As we begin 1995, I would like to take a moment to thankfully reflect back, and express my sincere gratitude to all of you who helped make 1994 such a special year. Your strong support of our children was evident in the tremendous outpouring of gifts throughout the holiday season. Thank you so much for investing in the future of deserving boys and girls.

This year, we are extremely excited about several new opportunities to serve even more youngsters throughout Florida.

At the Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota we are moving forward with the construction of a second home for troubled boys. The Sotatee Cottage, which will be completed this summer, will enable us to double the number of youth cared for at that site.

At the same time, a special gift from a caring couple will also provide us with a staff house on that campus to ensure a warm, nurturing child-care environment.

In another part of the state, we are preparing to break ground for the third campsite at Caruth Camp near Inglis/Yankeetown. The loyal members of the

Florida Bermuda Moose Association have generously pledged their continuing support of the Wilderness Camping Program.

In South Florida, we recently celebrated the Grand Opening of our fourth Opportunity Store located in Del-ray Beach. These stores provide our donor family with an additional convenient and unique way to help the boys and girls in our care.

It is exciting to be in a position to help so many more of Florida's needy, neglected or abused youth. There are so many of them that need our help and guidance and their needs are so great. Thank you for being such an important part of this growing effort to prevent juvenile delinquency.

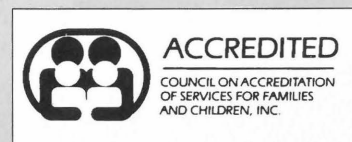
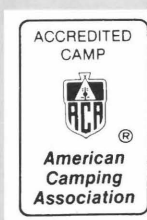

Harry K. Weaver Endowment Moves Closer To Goal

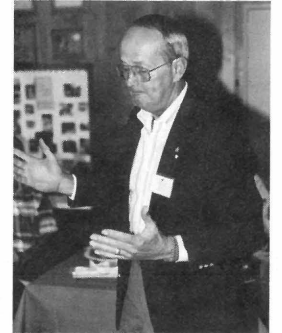

In the rolling green fields of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa, soft, balmy breezes run from the lake, while patches of marigolds paint vast meadows with soft, velvety hues of yellow. The strong sunshine warms the soul and spirit, melting winter into spring; uncovering signs that a new season has arrived.

In her five years at the Youth Villa near Bartow, 18-year old Marion has witnessed the turning of the seasons, and has watched her life change with each new blossom. Arriving at the Youth Villa a young teenager with a weak educational background, Marion initially experienced difficulties in school. But, through making the necessary adjustments, and by working diligently over the last few years, she currently maintains an "A" average at Roosevelt Vocational School for "exceptional" students.

"We owe a lot of her success to her siblings," sites Director of Education Dot Bowers. "In the unique Villa setting, we were able to keep the family unit together. It was an extreme advantage having Mari-

on's two sisters also in the Villa program."

Marion has recently discovered a very special hobby. Because of the unusually large number of deaf students enrolled in Marion's school, she wished to explore the possibilities of communicating properly with her peers. That strong desire sparked her interest in sign language and also provided the backbone

for forging new friendships.

"There is a deaf girl on our cheerleading team," says Marion. "Since I'm the Captain, it is my responsibility to teach her any new 'cheers,' that's why I got interested in signing."

Marion's eagerness, influence, and determination fuels her spirit. Currently, she is spreading her newfound "language" through Dorista Cottage at the Villa, instructing some of the residents on the intricate alphabet and other common phrases.

"We've all been working on a song," says Marion, "it's called 'Love In Any Language.'"

Indeed, it is!



