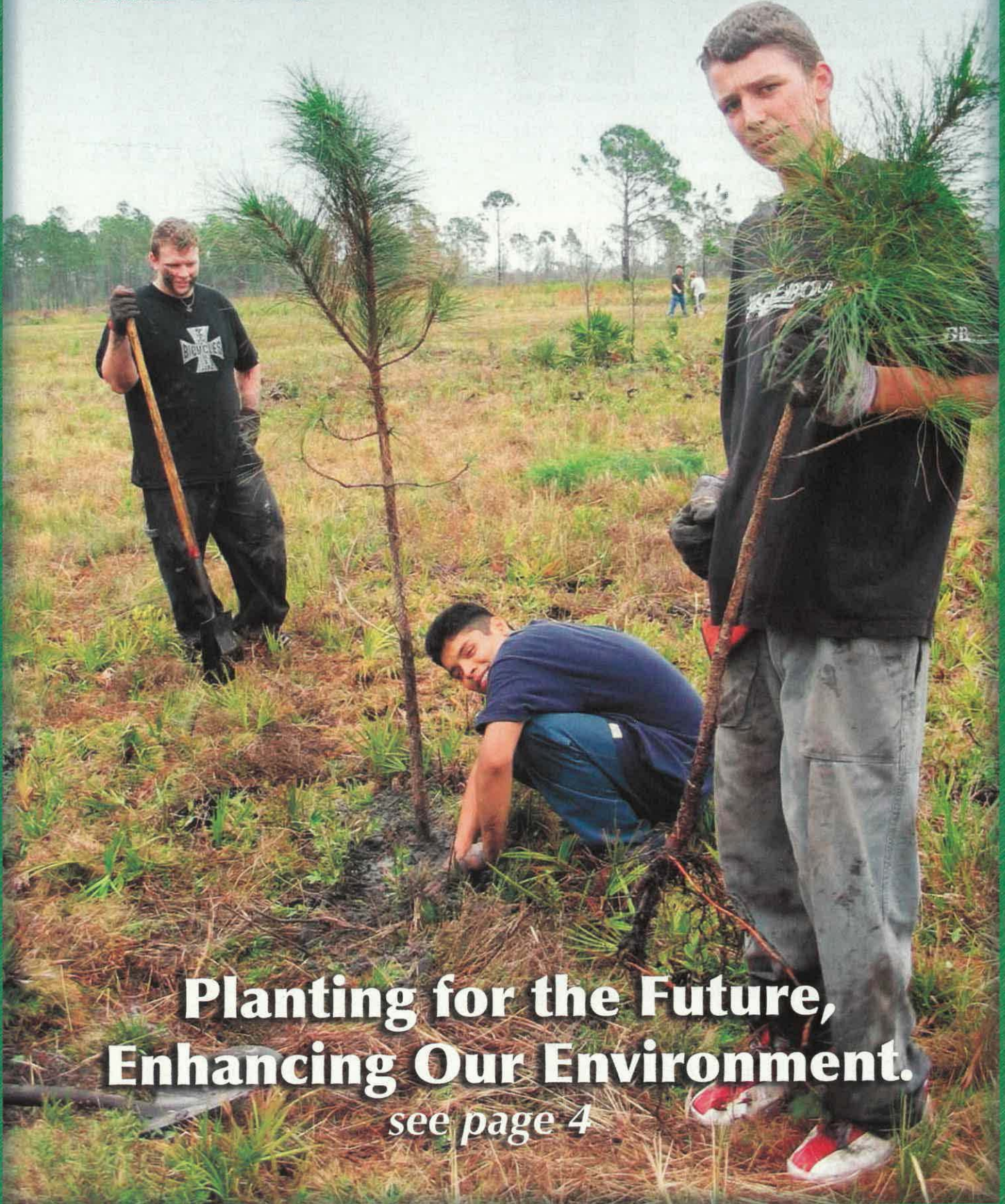

We always celebrate the small, but significant steps of progress in the children we serve. Your concern, prayers and faithful support help us educate and raise so many boys and girls.

