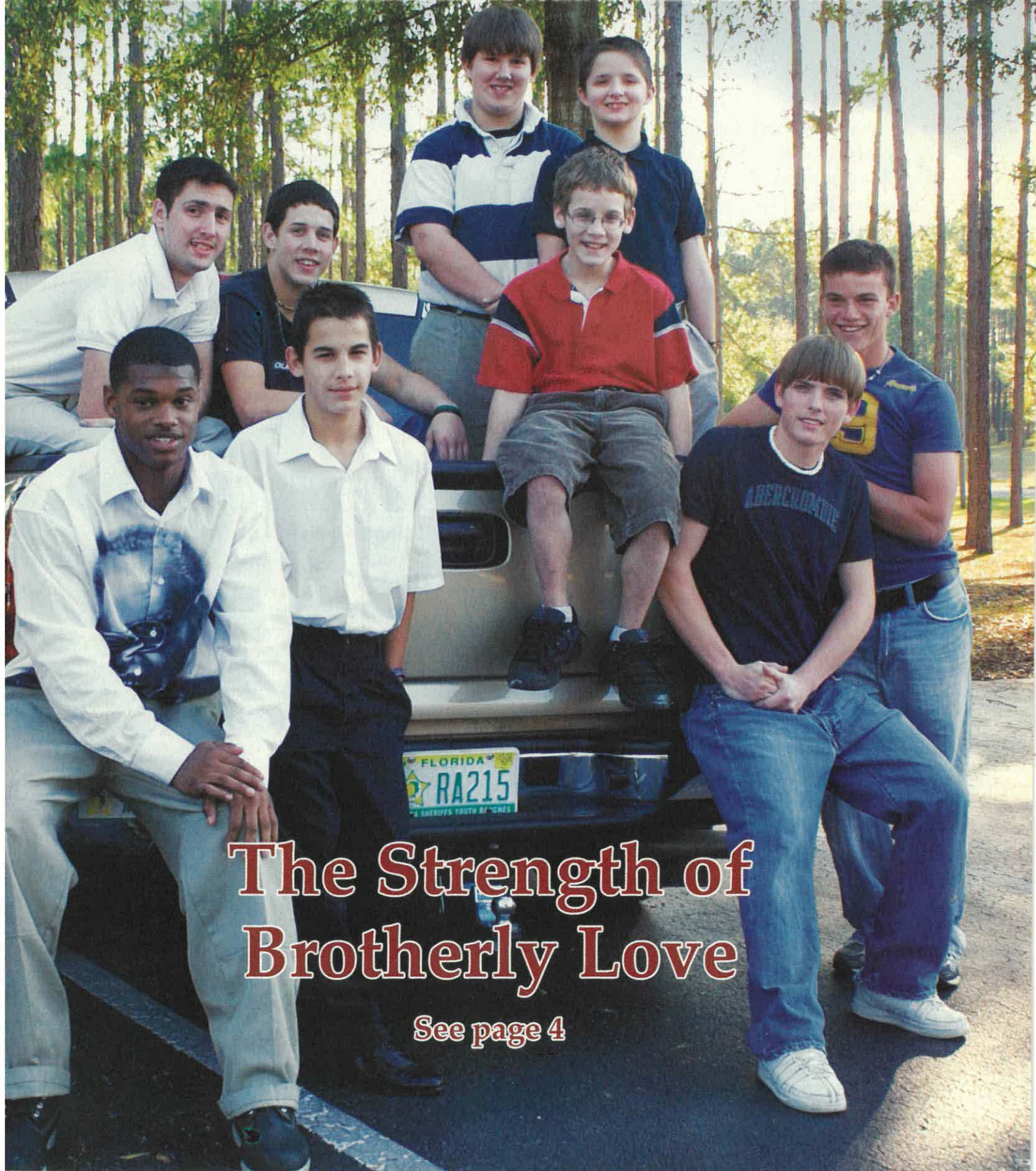

Andrew and Mikhail

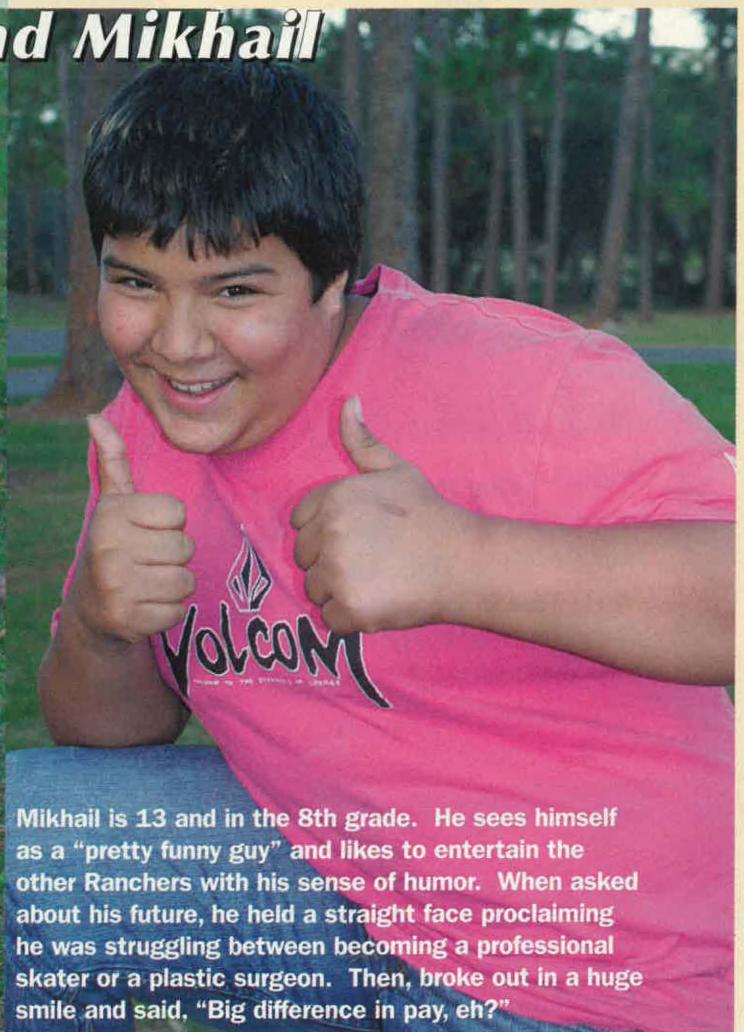
Younger brother Andrew admits he has a short fuse and a quick temper. He needed to learn how to control his temper and respect his elders. His brother, Mikhail, was used to taking the "easy way out" and thought he could slide through life without thinking about the consequences. Both boys were struggling in school and their mother needed assistance in guiding them in the right direction so she sought the help of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Both boys are doing well at the Ranch. Andrew said, "My Cottage Parents are pretty strict, but that's probably a good thing. My real mom always said the stricter the better! It's helping me stay on track." Mikhail piped in, "Being apart from our mom is hard, but my grades are up. I can get the tutoring I need here at the Ranch. For now, this is where we should be."

Back at home, there are step-siblings, half-siblings and even an adopted child. Art and Vinny know what it is like to live with a bunch of other kids. Here at the Ranch, they claim, "There is much more to do!"

Both boys have a job on campus. Vinny works in the Arts and Crafts Center. He likes to "build stuff" and have fun. Art is working in the cafeteria. He enjoys finishing his tasks quickly because Mr. Paul will give them a little extra free time for a job well done.

Art spoke highly of the staff at the Ranch, "Everybody here makes a difference. Now I am not hurting myself or getting into trouble. Before, I would fight a lot. Now I think about what I do...before I do it. I like to help others, stay on task, and do what I am supposed to do."

His younger brother, Vinny, agrees and has grown to like life at the Ranch. "Our Grandma has custody of us and our family thought it was best if we came to the Ranch. I used to be pretty angry. The Ranch has helped me with my temper. Now, I'd like to stay here until I am 18."

Art (age 14) is in the 7th grade. He is a huge sports fan naming the Atlanta Falcons, Tampa Bay Bucs and Orlando Magic as his favorite teams. Vinny (age 12) and in the 6th grade is very quick and enjoys playing (and winning) dodgeball. He also spends time at the farm working with the heifers and horses.

"Years ago, we were in the same foster home. We fought with everyone and I began failing in school. Something had to change," said Keilah.

