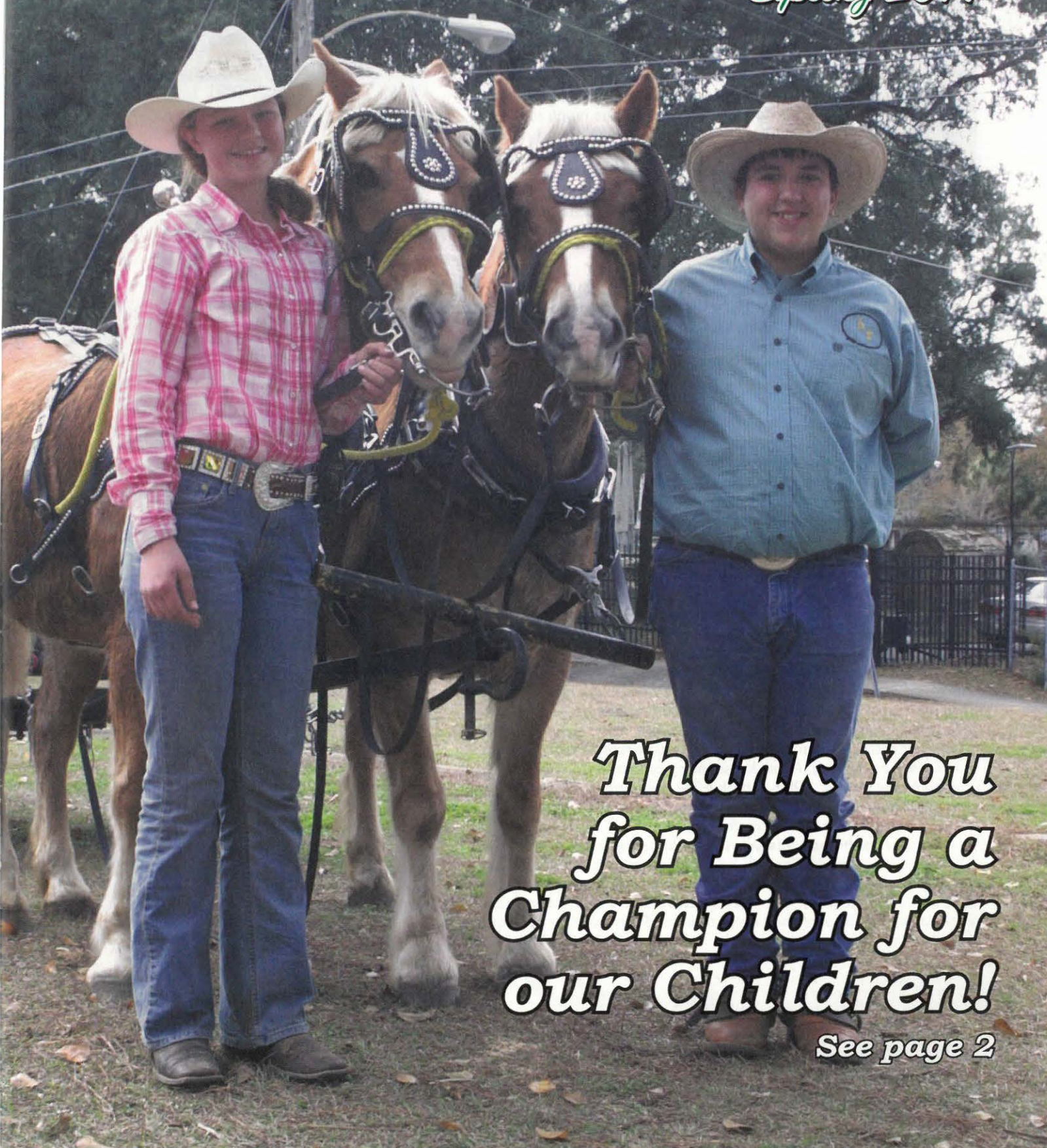

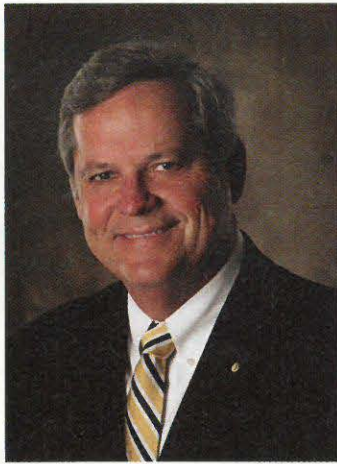

President's Perspective

As we move into this new year and are already getting ready for the Summer Camp season, the Youth Ranches has much to be thankful for. As you already know, last year we were forced to close five of our eighteen cottages due to the significant decrease in charitable

