Ceremonial triple-header marks two years of outstanding progress at Caruth Camp

INGLIS — Dedication, ribbon-cutting, and ground breaking ceremonies were consolidated into one ceremonial triple-header on February 21 to celebrate two years of outstanding progress at Caruth Camp, the newest child care project developed by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

In dedication rites the camp's administration building was named in honor of Sonya Tralins, mother of the building's donor, Dr. Alan H. Tralins.

The ribbon-cutting marked the official opening of a new archway on Highway 19 that gives the camp an attractive, landscaped entrance and captures the attention of passing motorists.

The ground breaking set the stage for construction of a \$66,215 wilderness campsite which will be built with funds raised by the Florida State Moose Association. It will consist of five cabins centered around a campfire pit, and will be the first of six proposed campsite clusters. When all are completed, the camp will have a capacity of approximately 60 boys and girls.

Located seven miles north of Inglis near Florida's west coast, Caruth Camp is being developed to give neglected, unsupervised, and troubled youngsters a wilderness camping experience designed to encourage desirable social and behavioral adjustments.

It was founded in 1986 when Mr. and Mrs. W.W. Caruth, Jr., a Texas couple with Florida business interests, signed over 182 acres of wooded property on a long-term lease, then added cash gifts totaling \$50,000 to help with "start up" expenses. Later, a gift

of 60 adjoining acres from Georgia Pacific Company expanded the camp to 242 acres.

In 1987, Dr. Tralins, who is the Director of Lykes Cancer Center at Morton Plant Hospital, Clearwater, accelerated the camp project tremendously when he told Youth Ranches officials they could have his \$180,000 house on Clearwater Beach if they would move it. They accepted the offer, and a gift of \$25,000 that Dr. Tralins provided to help with moving costs.



Marion County Sheriff Don Moreland, Chairman of the Youth Ranches Board of Directors, signed the guest register before presiding at the dedication.



Then they were faced with a terrific challenge because the house was too wide to be moved on land in a conventional manner. However, they felt that the house would make a dandy administration building for Caruth Camp, so they made arrangements to have it moved by barge to Inglis, then hauled by trailer to the camp.

Since then the building has been completely renovated and is currently in use. It replaces a small mobile home that temporarily provided crowded office space at the camp.

In a dedication prayer summing up the significance of the day's ceremonies, Youth Ranches Chaplain Warren Thompson included the following sentiments:

"Our Father, we thank you for helping us dream great dreams, and then giving us the strength and resources to accomplish them. Our hearts are full of joy as we see what has been done and dream of what is yet to be."

Salute to “Hidden Heroes:” Steve and Ruth Ivan

The “hidden heroes” of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches success story are the thousands of generous donors who sustain the Youth Ranches programs with their gifts, time and talents. We would like to give each one of them appropriate acclaim, but that is absolutely impossible because there are so many. We can, however, demonstrate the caliber of their generosity and dedication by focusing on a few chosen at random, and that is precisely what we are doing in this series of articles titled “Salute to Hidden Heroes.”

TYPICAL Florida retirees take trips to theme parks and hang out with the over-sixty crowd in shopping malls.

But Steve and Ruth Ivan are not typical retirees. Their idea of fun is to drive about 30 miles from their home to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp, and hang

out with the boys and girls.

Actually, they do more than hang out. The arts and crafts center at the camp was created with funds they provided. They go there from time to time to share their arts and craft skills with the campers. This is hardly a substitute for Walt Disney World or Busch Gardens, but they love it.

Typical Florida retirees play a lot of bridge and bingo, shuffleboard and golf.

Steve and Ruth prefer to hold yard sales and bake sales to raise funds for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Typical retirees take cruises to the Bahamas or Mexico.

Steve and Ruth would rather travel around Central Florida visiting mini warehouse centers. The sights they see aren’t so great, but the bargains they find in household goods confiscated for non-payment of rent are often spectacular.

Buying up used clothing, furniture and household

appliances doesn't turn them on. The fun begins when they call the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Office and say: "Send your truck down here and pick up another load."

Youth Ranches officials are always happy to respond to calls like this because the quality merchandise contributed by the Ivans can be converted into cash when it is sold at auction or at the Opportunity Store (Opp Store) in Live Oak.

Since 1967 when the Ivans visited the Boys Ranch for the first time and were captivated by a young boy from St. Petersburg who was their tour guide, their total cash and non-cash donations have placed them on the threshold of a Golden Star Award, the highest honor the Youth Ranches organization confers upon major donors.

Numerous Golden Star plaques are displayed in the homes of wealthy people, but the Ivans have proved you don't have to be wealthy to earn one. They live in a modest, but neat and attractive, home near the Central Florida village of Paisley, and they have become high ranking donors simply because they are hung up on helping boys and girls, not because they are rolling in riches.

