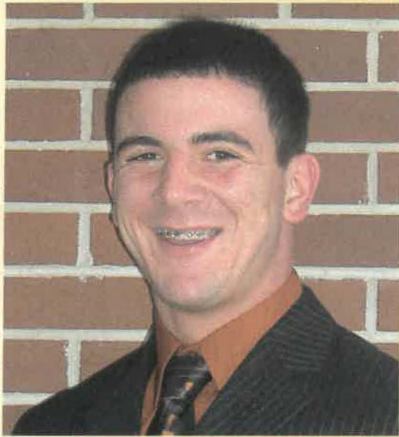

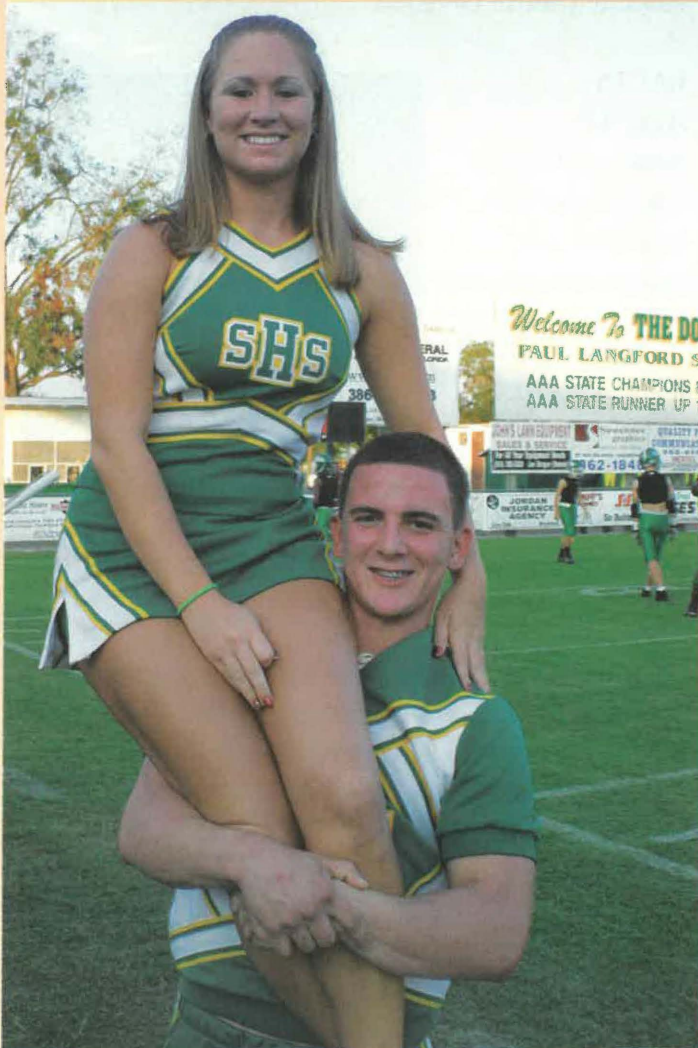
From Castaway Kid to Homecoming King Josh is a True Winner!



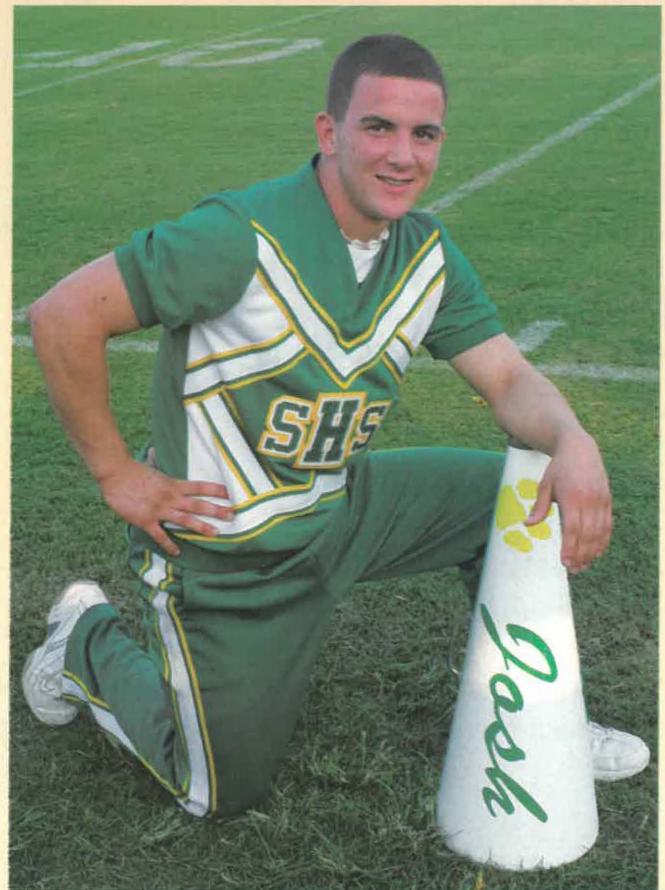
Back at the ranch with the crown on his head and the scepter in his hand, Josh receives a big hug from Cottage Mom Barnett. She was so proud to see "her boy" receive such a significant recognition from his peers at school.

His younger years were nothing a child wants to remember...an abusive home, a ward of the state, multiple foster home placements, and eventually by the age of 12 a runaway living on his own.