giving. As difficult as this was, it allowed us to refocus on what matters most; the safety and care of our children, providing the highest quality education and teaching the skills needed for them to live productive lives.

During the latter part of the year, our donor family opened their hearts and checkbooks and we began to see ways to serve additional children. The Champions for Children campaign has now raised over \$600,000 and we are on track to have all our cottages open again by the end of March. This decision involves a significant step of faith for us as we only have funds on hand to keep them open for 12 months.

As a donor and supporter of the Youth Ranches, your gifts made it possible for us to open our doors to boys and girls who have an incredible need for a safe place to live and receive the training and education to turn their lives around. Recently I was on a fishing trip with some of the boys and had the chance to spend some time talking to one of our ranchers. This young man came to us from a very difficult home situation. He has little to no contact with his father and his mother has significant substance abuse issues. He had no real direction in his life and was basically raising himself. As he talked about the changes in his life since he moved to the Boys Ranch, this well spoken and polite young man told me his life is totally different now. He has hope for his future and has set goals that are achievable.

In this issue of THE RANCHER, you will see pictures from Governor Scott's inaugural parade. I was able to spend the whole day with our kids and was proud to be riding alongside them. You would be so impressed with these teenagers. Their values and the quality of their character would make any parent proud. To make it even more amazing, I also knew many of their stories before they moved to the Ranch. When I think of all they have overcome in their lives and how far they have come, I am blessed and honored to have a small part in their transformation.

As you go through this year, I would ask you to remember the children of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. You are their future and your generous gifts are what have enabled thousands of our alumni to become great employees, husbands, wives, parents and productive members of their communities. Thank you for your gifts and for your prayers.

From Angry Teen to Sweet 16!

“My life has changed from top to bottom in every way,” claims Karrisa, now 16 years old. “I have had a dramatic change in my attitude, my attire and my future since I came to the Youth Villa.”

A few years ago, I was primarily known for sneaky behavior, dabbling in drugs and was a complete embarrassment to my family. All that has changed and I am finally the person I knew I could be!

I have rebuilt my relationship with my dad... I am drug free, have over a 3.5 GPA and love playing soccer on the Bartow High Varsity team,” she says with a huge smile.

Changes like this do not happen overnight. First, Karrisa had to want to live at the Villa. Stuck in a teen shelter for three weeks, she thought about her options. Home was not one of them and shelter care was only temporary. She

needed to be in a place where she could work out her problems, restore trust in her relationships and start making



positive choices in her life. The Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa was the answer.

“Here at the Villa, things are different than I thought. At first I expected it to be like a prison... I wasn’t sure about living with a bunch of troubled girls. But now I realize it is just a home for kids who need some support and help in life. We get to do stuff normal kids do, like go to Walmart and the movies. We have to help around the house and I have learned that I really like to cook, especially with Mom Ramey’s recipes!”

Now a year and a half later, Karrisa is a beautiful, energetic and happy young lady. She excels academically and athletically. Her roommate is her best friend and she has a strong bond with her Cottage Parents. “Mom Ramey is not just a person who lives here, she takes your thoughts and feelings seriously and

wants to help me make my life better.
I am getting the help I need to see
reality clearly and make the choices
I need to go down the right path.
I am proud of who I am now,
and the future I see for
myself. I plan to return
home this summer and
continue to work on
improving my relation-
ship with my dad.”

The Boys Ranch gave me a stable home to grow up in and I am truly grateful for the years I have lived here.”

Cody arrived at the Boys Ranch in November of 2005. He was 13 and had been living with his grandmother until she passed away. Neither of his natural parents could care for him. He was intelligent, energetic and a bit mischievous. A stable, loving home

with good supervision and consistent guidance was exactly what this young man needed to ease him along the path to maturity.