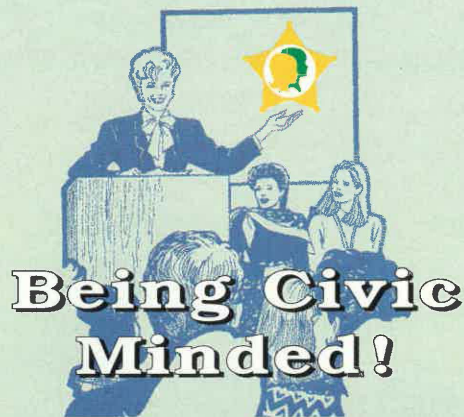

# Planting For The Future, Enhancing Our Environment

## Working Together, Helping an Endangered Species!



**H**ow many teenage boys are willing to spend four hours on a Saturday afternoon digging holes for free? The answer at the Youth Ranch in Bradenton/Sarasota is 12...six more than requested!

The reason for this strong showing of volunteerism is two fold – the boys wanted to build a future habitat for an endangered species, and the other, a surprisingly candid reply... “I did it because I like to work,” said Ricky, age 15. “It makes me feel good to know I have accomplished something every day. I want to become a mechanic and have my own shop. If you own a business, you better like hard work!”

Six boys were selected to join four adults out at the 90 acre facility owned by the Lemur Conservation Foundation. Lemurs are primitive primates with big eyes, long noses along with very flexible fingers and toes. Some types are listed as an endangered species and are found naturally on the Island of Madagascar, located off the southeast coast of Africa.

The Foundation cares for 20 Lemurs received from various zoo communities and focuses their efforts on scientific research and education. Eventually, they want to reintroduce the animals to the wild. In planning for future habitat needs, they needed to transplant 55 slash pine saplings



to a large parcel of land and sought some volunteer help to complete the project.

“We were protecting an endangered species and making them a place to live...that’s cool!” said Mike. “I knew I wouldn’t get paid, but I did it anyway. I really don’t mind getting dirty. It was really fun.”

For four hours, the boys and adults dug holes and planted pines. Anthony claimed they did a whole lot of digging. “I am now an expert at working with a post-hole digger.” Brian, a polite young man from Cape Coral was very eager to help. He hopes to train horses when he gets older so he knows there will be plenty of hard work in his future.

Each of these young men earned something more valuable than a paycheck. They learned the value of something given to others in need.





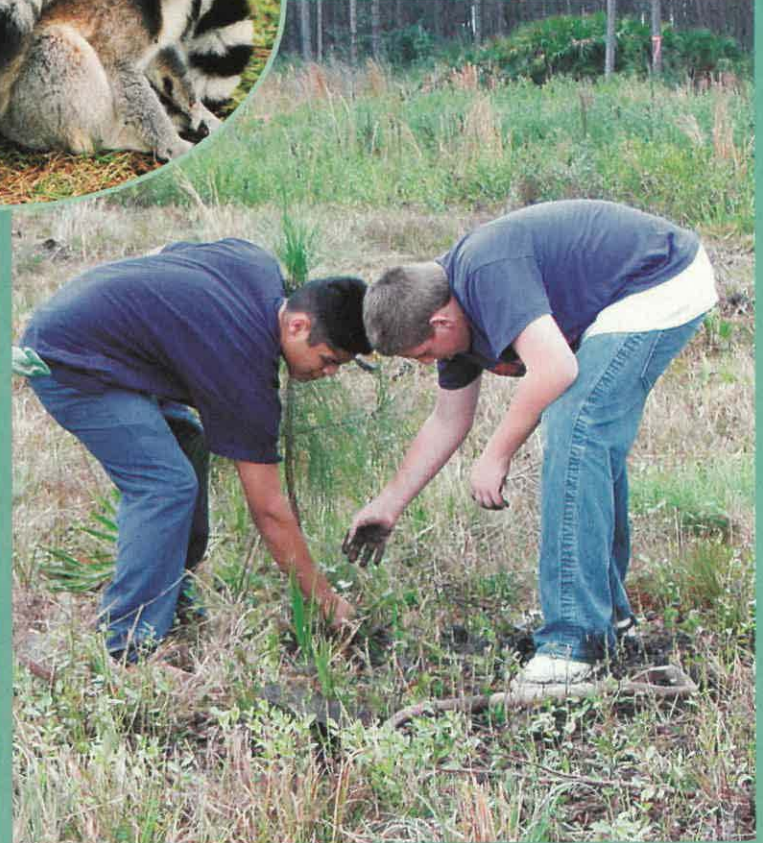
These four Lemurs showed a special curiosity and interest in the work being done by the boys from the Youth Ranch.