She decided to come to the Ranch by herself, without her sister. She lived with us for two years and did quite well. When she went on a family visit, Ashley noticed a huge difference. "I saw how much Keilah had improved. Her attitude was better, her grades were up...she was happy again!" Keilah told Ashley she could have the same opportunity if she came to the Ranch.

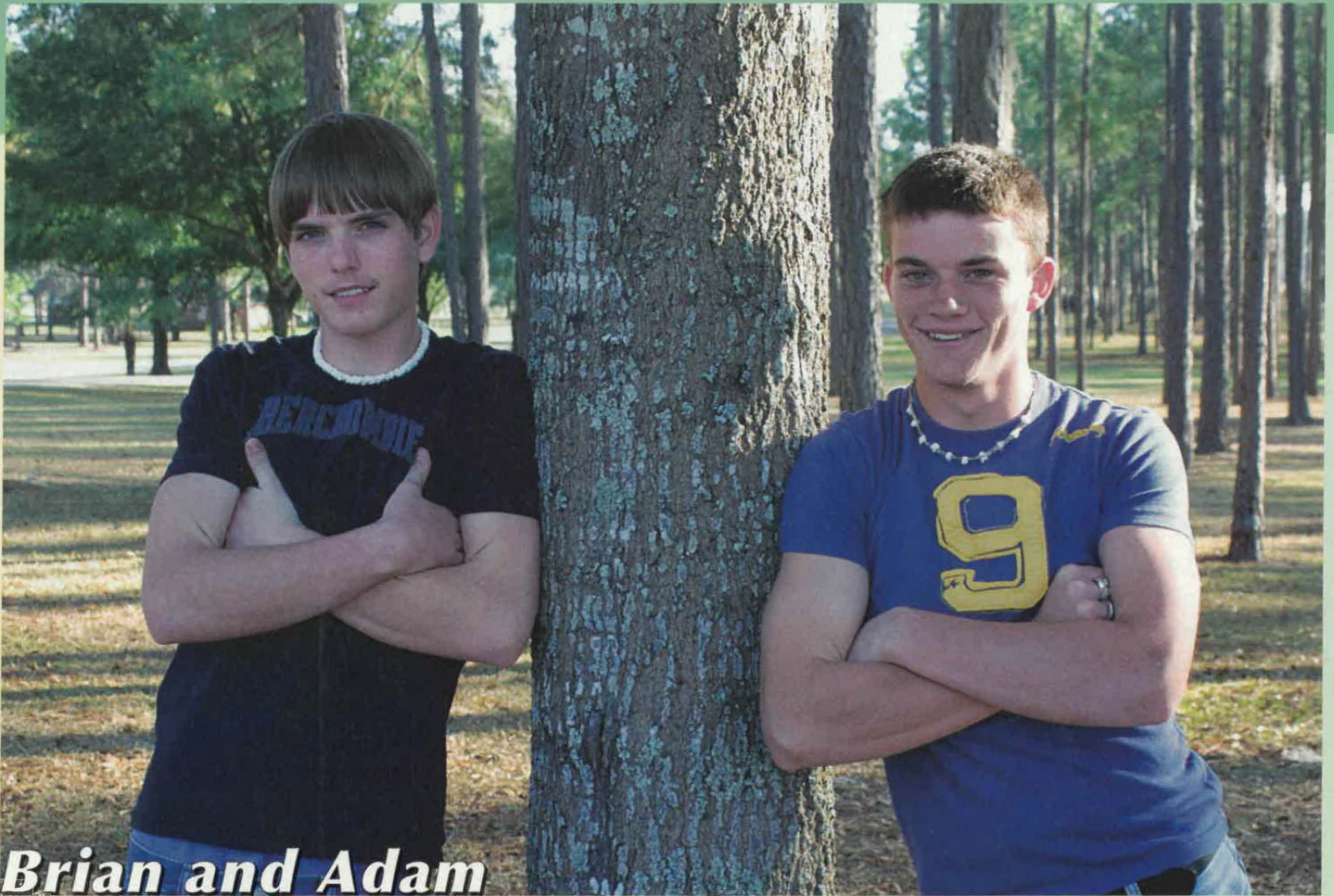

Renat and Rais

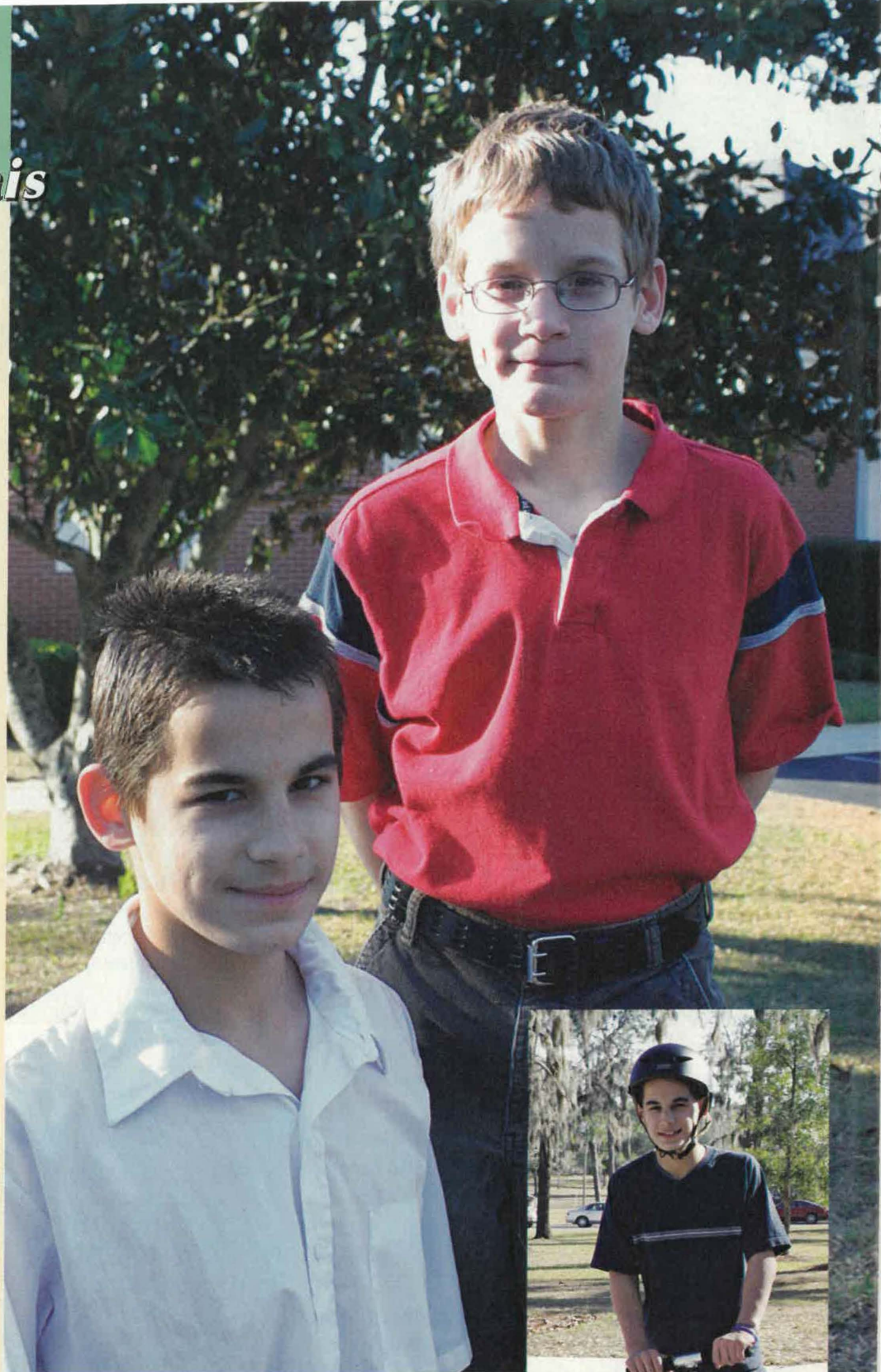

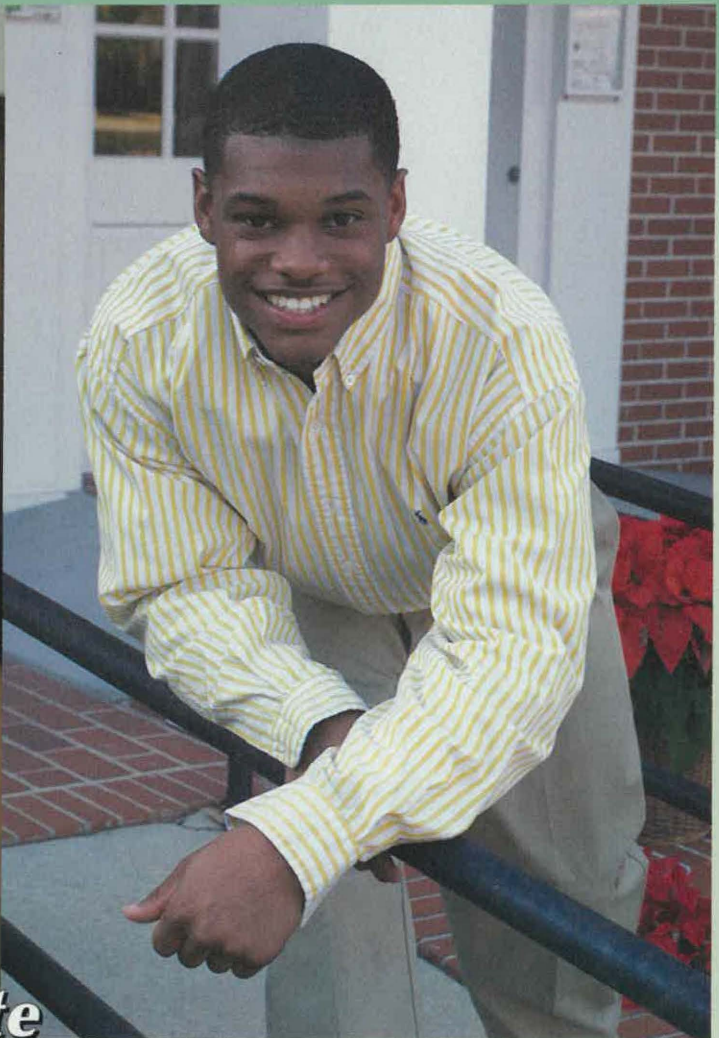

Cykeria and Edwaynte

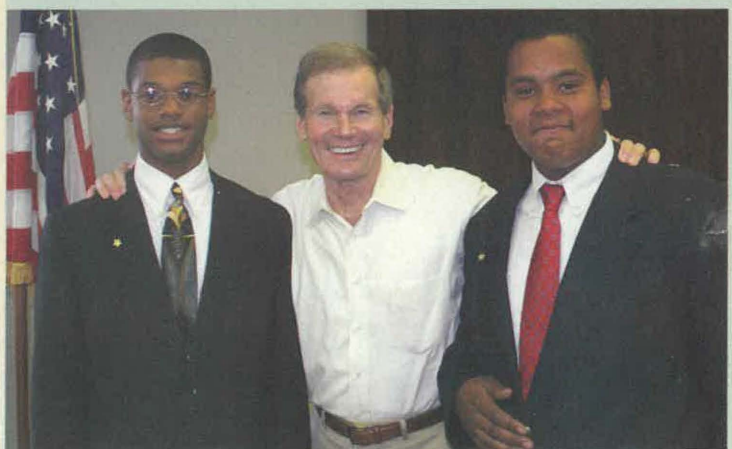

Older brother Juan talks about the impact the Ranch has had on his behavior. "Moving to the Boys Ranch nearly four years ago changed my life. The Ranch is a place of many choices. Chris chimes in, "I'd rather be here than in "juvy" <detention> or jail. That's where I was headed. The Ranch has kept me out of the trouble I would have found at home." "Yes," Juan agrees. "It is good to be at the Ranch, and it is good to be here with my brother!"

Over the past few years, Chris and Juan have grown in many ways including physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually. Chris proudly claims, "The Boys Ranch teaches you many things. I especially like Chapel and want to use what I have learned to become a good man."

Juan and Chris are ready for an afternoon of campus lawn maintenance. Working as a team they will complete their tasks quickly.

Would You Like to Help Support the Children in Our Care? Consider donating your vehicle to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches!

What will the Youth Ranches do with the vehicle I donate?

If the vehicle is in very good to excellent condition and it is suitable for use in the program, it may be assigned to the Ranch for use. Otherwise, vehicles are sold at public auction. Proceeds from auctions provide operational funds for services for needy boys and girls.

Can you pick up the vehicle or do I need to bring it to you?