“People tell me I have an outstanding work ethic. I know I learned that at the Ranch because here they give you a chance to succeed,” said Cody. “Even if you do fail a time or two...which you will...the folks here at the Ranch teach you how to pick yourself back up, fix what went wrong and try again.”

“I am more prepared to deal with the real world. I have set my goals and achieved some of them.” Cody holds down two jobs, one in town at a local fast food restaurant and the other on

the Ranch at the farm. He earned the money and the privilege of buying a truck so he can get to and from work and school.

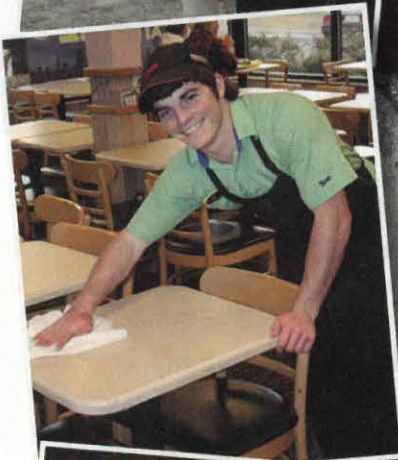
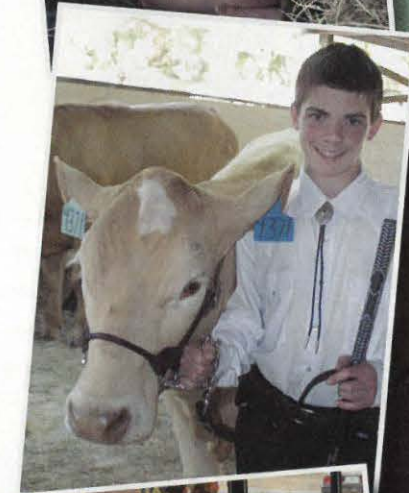
In school, Cody shines. He has maintained an excellent GPA and has won several academic awards. After graduation this spring, he will enroll in

Coming Home!

Corey graduated from the Boys Ranch in 2004. He joined the United States Marine Corp later that year and wrote us a note from Paris Island:

“Well, I’ve made it half-way through my basic training. It’s been tough and that’s no joke. But, boot camp is what you make of it.

The chow here is good, but it is eaten so fast that it’s hard to enjoy the flavor. I miss the good old days when you had more than five minutes to eat and actually got to shower in private.

Other than that, I’ve never regretted my decision to come here. It is hard but it’s only 10% physical, 90% mental...”

Corey completed his basic training and then went on to serve our nation with honor. He completed his commitment and has since returned to the civilian world. Today, he is married and they are expecting their first child. Corey is attending college on the GI bill and his wife is still a member of the US Navy.

Once a year or so, Corey comes back to the Boys Ranch to visit with his Cottage Parents Mom and Pop Barnett. “We are so proud of Corey!” beams Mom Barnett. “He took advantage of every opportunity the Ranch gave him to succeed and he has carried on this success after leaving the Ranch. When we talk about raising boys up to become responsible men, husbands and fathers, I think of Corey.” Pop Barnett added, “Nothing makes me more proud than when one of our boys decides to join the military.”

Corey understands he would not be where he is today, if not for the care and guidance he received at the Boys Ranch. “This is a part of who I am and what I have become. The Ranch is always a place that I will call home!”

At the end of the week, our campers write postcards about their favorite activities at camp. The Camp Director smiled when she read that Zach's favorite activity was archery. That was the day he took his big first step in learning self control and respect for others.