All the volunteers are proud of the newly planted pines which will, one day, be a future habitat for many adorable little Lemur critters.

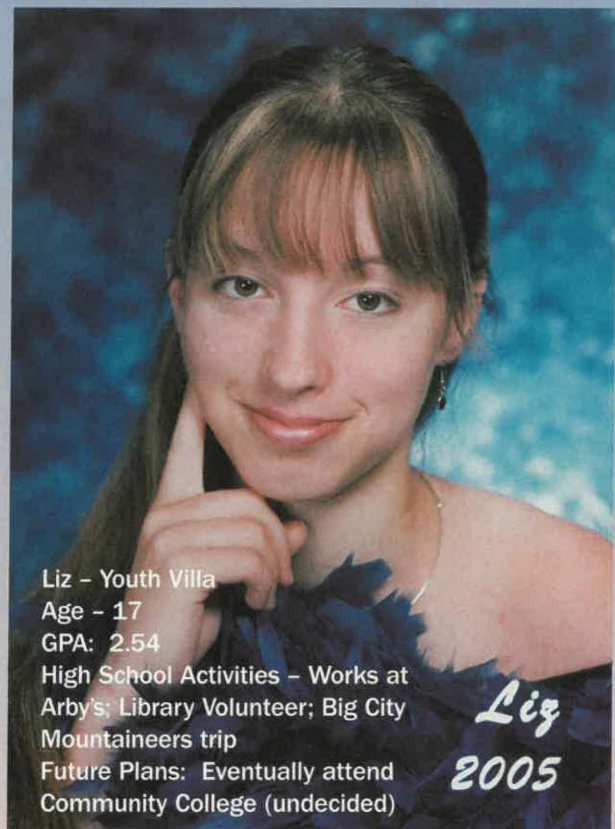
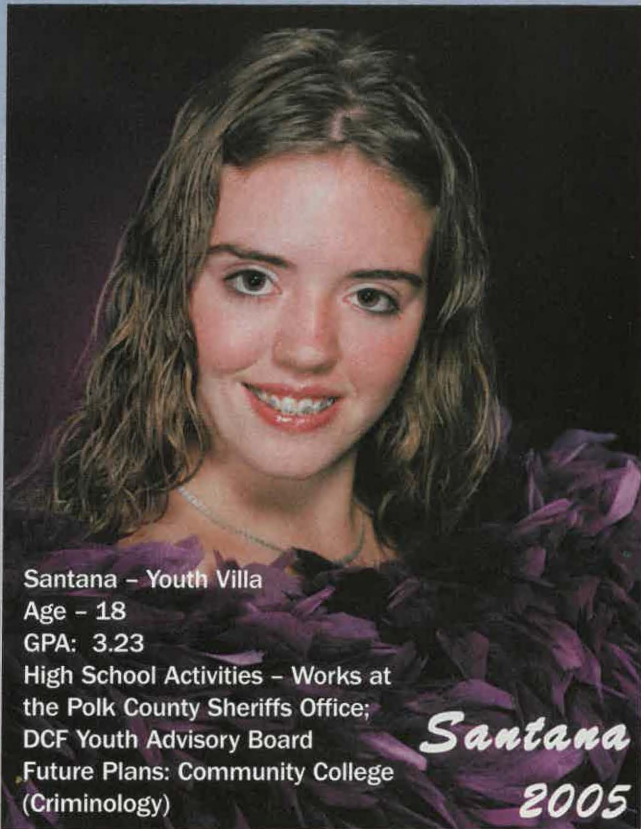

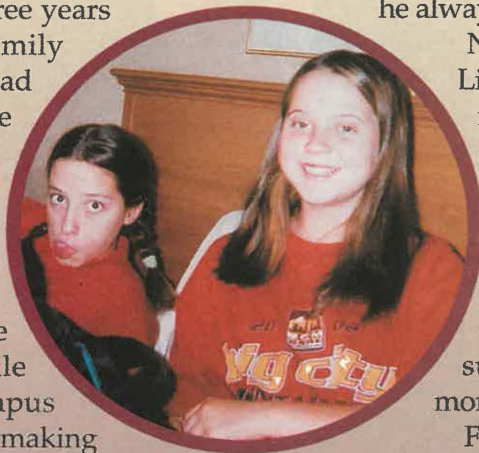
If the girls are giggling, you will usually find Liz at the center of attention. She believes humor can help