We will be happy to arrange a convenient time to pickup the vehicle wherever located in the state of Florida.

What requirements must be met to donate my vehicle?

- A signed Donor Information Form returned to us (Form is mailed to you after phone contact)
- Must have a clear title in donor's name
- Vehicles in fair to excellent condition are accepted. Due to the cost involved for pickup and disposal, vehicles that do not have a fair market value of at least \$500 or that are in poor condition are not accepted.
- Unless the car is a collectible or is in excellent condition, cars older than 1985 model year are not acceptable.

How much of a charitable contribution deduction will I receive for my donation?

The American Jobs Creation Act of 2004 changed

the regulations surrounding tax deductibility of donations of motor vehicles, boats and airplanes. To take a charitable contribution deduction for the gift of your vehicle, you must itemize your deductions on Schedule A of your Form 1040. For vehicles which are used in program, the "fair market value" which takes into consideration the condition and mileage of the vehicle may be taken as a deduction. For vehicles that are sold, the deduction is limited to the **greater of \$500** or the gross sales proceeds.

If the car is sold, the Youth Ranches will notify the donor of the gross sales proceeds within 30 days of the sale of the vehicle. The written acknowledgement, or in some cases Form 1098 C, is required by IRS and may need to be included with the donor's tax return. In addition, the charitable contribution deduction is taken in the year in which the vehicle is donated, even if it is sold in a later year.

How do I notify you that I want to donate my vehicle?

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches accepts vehicles in fair to great condition. If your donation has proper emission controls, fair tires, no major body or rust damage, and the engine/transmission are in good working order, please consider sharing this resource with our charity.

Please note: The American Jobs Creation Act of 2004 contains new rules pertaining to the charitable deduction allowed for vehicles donated to a qualified charity after December 31, 2004. Basically, this law limits the donor's tax deduction to \$500, or the gross proceeds from the sale of the vehicle, if over \$500. We recognize that each individual's tax situation is different and the impact of any charitable deduction is based on a variety of circumstances. You are strongly encouraged to consult with your independent tax advisor.

Mr. Vincent Giacinto was born and raised in Bayonne, NJ. He took his education seriously and earned an AB degree from Johns Hopkins University, and MA from Columbia and an MBA from Wagner College.

Believing in a strong work ethic, Mr. Giacinto spent 42 years serving as a Business and Technical Manager and Senior International Clinical Trials Coordinator for Merck and Company. During his tenure, he helped develop a number of vital programs and medications, including Atabrine, a synthetic counterpart of Quinine used in the prevention of malaria.

In appreciation for his efforts, Mr. Giacinto was awarded membership in the International Who's Who of Medicine and honored by the Ellis Island Foundation with its Flags for Freedom Award. He is the author of several scientific publications and received numerous commendations from the U.S. Government for his achievements.

Boys Ranch Director of Education Susan Moffat believes in expanding each boy's understanding of the simple but steady questions she hears nearly every day. "What is that?" "How does it work?" and "Why is it important?" She knows experiential learning often makes all the difference in the world.

Whenever an opportunity for a field trip presents itself, she tries to take full advantage of the many other "teachers" within our community. Recently, a select group of boys visited PCS Phosphate Mines and learned about

the available jobs in this industry from the men and women who are currently employed in this business.

Questions ranged from the use of phosphate, the safety of an open pit mine, starting pay, educational requirements, environmental care standards and many other issues. Each youngster then returned to the Boys Ranch to discuss their impressions of this industry.

Each experience like this gives the boys a

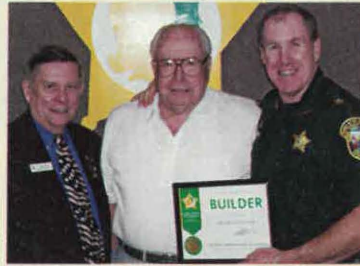

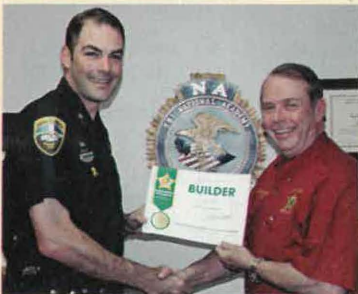

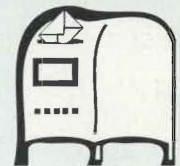