Steve and Ruth grew up during the "Great Depression" of the 1930s and there were many times when they needed the kind of help youngsters are currently receiving from the Youth Ranches programs. It wasn't available then.

Steve was only 15 when he traveled alone from Czechoslovakia to the USA to claim American citizenship, and he almost didn't make it. He was expecting an aunt and uncle from Scranton, Pennsylvania, to meet him when the ship docked, but they didn't show up, and he was told he couldn't go ashore unless he was accompanied by an adult.



Ruth's artistic talent surfaced at the age of five when, because of financial problems caused by the Great Depression, she used paint brushes made with match sticks and dog hair from the family pet's tail. With ingenuity still intact, she now uses yarn to make unique artificial flower arrangements.



Fortunately, a passenger who was going to Scranton agreed to pose as his uncle. It worked, and Steve reached his destination, but another obstacle had to be overcome. Steve couldn't speak English.

Again, a stranger came to the rescue. A farmer took the teen-ager in as a hired hand, and the farmer's wife, who spoke both Russian and English, undertook the task of helping the lad banish the language barrier.

Every night after chores were done, Steve learned a little bit more English, and eventually he was encouraged to try to read Walter Lippmann's column in the Scranton newspaper. This was a tough challenge, but one that not only gave him a linguistic workout but also provided a perspective on national and world affairs.

After 14 months of tutoring, and wearing out four pocket-size dictionaries, Steve was able to handle English well enough to transfer to another farm job

When the Ivans visit the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp they help the youngsters with arts and crafts projects. Sometimes Steve prefers to have long conversations with campers who claim their parents never seem to have time to talk to them. "I'm a good listener," he explained. The Ivans bought sewing machines at the Youth Ranches Opportunity Store and donated them to the Youth camp Arts and Crafts Center.



in New Jersey.

Less than a year later, joining the U.S. Army became Steve's number one goal. The Army was ready to accept him, but, because he was only 17, he had to have a guardian's approval.

"My aunt wouldn't sign," Steve told *The Rancher* recently, "so I picked a guy up on the street and gave him \$10, and he became my uncle. He signed the papers, and to this day I don't know who he was."

Thus, the teenager from Czechoslovakia began a 22-year Army career that included service as a combat engineer in World War II and the Korean War.

Steve was discharged in 1958 with the rank of Master Sergeant, and a well-established reputation as an anonymous stranger who had worked on projects for underprivileged kids in Germany, Japan, Korea, the USA, and wherever else he had been stationed.

This was his way of expressing gratitude for the help strangers had given him when he was in desperate situations, "I promised myself if ever there was any way in the world I could help other kids, I would do it," he said recently.

While stationed in Germany near a small village, Steve made a deal with an ice cream vendor to give a free ice cream cone to every youngster under ten. They never knew who was paying for it.

"In a lot of those small towns the people didn't have any luxuries," he told *The Rancher* interviewer. "They had just enough to feed them . . . lotta times nothing but potatoes three times a day, so getting that ice cream on Saturday was a luxury. The guy used to pile it on. I told him not to be stingy about it."

In Japan, Korea, Germany, and the U.S., the big American Sergeant with the foreign accent was also responsible for establishing orphanages, and, again, the kids who were helped didn't know the identity of their primary benefactor.

These orphanage projects were classics in their simplicity. GIs and their families, motivated by Steve, donated used clothing and furniture; also raised funds with bake sales and softball games. One of the best sources of revenue was a big "profanity jar" on the bar at the Non-Commissioned Officers' Club into which GIs dropped fines every time they used swear words.

Civilians in the villages were too impoverished to help out financially, but they contributed vegetables and meat from their meager supply.

Asked to describe a typical orphanage project, Steve said: "The GIs would get together and collect money, then we would see the mayor or somebody

in town. We would find an old house. No one in them countries could afford to give us a nice place. We would find people who wanted to take care of the kids . . . and pay them so much a month."

Asked if the orphanages are still in operation, Steve said "I don't know. I never allowed 'em to use my name. One did and I quit 'em altogether. The only way I would support them was that nobody knew my name."

Ruth shares Steve's strong desire to help kids because she too knows what it's like to struggle against financial handicaps. She lived with a family and took care of their children while attending Ohio State University; also held three jobs and completed her college education in three years by skipping vacations.

"We both have been very hungry in our lifetime," she told *The Rancher*. "We know what it is to be hungry. We can sympathize with a lot of these kids we have been helping."

After college, Ruth became a fashion designer in Columbus Ohio, Dallas, Fort Wayne, and St. Petersburg. Nardi's of Dallas was one of the firms that profited from her creativity. Girls competing in Miss USA beauty contests wore formal gowns she designed. The world of fashion captured much of her attention, but she also found time for volunteer work that benefited boys and girls who needed help.