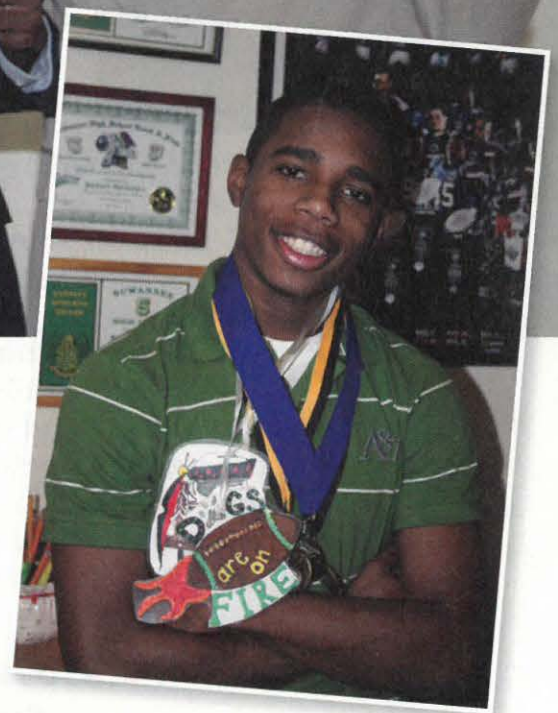

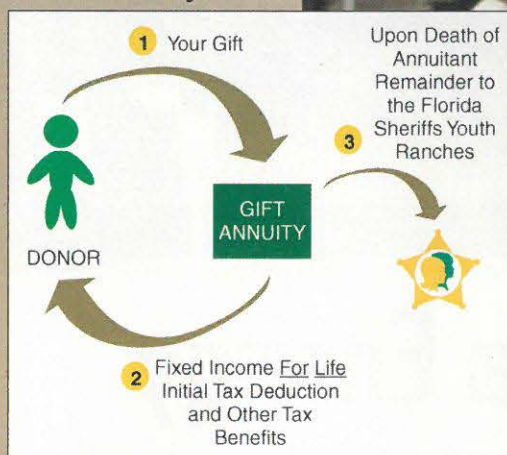

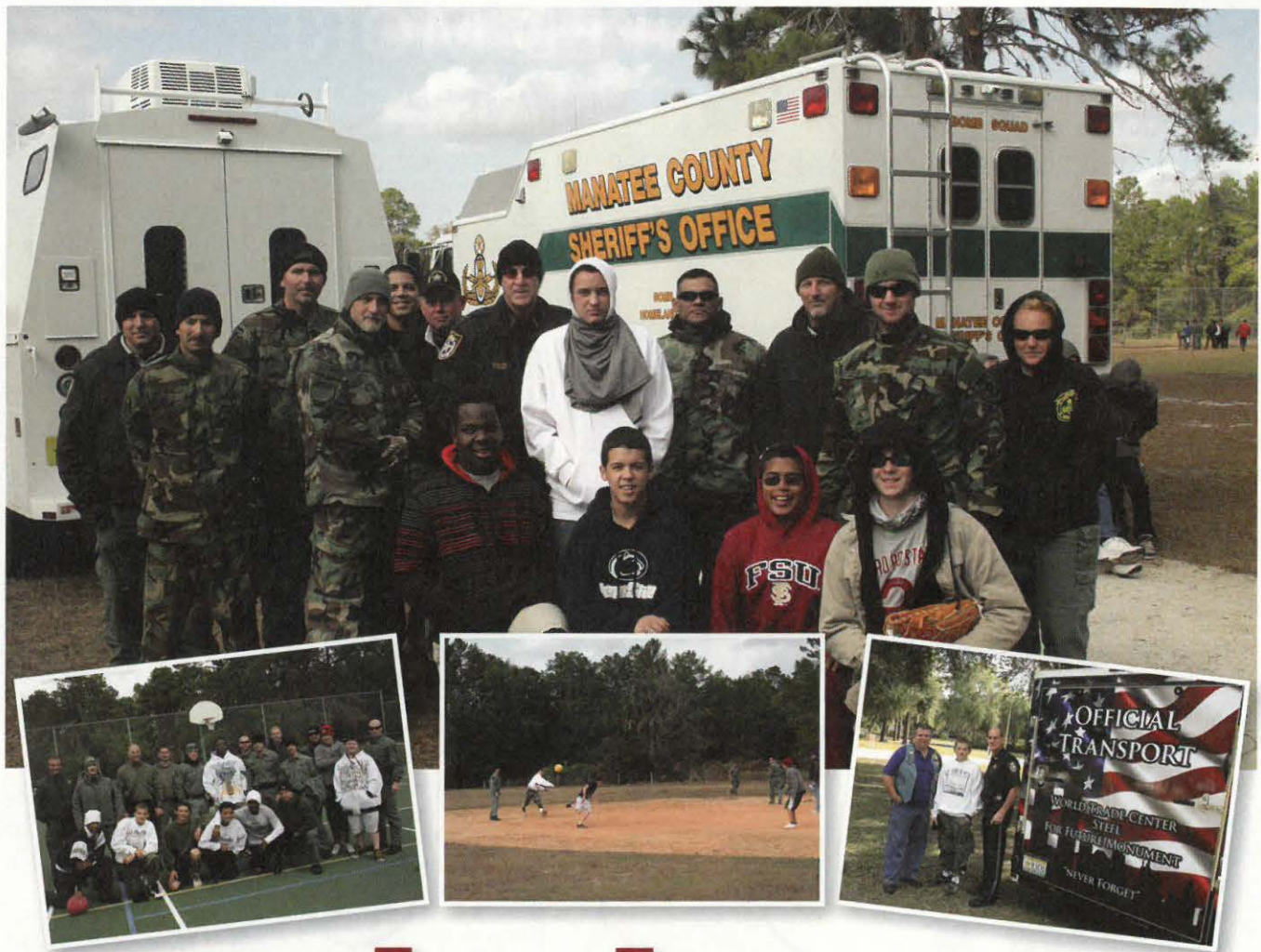

