

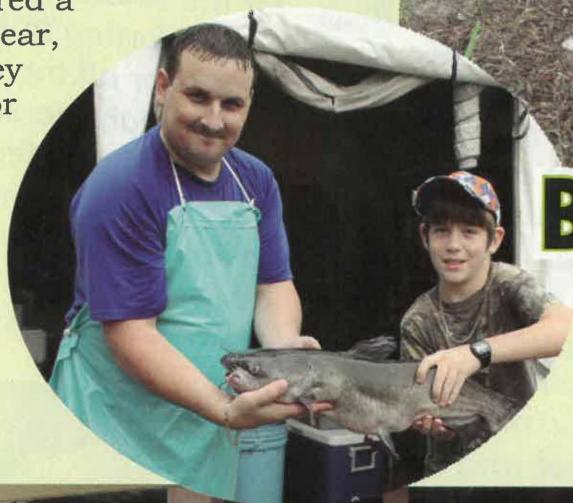

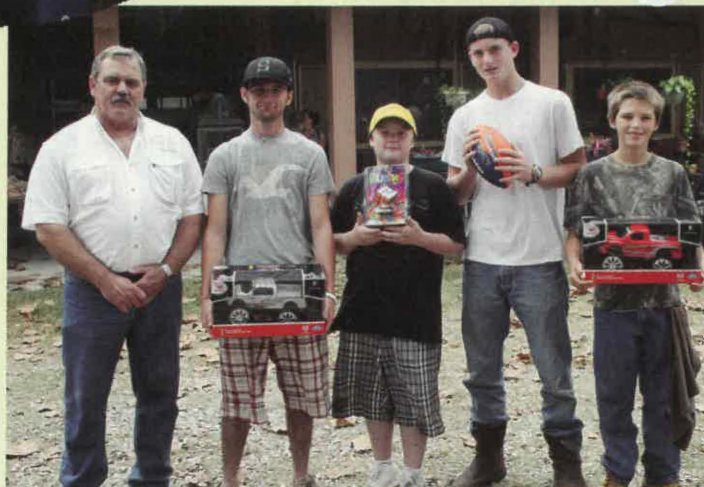
Dr. Hank and Dr. Linda Stoddard, along with their staff, had prepared a wonderful lunch for the kids and really made this fishing trip a true adventure!