While living in Fort Wayne, Indiana, she worked as a non-paid volunteer in an institution for the hearing impaired. She remembers that it took a whole year, at the rate of six hours a week, to teach one little girl to say "ma-ma." When this happened, said Ruth, "I went around the corner and cried."

Ruth also worked as a volunteer for an orphanage in Fort Wayne, and helped to raise funds for it. The most delightful part of that experience occurred at Christmas when each volunteer was given an opportunity to take four needy youngsters shopping for gifts.

Many memorable things have happened to Ruth in child care agencies, and also (of all places) in bowling alleys. She met Steve in a bowling alley when, after four years as a reclusive, depressed widow, she was persuaded by a friend to get out and live a little. A year later Steve said, "When are we going to get married?" and they did. The year was 1965.

Not long after that they met Pinellas Sheriff Don Genung in a bowling alley and learned about the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, the forerunner of the present Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches organization. Genung was notorious then, and still is, for getting people involved in his favorite charity. The Ivans

were easily persuaded, and have been outstanding supporters ever since.

What a lucky day it was for neglected, unsupervised, and troubled boys and girls when the Ivans joined the Youth Ranches family of donors!

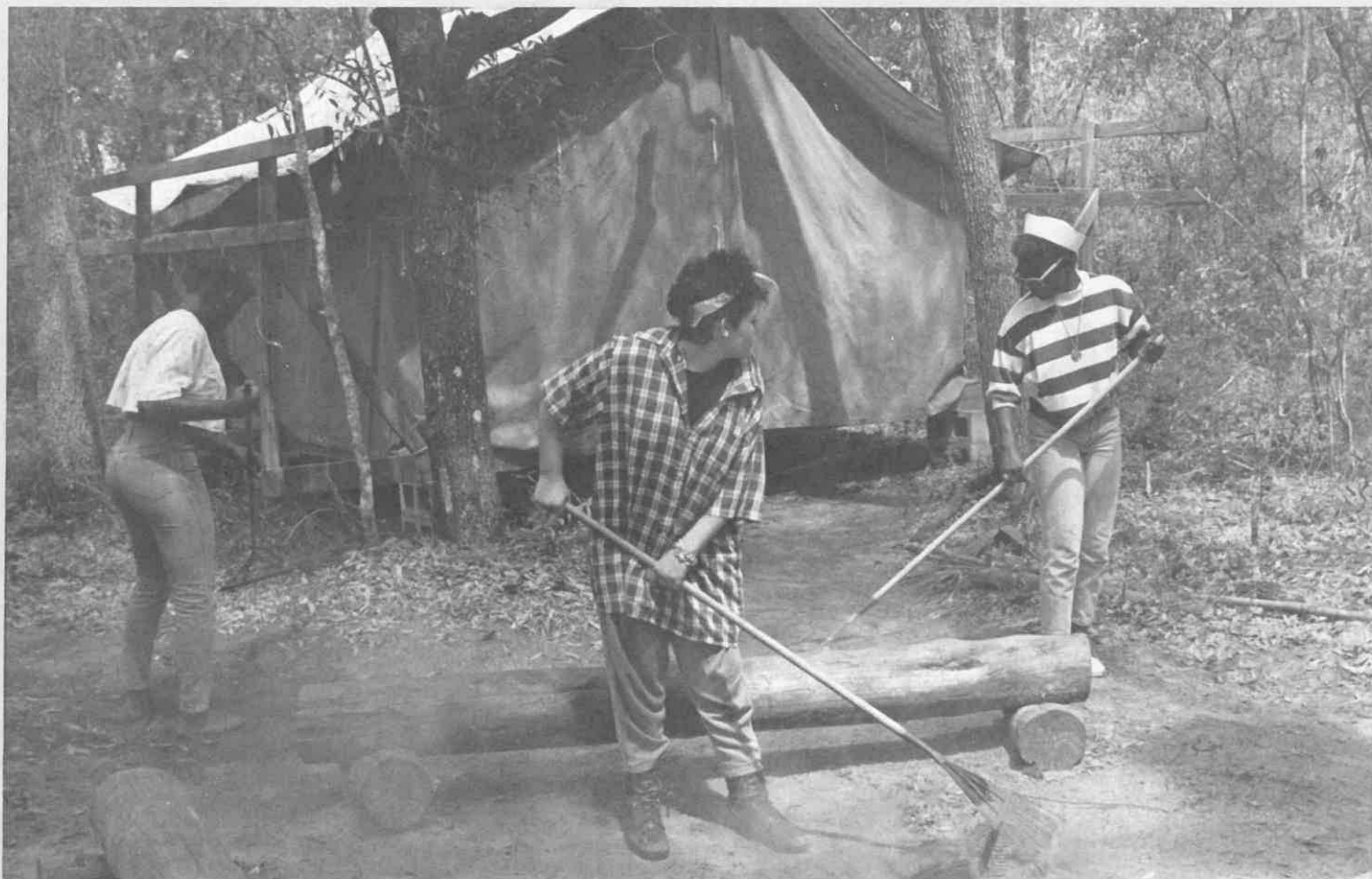
What a shame that the Youth Ranches files contain thousands of compulsive benefactors with the same generous impulses, and we can only introduce them to our readers one at a time.