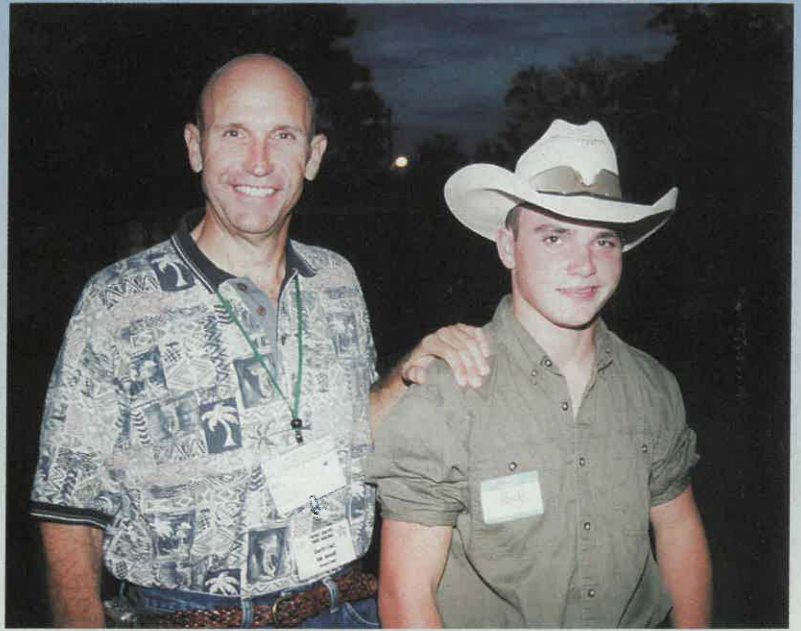

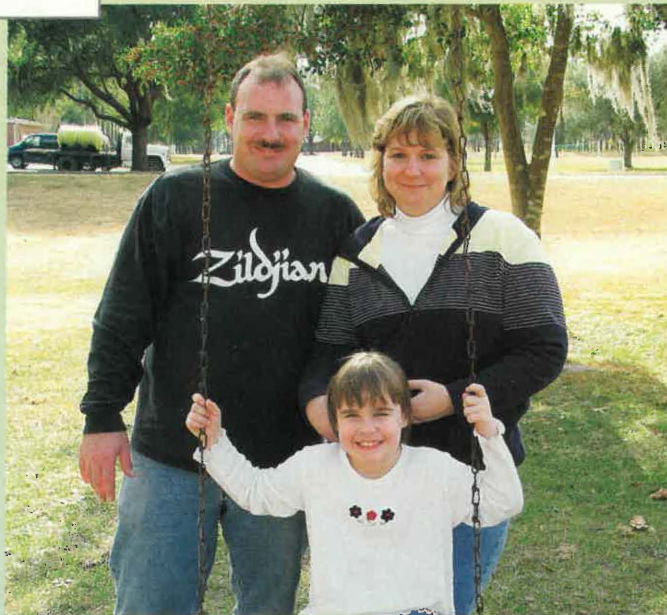
## Just One Year Made All the Difference in the World!

"I really loved working at the farm. We were allowed to pick out a horse and take care of it. My horse's name was Dusty. You learn a lot about responsibility when you



have a job on the ranch."

When he wasn't at the farm, Thomas and his friend, Rick, learned to play the drums. "We went to the music room under the chapel to practice every chance we could. Now, I 'moonlight' as a drummer for a band called *Searchin'.*" When asked, "What the band was '*Searching*' for?" Thomas smiled and quickly replied, "A bass player to finish out our sound."

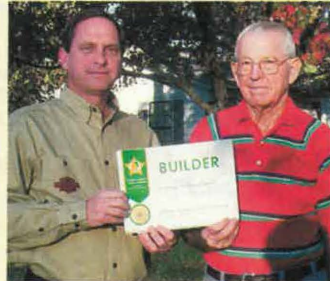

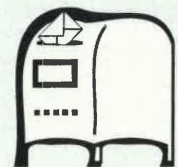