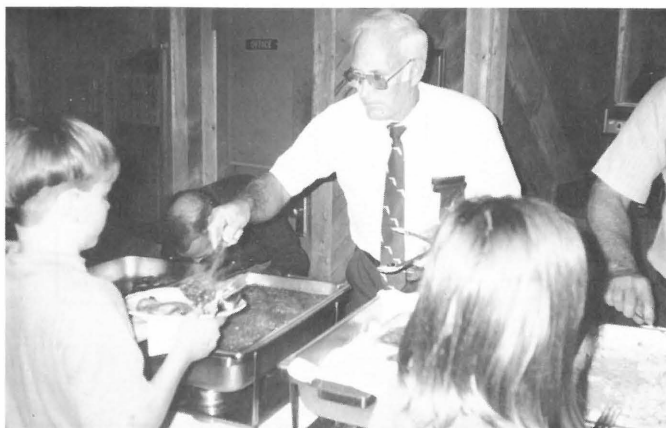

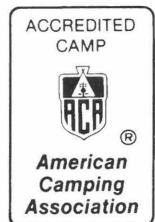

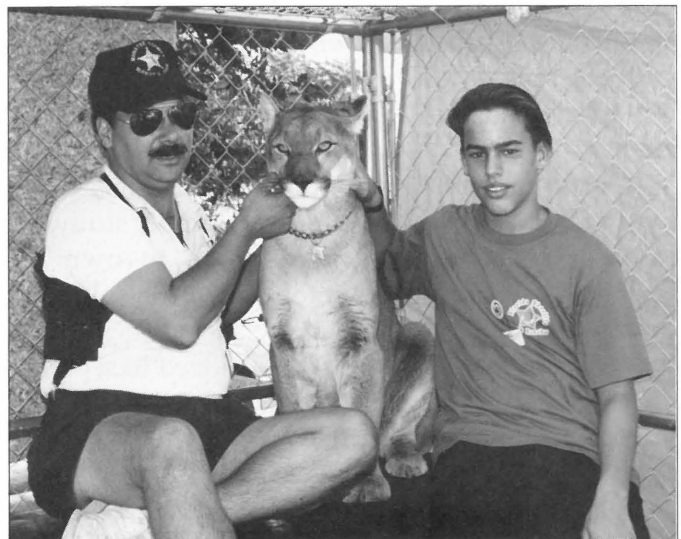
Reeling in Support for Youth Ranches

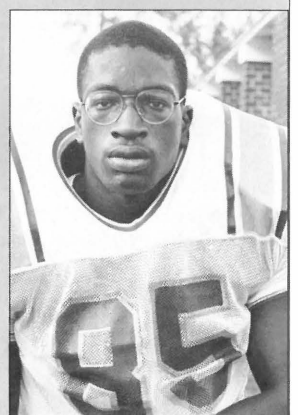

Bye For Now, But Not Forever

Birds whistle through the pines of a dense forest, rustling brown needles with their feathery wings back to the soil below where young boys hum songs of soft melodies that bring smiles, laughter, friendship, and trust. These boys, with their firm jaws and once heavy hearts, are seizing a second chance, a fresh start at a new and improved life . . . this is the therapeutic, wilderness camping program known as Caruth Camp.

When young boys arrive in this natural setting, it becomes a place to heal the hurt of the past — it is a place where very troubled youngsters can work through their problems. The approximately 30 boys who enter this unique program annually often suffer from behavioral problems and major obstacles that prevent them from functioning

properly in everyday society. Their challenges often include illiteracy, emotional handicaps, abuse, violent behavior, poor language skills, lack of mathematics skills, and negative relationships with authority figures and peers.

Four years ago, a young boy of 12 arrived at the Caruth Camp for help, guidance, and new direction. Like many of the young boys that cry out for help today, Michael was burdened with some of the problems of typical Caruth residents.

But, Michael became one of the lucky ones. After three productive years in the wilderness program, he graduated and returned home. Currently, he is living a happier, healthier life and can look forward to a brighter future. Michael recently wrote the Caruth Camp a letter updating his positive progress.

Dear Caruth Camp,

What's up? Not much here. I sometimes wish I were still at camp. I will try to visit ya'll. I will be getting my license soon now that I'm sixteen. When will you all be taking another trip?

"Chief Steve" - When are you going to come down and go fishing? I miss you.

"Chief Jerry" - What's up? Not much here. I miss you. Tell everyone I said "hi."

*"Chief Nate" - Hey, what is up? Eating well, gaining weight. I miss you, **bye for now.***

"Mrs. Powers" - How are you? I am fine. I miss working with you. Give me a call.

*"Mr. Albiero" - So, how is everything going? I miss you. You helped me out a lot, I am an A/B student. **Bye for now.***

*"Mom Judi" - You helped me out a lot, too. I miss you. **Bye for now.***

*"Mom Sandy" - How are you? I am glad that we met. Thank you for all that you did to help me out. **Bye for now.***

"Mr. Feldstein" - I like the song that you played for me. I am doing good here in my life. I have had a few problems, but the camp helped me with problemsolving so everything

*is going O. K. I miss you. **Bye for now.***

"Mr. Wolf" - I miss you a lot. I still have the coin you gave me. I carry it everywhere I go.

*"Trailblazers" - Work hard on your goals, respect authority. For those who don't know me, I was in Trailblazers for almost two years. I'm at home now, so work on your goals and you can be, too. **Bye for now.***

"Pioneers" - I did not spend much time in Pioneers but I would just like to say "hi" and work on your goals, too.