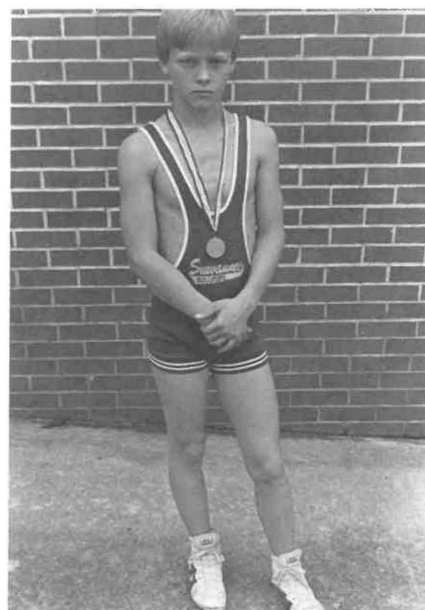
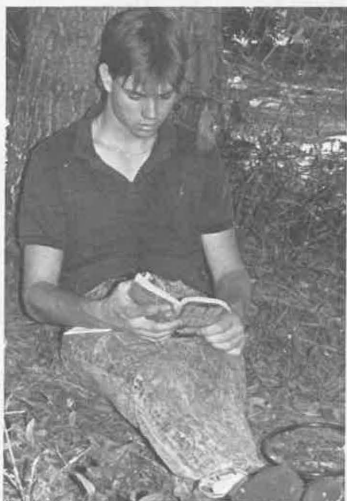




Springtime was also clean-up time

BOYS RANCH IS . . .

A residential group child care program for Florida's neglected, unsupervised, and troubled boys between the ages of eight and eighteen. It is not an institution for juvenile delinquents. The Boys Ranch is sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. It was founded in 1957 and currently has approximately 108 boys in residence at any given time. The Boys Ranch is located in North Florida, about half-way between Jacksonville and Tallahassee and nine miles north of the town of Live Oak on County Rd. 795. Telephone: 904/842-5555

YOUTH VILLA IS . . .

A similar program for boys and girls located two miles east of Bartow, Florida, on Route 60. Originally conceived by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce of Madeira Beach, Florida, the Youth Villa was adopted as a project of the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1970. The first buildings were completed and the first children admitted in 1972. There are approximately 50 boys and girls in residence at any given time. Telephone: 813/533-0371



YOUTH RANCH IS . . .

A residential group child care program of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. It was founded in 1976 and opened in 1978. It is located just east of the intersection of the McMullen-Booth Road and County Road 102 (Enterprise Road) near Clearwater, Florida. The Youth Ranch has approximately 30 boys and girls in residence at any given time. It provides care in a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are neglected, unsupervised and troubled boys and girls. Telephone: 813/725-4761

YOUTH CAMP IS . . .

A facility which operates a Wilderness Camping Program and a Summer Camping Program for boys and girls. The 200-acre campsite is located one mile northeast of Barberville, near Deland. Campers are normally selected from among boys and girls who have had Requests for Service submitted to the Youth Ranches on their behalf. Many of these youngsters are already on the waiting list for admission to Youth Ranches residential facilities. The camping program was initiated in 1981 and moved to its present location in late 1982. Ph: 904/749-9999

CARUTH CAMP IS . . .

A Wilderness Program for an eventual capacity of 54 boys and girls situated on an approximately 240-acre site 14 miles north of Crystal River, off U.S. Highway 19, near Inglis. This program was established through the generosity of Mr. and Mrs. W. W. Caruth, Jr., of Dallas, Texas. The Caruths are the owners of The Plantation Inn and Golf Resort in Crystal River. 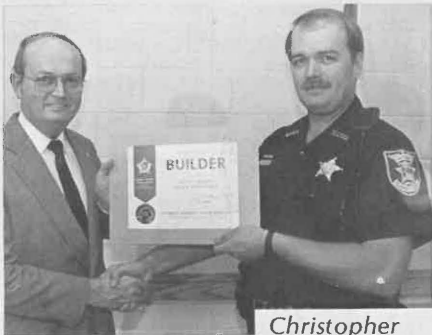
