



oung boys from around the state live at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch near Live Oak. Many come from large, crowded cities and have never had the opportunity to see a "real" working farm. Arthur and Jaime are two such boys who work on the farm at the Boys Ranch. Under the careful and experienced guidance of the Farm Manager, the pair has learned that hard work and dedication are required to be a part of the Boys Ranch farm.





Diligently helping to care for horses, goats, chickens, and cattle, the boys can earn the privilege of raising a steer or heifer to exhibit as part of the 4-H Spring Livestock Show at the Suwannee County Fair. This is no easy undertaking as the animal is not tame when this process starts. The boys must continue

their jobs on the farm in addition to caring for their animals. The experience begins in October, and ends at the livestock judging in March. The boys learn they must make a commitment, set a goal, and work hard to follow the project through to the end. Arthur and Jaime will have spent many hours of their free time working with their steer or heifer. The boys train the animal to wear a halter, walk on a lead line, and stand for inspection and judging during the livestock show.

Jaime carefully adjusts the halter on "Snow White," his Charolais heifer.



Raising a steer or heifer teaches the boys self-sacrifice. Instead of a warm, quiet indoor activity, the boys spend much of their free time in the damp cold of a gray winters day teaching the cow how to walk and stand for judging. But, by the time the boys load their animal onto the trailer bound for the fair-grounds this spring, the cows will be as tame as a pet! This is a time when the boys are especially proud. They can see the result of their hard work and diligent efforts.

Jaime was very eager to show off the progress he has made with his two heifers. One is a Charolais named "Snow White", the other is a Simbrah-Braford cross named "Baby." Jaime is grateful for the opportunities he has had at the Boys Ranch, "I really

like being here. It has taught me responsibility and helped me like school. Before, I didn't care about school at all, I hardly ever went." Jaime looks forward to spending time with his heifers, he has done a great job of taming them and teaching them to walk and obey his commands.

Arthur has also been quite successful with his work at the farm. He is the 1996 winner of the Carleton F. Tweed Memorial Award for outstanding horsemanship. Arthur hopes to be as successful with his steer as he has been with his horse.

Of course, not every steer or heifer will win at the show, but Arthur and Jaime have committed themselves to this project and are putting forth their best effort. With much encouragement and support, the boys know they have succeeded because they did their best to meet their goal. Completing the task and appearing at the Steer and Heifer Show will be a tremendous reward. Winning at the Fair would be the icing on the cake!

ne of the traditions emphasized at the Youth Ranches is a strong work ethic. All of the boys and girls in residential care are assigned daily chores. After their schoolwork is finished the youth are responsible for doing their laundry, keeping their room clean, emptying trash, washing dishes, and other general household duties.

Additionally, all youth in residential care have an on-campus job for which they earn a wage. The boys and girls may work in an office performing custodial duties such as emptying trash and clean-


ing. Some may work in the cafeteria helping out after lunch to clean-up tables, wash dishes, and mop the floors. At the Boys Ranch, youth also have the option to help on a

real working farm. This is especially appealing to those boys who are fond of animals and enjoy the outdoors.

Occasionally, we have youngsters who go above and beyond what is expected or required of them. Two of these exceptional ranchers are Dawn and Roy. In addition to school, their on-campus jobs, and cottage duties, both Dawn and Roy manage to include jobs at local restaurants in their busy schedules.




Dawn carefully fills an order for the next customer.



A Photo ID...it's the Sheriff and Me!

For many years, Cora Seifert had heard her neighbor Richard Thornton speak about the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. He told her about the great work being done to prevent juvenile delinquency and showed her a copy of THE RANCHER magazine. He even told her about the income he received through the Youth Ranches Gift Annuity program. Mr. Thornton was so interested in helping children, he quietly told Cora he made plans for one final gift to the boys and girls through his estate planning.

Cora trusted Richard and knew he gave good advice. So in 1991, she celebrated her 85th birthday by purchasing her own Gift Annuity. This not only provides her with a steady stream of income and a tax deduction, it also helped deserving youngsters have a new start in life.

After his death in 1994, Cora learned Richard had been true to his word. Mr. Thornton had been very generous and left a substantial gift to continue saving young lives. After careful thought, Cora decided to follow in Richard's footsteps. She called an attorney and arranged to include the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches in her will.

Not knowing Ms. Seifert personally, the attorney requested she bring along a photo ID. You can imagine his surprise when she arrived with an 8 x 10 photograph of herself with Lee County Sheriff John McDougall. The photo was taken when he presented her with a plaque representing Lifetime Honorary Membership in the Florida Sheriffs Association. If the attorney didn't believe her, he could just call Sheriff McDougall. Needless to say her identification was complete and her will finalized right way!



In 1996, Cora asked if the Youth Ranches could do something special to remember Richard. She thought it would be nice if a tree could be planted in his memory at the Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota. As plans for this tribute were made, it seemed fitting to plant two neighboring trees, side by side; one in memory of Richard Thornton, and the other in honor of Cora Wakeman Seifert's 90th birthday.



First impressions last a long time. Young Ranchers learned the value of this lesson recently when the newly elected Sheriffs visited the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch. As a part of their training and orientation, the Sheriffs-Elect witnessed some of the long-standing history and traditions of "Florida's Charity for Florida's Children."

By discovering and understanding the strong connection between this delinquency prevention child care program, Florida's 67 Sheriffs, and the Florida Sheriffs Association, the Sheriffs-Elect had the opportunity to get directly involved with the boys and girls at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Led by over 8 veteran Sheriffs including the President of the Florida Sheriffs Association Sarasota County Sheriff Geoffrey Monge and the Chairman of

the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Board of Directors Polk County Sheriff Lawrence W. Crow, Jr., the newly elected Sheriffs could see the commitment and responsibility of Florida's Sheriffs to help these deserving youngsters.

When the formal training was complete, Sheriffs-Elect were given a grand tour of the Boys Ranch. Each group was led by a young Rancher who had earned the privilege of escorting the special guests on campus.

They visited the Elvis Presley House, which is the current headquarters for the Boys Ranch Alumni Association, and met Alumni Association President Bill Riggins. Each group stopped in Saunders Cottage to see firsthand where the boys eat, sleep, and live. Saunders Cottage was the first cottage built on the Boys Ranch in 1958 and was named in memory of former Pinellas County Sheriff Sid M. Saunders.

The next stop was the Beck Memorial Learning Center. Over half of the boys in residence attend this




The Young and Young at Heart


Thank you, Universal Studios!


Boys Ranch welcomes newly elected Sheriffs as Honorary Ranchers!