*"Mr. Thiboo" - I am taking Tae-Kwon-Do. I am a "green" belt with one blue stripe. Give me a call. **Bye for now.***

*"Mr. Sharbrush" - What's up? I lost your number, but if you give it to me again I will call you. O. K.? **Bye for now.***

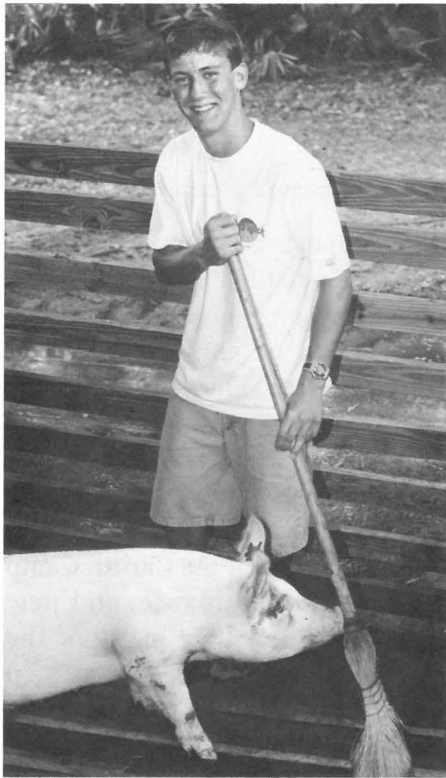
If I forgot anyone, I'm sorry. Just write me and I'll write you back.

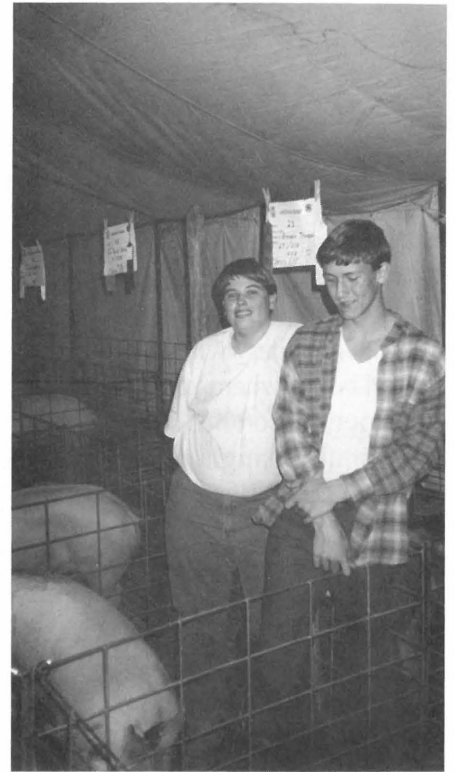

Springing to Life at Boys Ranch

Springtime is typically a season of rebirth at the Boys Ranch/Live Oak — deep, plush fields grow greener; blossoming trees provide a haven for young birds and offer shade to young boys harvesting new crops; and newborn calves roam the land, chewing blades of grass and looking to mother's milk for nourishment.

In late December each year, "Calving Season" closes at the Ranch. As the temperatures gradually warm, newborn calves are raised and nurtured to become an intricate part of the true, working Ranch.

Welcome Home Paul, You Will Always Be One of Our Boys

The card simply read, "In case of emergency, please contact Harry K. Weaver, Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch."

With a heavy heart full of tragic news, the Florida State Trooper made that call, to a place former Rancher Paul Clenton Hutto once called home. "Hutto . . . Paul Hutto," replied Mr. Weaver sadly, shaking his head. "Yes, I remember him well . . . strong work ethic, great horsemanship skills . . . of course, we will take care of him. He will always be one of our boys."

Thirty-five year old Paul Hutto, who lost his life in an automobile accident on November 6, 1994, was quickly returned to the place he loved so dearly. His children, family, former Ranchers, and friends gathered at the Clay County Maverick Riding Arena, located on the Boys Ranch campus, to pay tribute to this man who embraced the principles he learned on the Ranch.

A true horseman, Paul's farrier tools and saddle were displayed proudly at the memorial. They helped tell the story of his life.

Following the service, Ranchers and alumni alike mounted-up to lead a riderless horse one final time through the green pastures of the Boys Ranch. This mov-

ing tribute brought to mind Psalm 23:

He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: He leadeth me beside the still waters.

He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

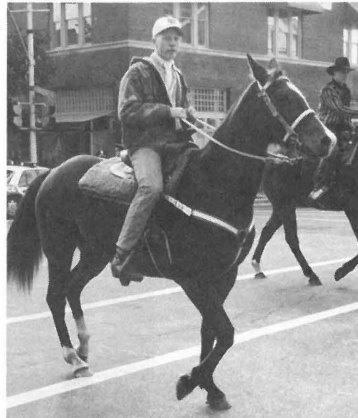