Quick on his feet and a light sleeper, Josh spent several homeless months waiting for the sun to go down so he could sneak into a construction site and sleep in the protection of cement culverts. Up before dawn, he moved out to find food and perhaps earn a little cash here and there.

The reality of life on the run was hard and Josh knew it was a path to destruction and delinquency.

He wanted more so he decided to "turn himself in" at a local church, hoping to find compassion and care. Unsure of what to do with the young teenage runaway, the church staff called the Sheriff.

Sizing up Josh and listening to his story, the options of returning to foster care or being sent to a juvenile detention center were not reasonable solutions for the boy. Instead they gave this little castaway child the chance to go to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

When Josh first saw the Boys Ranch, he could not believe his eyes! He stood in awe of the rolling hills, horses, chapel, school, gymnasium and plenty of cottages for boys like him. Immediately he knew he had finally found a home!

For weeks he ate heartily as it had been some time since he had three meals a day. He relished the soft bed with clean sheets and when the storm clouds began to gather, he smiled recognizing the safety of living under a sturdy roof.

As he grew he always had new clothes and everything he needed for the start of a new school year.

For Josh, the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch was a dream come true!

One Spring day, Josh approached the staff and asked if there was any way he could work extra hours and earn money to go to camp that summer. When asked what type of camp, Josh replied "Cheerleading Camp."

Now this was something new. In the past 50 years of raising teenage boys, none had ever wanted to be a cheerleader. Further information surfaced and soon the focus was clear.

Go to one football game and you will see Josh's theory in action. He is a handsome, strong, confident young man who spends his time standing just off the gridiron, surrounded by and literally "picking up" some of the prettiest girls in town. Smart boy!

At Suwannee High, the Homecoming Court is selected by the student body. Josh was nominated by his friends and a bit nervous because he was up for King against some other really talented, popular guys. He held his breath when the moment arrived.

Hearing his name, the crowd erupted in cheers for this once castaway boy had become the 2006 Homecoming King!

With all these talents, Josh has also maintained a 3.0 GPA, served as a Page for the Florida Senate,

As her confidence grew, so did her desire to succeed.

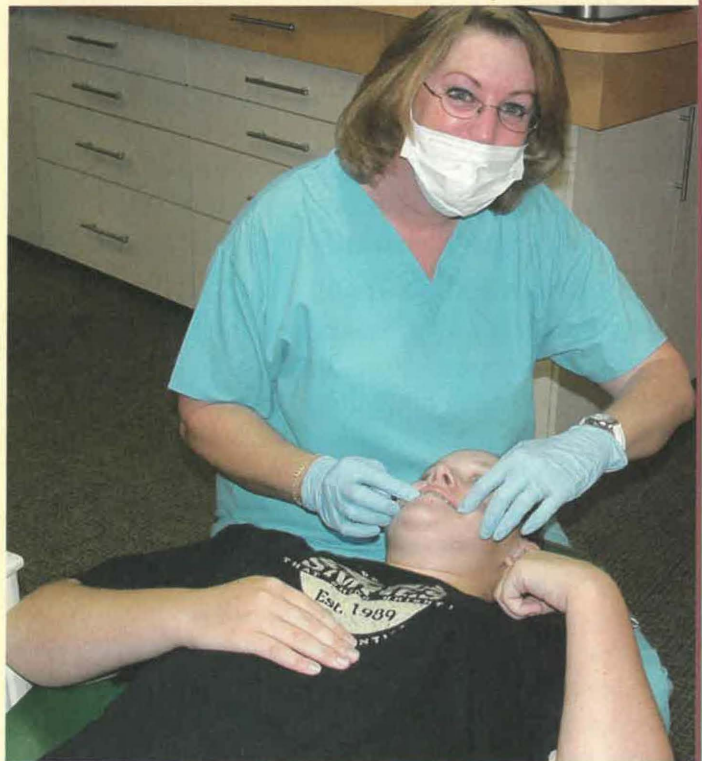

Ranchers Build A Work of Art, A Thing of Beauty...

Beginning in November and stretching all the way to September, Boys Ranch Arts and Crafts Instructor Pete Peterson challenged his students to build a canoe from scratch. None of the materials were pre-cut or prefabricated, and every part was handcrafted by the boys.

With the help of about 15-20 different youngsters throughout the year, five stayed steady and saw the canoe develop from start to finish.

Andrew, James, Brandon, Vincent and Aron handled the bulk of the work and demonstrated a tremendous sense of pride in their accomplishment.

The boys learned about wood as they selected, cut, sanded, set and sealed each piece in the construction process. They used western red cedar for the stripping and added a spruce accent stripe for color and style. They selected poplar for the stems and gunwales and decided to use a combination of oak and mahogany for the remaining parts of the canoe. The seats are mahogany with custom caning woven for comfort and support.

With anticipation and awe, the boys and Mr. Pete launched the canoe in the Suwannee River for the very first time. She was very seaworthy and slid through the water like a sleek, silent ship. A bit nervous and quite protective, the boys only let a few adults maneuver the canoe, lest a hidden rock or unanticipated sunken limb would scratch their masterpiece.

Once back on land, the sigh of relief and back slapping smiles of success spread over their faces.



The canoe will be on permanent display at the Boys Ranch as a tribute to those young men who remained focused and completed this incredibly beautiful work of art.