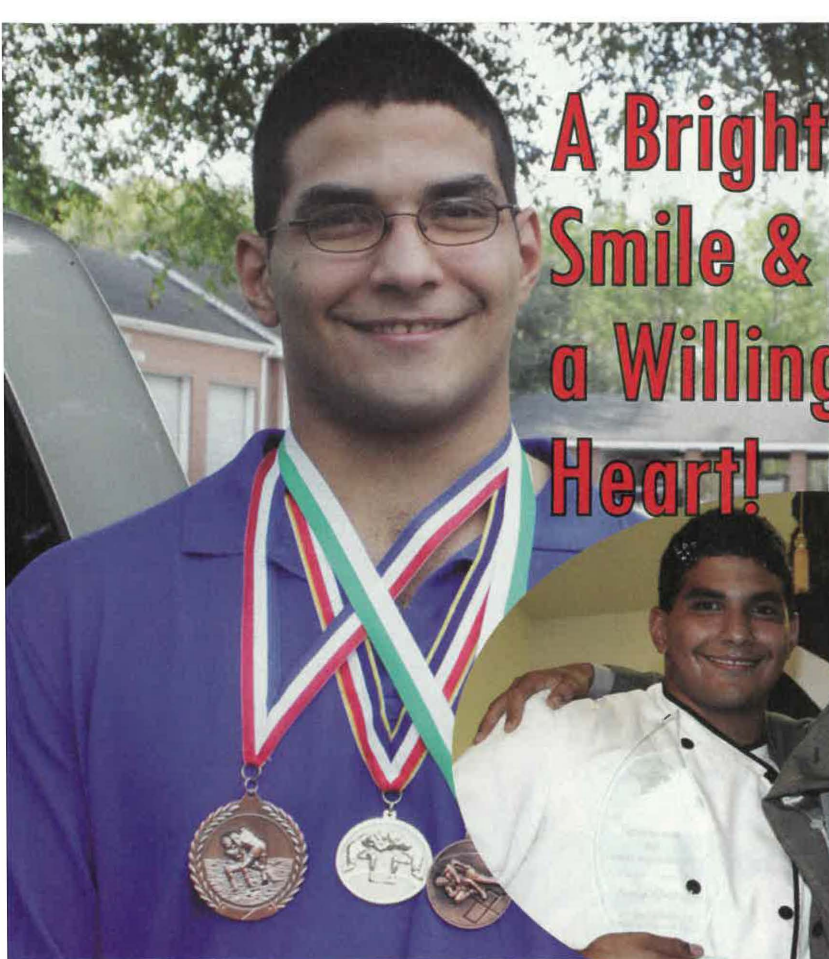

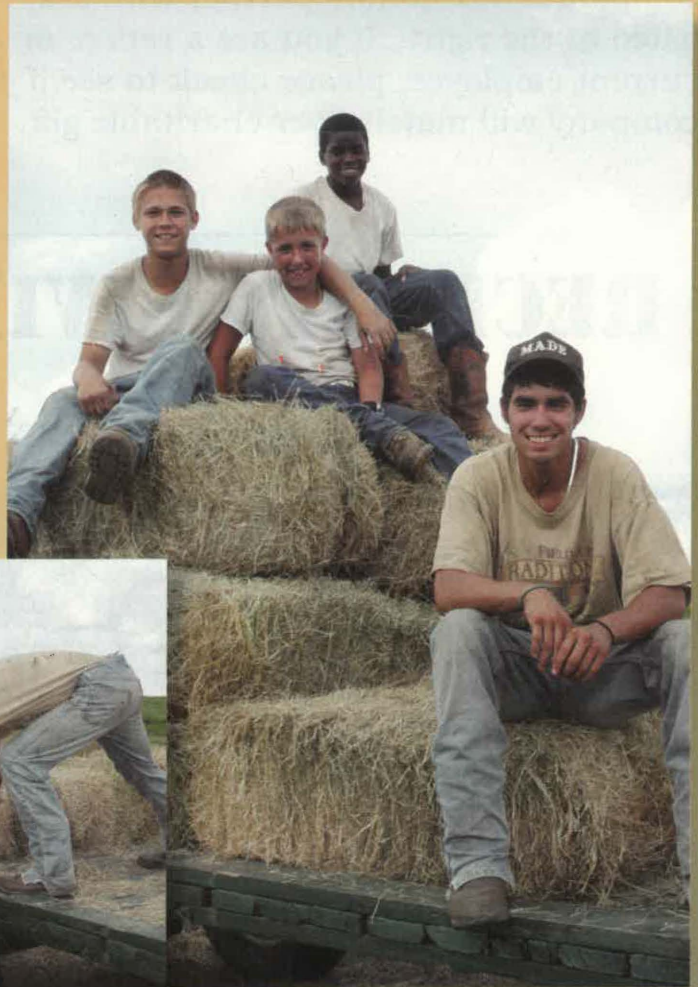


job, youth earn spending money but more importantly, they learn work skills and how to work with a boss and co-workers.

A Word From Our Kids



Today I'm going to tell you a story about a girl I'm just getting to know. Growing up, my childhood wasn't great at all. Not having the right type of structure and authority when I was younger led me to become very aggressive towards everyone who cared about me. I began hanging out with the wrong type of people and my grades dropped lower and lower. I began to feel trapped in a box with no way of letting my feelings out. My family and I decided that I needed help.

We heard about the Youth Villa from a co-worker who had their daughter in the Ranch the year before and it changed her life for the best. My parents loved the idea of "just girls." They always said boys are just going to bring you more problems. My life at the Villa wasn't easy at first. Of course, saying good-bye to everyone you love and care about is hard and going to a place where you don't know anyone just made it harder. But I had to put all of that to the side if I wanted to be reunited with my family. So I started getting my act together and worked very hard to prove I could do it.

Ever since, I've been here I haven't been in any trouble. I have a structured environment and I am on the A/B honor roll. I am involved with the Explorers in Polk County which might help me with my future career as a law enforcement officer. I look back at my past and wish that I could change all of the mistakes that I have made. But I know I can't. So I'm trying to be the best that I can! Thank you for allowing me the change to become a better young woman.

I came to the Youth Villa because I had a few problems at home. I had a bad attitude and, a very short temper and it caused me to argue and get angry a lot. My brother, who was failing in school, skipping class, and sneaking out at night, sometimes left me at home by myself. My mom worked the nightshift at a nursing home and went to college. I didn't have a father figure and my brother's father didn't live in the state, which left my brother and me taking care of ourselves most of the time.

