right. Since then he has lost touch with his relatives, but is satisfied with his decision. "I loved the Boys Ranch," he said. "I had figured I would stay there until I was 18." After all, things were going well for him, and he knew the

Ranch would provide opportunities to improve his life.

The following summer the Gravitts again invited Charles to their home for a visit. He spent three weeks with them and had a terrific time. He seemed to fit well into their family, and so, when they invited him to come live with them on a permanent basis, he accepted.

Later that year they became his foster family legally, and his real family in his heart. "For me, family is a lot more than blood," Charles explained. "Birth doesn't make someone a good mother or father. You have to build a relationship."

While living with the Gravitts, Charles graduated from high school and joined the Marines. His entrance scores made him eligible for the Officers Candidate Program, but he opted for the conventional training of a Marine recruit. After boot camp on Paris Island, he quickly moved up in the ranks and became a Tank Commander in a relatively short time. Later he qualified as an Air Traffic Controller.

"I felt like one of the luckiest Marines alive given my station assignments," Charles recalled. "Southern California and then Hawaii, it just doesn't get any better than that."

Charles left the military after more than 12 years of service. Due to the down-sizing of the armed forces, he felt it was time to move on.

He returned to Florida, settled in Miami and spent the next 15 months as a licensed real estate

broker for The Prudential Florida Realty Company. He advanced to Advertising Director, and is now Marketing Director for Dade County.

Charles admits he has achieved numerous goals, yet, he believes there are still challenges ahead. The Boys Ranch was a much-needed stepping stone — a haven — for this once troubled boy. In retrospect, he is grateful to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches for providing him with the stability and the opportunities to make good decisions in his life.

In looking to the future, Charles is determined to provide his young daughter with the stability, consistency and love he once lacked. "She is a lot like me," he said proudly. "I want her to know I will always be there for her. I am very comfortable with what we have been able to show her and teach her. You try to instill values and morals, and then if she falls, you are there to pick her up."

Despite his early experiences, Charles has been able to observe, learn and now practice good parenting skills. No doubt the role models he had at the Boys Ranch and in his subsequent placement with the Gravitts, provided him with plenty of opportunities to learn. Since 1957, thousands of troubled youngsters have had similar experiences.

wish I knew the name of the police officer that suggested I contact the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch," recalls Wenona. "His suggestion made all the difference in the world."

Frustrated and alone, she had been struggling with her teenage son's truancy and troubled behavior. "He slept in class, and was bored with school," she said. "I knew he could do it because he was a gifted student. It was more of a challenge to him to beat the system rather than work within it. Sometimes he would just take off for two or three days in a row. I was so worried about the people he was with, and the trouble they could get in."

Wenona continued: "I was filing another runaway report on him when that officer suggested the Sheriffs Ranch. I had already tried crisis centers, the Youth Services Bureau, and the Where to Turn book. With no insurance, there are very few options."

The next day she contacted her local Sheriff's


Office who put her in touch with the Youth Ranches Family Social Worker (FSW) in her area. FSW Arlene Boumel worked with Wenona, and determined that Jeremy was indeed eligible for Youth Ranches program services.

Through continued contact with the family, Mrs. Boumel processed a "Request for Service" application form. She met the family in their home, and discussed the problems and potential solutions.

Initially, Jeremy refused to consider participating in a Youth Ranches program, but after this meeting he

changed his mind. "I saw it as a chance to start over," he said. "It was a new place, a new beginning." Obtaining his agreement to voluntary placement was essential to the admission process.

After Mrs. Boumel completed the necessary paper work, Jeremy and his family made a campus visit to the Boys Ranch near Live Oak, and he was approved for admission.

Unfortunately, all of the available beds were filled, and Jeremy was placed on a waiting list. During this time, the Family Services staff continued to meet with the family to provide counseling and parenting classes. She also networked with other social service agencies to nurture the family and keep it intact.

When Jeremy was finally accepted as a resident at the Boys Ranch, it was hard on Wenona and the other children to see him go, but they knew it was the best alternative for him. "I still worry about him," Wenona said recently, "but I feel I have good communication with the Ranch. He has good male role models there, and it was the best decision to let him go."

Mrs. Boumel continues to visit the family monthly, providing counseling and support. Wenona is working hard on her goals, and has successfully completed the parenting class twice. The counseling and support Wenona received gave her the confidence and reassurance to continue on with the children still at home.




# PUTTING THE PIECES TOGETHER -A YOUTH GROWTH PLAN



ach child that enters one of our residential programs comes with a unique combination of problems. Often times these enormous obstacles overlap into many areas of their lives. For example, a boy that is struggling with appropriate social growth and does not know how to accept responsibility or adult supervision may, consequently, experience problems in school that will hinder his educational growth.