Leverock Fish Fry is a Great Success!

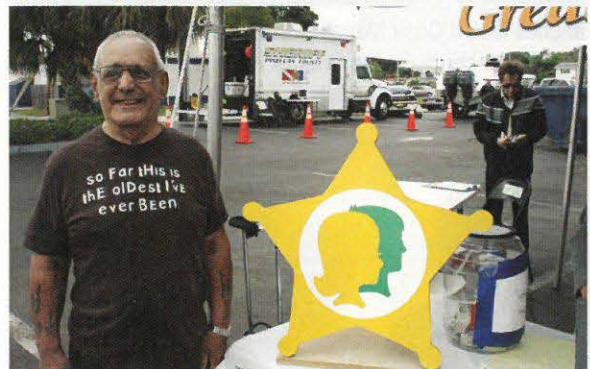

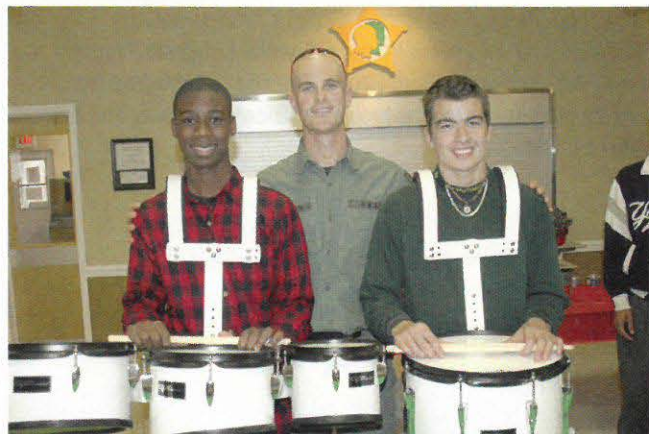

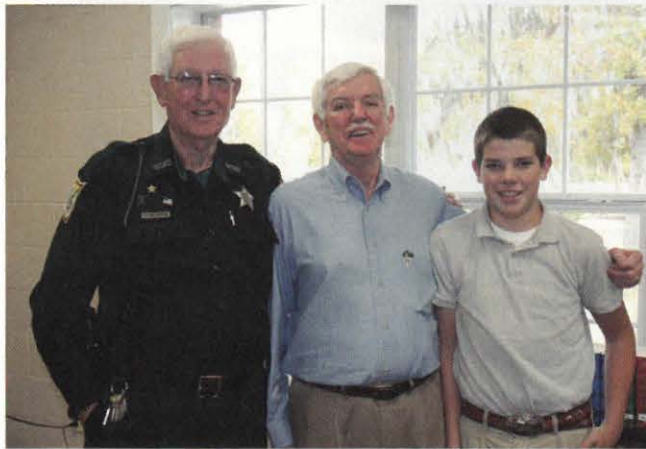