After getting pretty depressed, I stopped eating well and started smoking, drinking and skipping school to hang out with my friends. I was not getting along with my mom and her boyfriend, I wasn't getting the best grades, and I was constantly grounded. My mom finally listened to my school resource officer and called the Florida Sheriff's Youth Villa in Bartow and I immediately knew this was the place for me!

I have been very happy here because life is much better than at home. The people here really care about you and help you with your problems. I have bettered my life tremendously. I have not been so argumentative towards people, have not skipped school and I have been getting better grades which makes my mother proud. In fact, I just made straight A's on my last report card. I eat healthier and do not ever drink or smoke.

My plans for the future are to stay at the Youth Villa until I graduate high school. After that, I will get my associates degree in Dental Assisting/Orthodontics and eventually become a Pediatric Dentist/Orthodontist.

I never want to go back to my old life style and now make better choices about the people I hang around. Now, I am the good influence on them and not vice versa. I have decided to change my life for the better and to prove to my family and everyone else who doubted me that I can make it successfully in life. I could not have done any of this without the help of the Florida Sheriff Youth Ranches. Thank you for supporting the Youth Ranches.

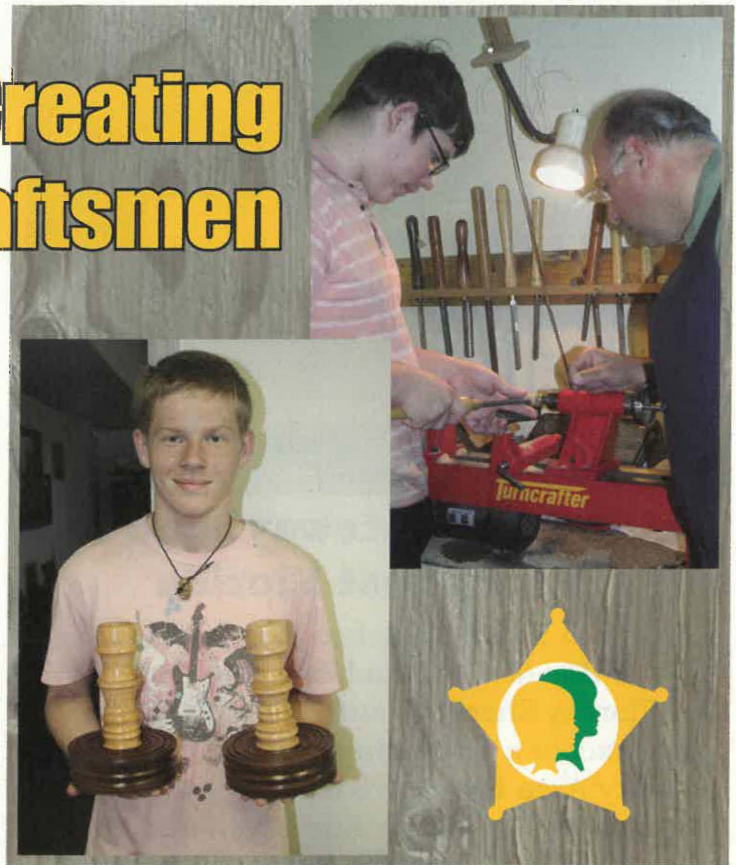


Dyer Award Gift

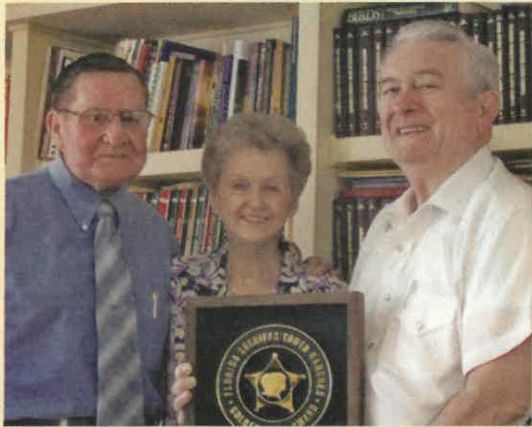

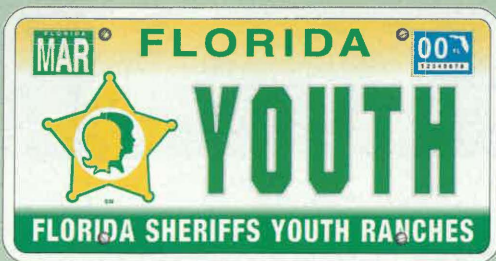