The Youth Ranches programs utilize a multifaceted approach to help youngsters identify areas of concern upon which they need to concentrate. This Youth Growth Plan targets desirable components or categories that promote the overall wellness and healthy development of an individual. Specific problems in each area are identified jointly by the youth, the family and the Social Worker. Measurable and attainable goals are set, with quarterly reviews to evaluate as well as celebrate the youth's personal growth and achievements.

- 1. PHYSICAL GROWTH: Nutrition, hygiene, clothing, fitness, substance abuse prevention, sex education ...
- **2. SOCIAL GROWTH:** Accepting responsibility; resolving conflicts; maintaining desirable relationships with adults, peers, family, and authority figures; developing respect for others . . .
- 3. EMOTIONAL GROWTH: Sense of selfworth/belonging; awareness of personal/cultural




heritage; identifying with program, community, and country; handling anger/disappointment appropriately ...


4. MORAL/SPIRITUAL GROWTH: Sense of right/wrong (conscience), respect for God, personal spirituality, respect for beliefs of others, forgiveness toward wrongdoers . . .

5. EDUCATIONAL/VOCATIONAL GROWTH: Good study skills and habits, organizes and completes assignments, appropriate school behavior, positive extracurricular activity, passing school grades, vocational testing and work readiness skills ...

6. WORK/CAREER SKILLS: Successful performance of work tasks, punctuality/dependability, accepts supervision, money management, personal skills and marketing of self . . .

7. LEISURE TIME ACTIVITIES: Learning of lifetime recreation skills/hobbies, participation in group/individual activities, good sportsmanship and team skills . . .





Typically, our youth are experiencing difficulty in at least half, if not all, of these areas. Their active participation in the development of their individualized plan creates a sense of ownership which, hopefully, will further motivate them. Our trained and caring staff is there to help them every step of the way.

Every piece of the pie is important. Each component is linked to the others. Consequently, success in one area often leads to immediate improvement in another. When an overweight, depressed teen focuses on proper diet and physical exercise, they typically experience weight loss, which elevates their self-esteem and improves their level of social skills and emotional security. This comprehensive plan enables our youth to face and conquer problems that have suffocated their lives for so very long.

Their achievements, through their individualized Youth Growth Plan, serve as a constant reminder of where they have been, how they are doing now, and, most importantly, where they can go in the future.

# Charitable Gift Annuity



The charitable gift annuity allows you to give to our troubled boys and girls and also provides you and/or someone you designate with a guaranteed periodic payment for life.

A sizeable portion of your gift (cash, stocks, bonds or mutual funds) is immediately tax deductible and a portion of the periodic annuity payment is tax-free during normal life expectancy. The agreement is irrevocable and is guaranteed by the full assets of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

The amount of the annuity payment is based on the amount of the gift and the age of the annuitant. Typically, the older you are, the greater the payment.

Organizations that are permitted to issue gift annuity agreements are required by state and federal law to meet stringent financial standards. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in the state of Florida to receive this permit "No. DAAP-74-1."

The committee on Gift Annuities meets approximately every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.







# "Woman, 87, wants to go to jail"


ow, why would anybody want to go to jail! Especially, a creaky senior citizen, well-cared for in a state-of-the-art retirement home. But, retiring doesn't need to mean "giving up on living." The world is so full of interesting and wonderful things to see and do that I don't want to miss anything. Time is running out on me. I have a lot of catching up to do.

So when the announcement was made that the newly completed jail in Suwannee County would have an Open House and that any person wishing to make a donation could spend the night in the jail as the guest of Sheriff Leonard and the County Commissioners, I wasted no time signing up. The beneficiary was the various Ranches sustained by the Sheriffs' organizations around the state for disadvantaged young people.

I was greeted at the entrance by deputies/guards; Mary Cundiff, the Administratrix; and the Sheriff himself. Mary suggested a wheelchair would be easier to maneuver through the crowd than my walker, and one immediately appeared. Mary was everywhere. She hovered over me like a mother hen; got me registered; saw that I had refreshments (delicious!); arranged a tour of the jail; and — oh yes, assisted with my "mug shot."

On and off during the afternoon, Kangaroo Court was held in the TV room. Prominent citizens were summoned, one by one, to answer "charges" brought by the judge, and to pay a penalty. I was not privy to the significance of the charges, but there was no mistaking the howls of laughter that greeted each verdict.

We were served supper on heavy covered plastic

trays: a well-balanced meal with generous portions, more than we could eat. After supper the area was much quieter, the crowd had gone and only about 25 or 30 people chose to spend the night.

The cells are large, light, and airy. There are no bars on doors or windows. Every room is glassed in, affording easy surveillance from anywhere in the cellblock. There is no place to hide, for whatever purpose. Privacy? What's that?

Accommodations are less than minimal, and are securely fastened down, including the bed. If these beds are an example of what awaits the subsequent residents of the jail, I can only say, nothing, but nothing else ever in the world, would be as effective in keeping me on the straight and narrow and out of any jail, hereafter.
