



#### **Summer Camp Saves Lives**

Summer camp can be the dream of a lifetime for a needy and deserving child. Eight days of learning, working, and fun with caring adults and law enforcement officers and others could mean the difference between a young person becoming an honest, hardworking, productive adult; or turning to a life of crime.

How can this be?

Each year, because of your generosity, hundreds of children enjoy the Florida Sheriffs Summer Camp. The Youth Ranches bus travels statewide to pick up girls and boys from every area of Florida.

Many of these children are needy - they come from families of low to moderate income who are, for the most part, unable to afford to send their youngsters to camp. These boys and girls deserve, and get, the fun and opportunities enjoyed by other American children who go to summer camp. They ride horses, go canoeing, learn archery, and make friends with other children, caring adults, and volunteer law officers in this peaceful, outdoor setting.

A few of these lucky youngsters will get the chance of a lifetime. They will receive much more than an eight-day reprieve from a sometimes difficult home situation; the dangerous, dirty streets; and the strong temptations and pressures of unsupervised peers. Those children with the greatest need and the fewest options may be selected for admission to one of the Youth Ranches year-round residential programs. But, sadly, there is a long waiting list for these services, and, with more boys and girls added daily, that list is growing.

The lucky youngsters eventually chosen for admission to the Youth Ranches programs—designed to prevent juvenile delinquency—will be taught the value of hard work, the importance of respecting adults, and how to care about themselves and others.

Because funding is limited this year, we will only be able to send 350 children to camp instead of the usual 550. However, we are extremely grateful for the generosity of our donor families who are helping to salvage the lives of these children.

Thank you for keeping the bus running! Thanks for the smiles on the faces of hundreds of boys and girls and the sound of laughter - and thanks especially for the very meaningful difference you make in the lives of a special few.






Imagine a world without words; a life without books; an existence without the ability to read or write...

Imagine not realizing that two plus two equals four; simple mathematics equations as incomprehendable; and the inability to count correct change after buying something as small as a candy bar...


Imagine believing the capital of the United States is New York; that Mexico is a state; or Hawaii is a country.

ne of the most common characteristics of the boys that seek shelter and guidance at the Florida Sheriffs Caruth Camp is their constant struggle against educational obstacles. Due to emotional handicaps, learning disabilities, or behavioral problems, most of these troubled boys were "failing" in the classic school setting. Through the joint efforts of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches and the Levy County Dropout Prevention Program, these youngsters are meeting their educational challenges.

In a school atmosphere that emphasizes respect, and a lack of pressure, the Caruth Camp Learning Center is a place that allows kids the opportunity to try without fear of failure. The typical, formal classroom structure has made way for more "hands on"

learning experiences, where achievements are more immediate and meaningful.

"I conduct a lot of one-on-one tutoring with the boys," says Caruth Camp Director of Education Manny Smigel. "Those sessions give them the personal attention they need."

Mr. Smigel points to a set of their "Class Agreements" hanging on the Learning Center wall. Six rules are always within sight: speak with permission, raise your hand, keep your hands to yourself, be respectful, maintain good posture, and always

"I give no grades, all they must prove to me is that they are trying," continues Mr. Smigel. "Success breeds success. This is a school atmosphere that the kids enjoy; these youngsters actually *like* school now! That's the first step in turning them around!"

One major link in the educational program at Caruth Camp was established a few years ago with the publication of their first Caruth Camp Capers, a small newsletter filled with stories, experiences, and original drawings produced solely by the Campers. Required Capers contributions broaden the boy's writing skills, creative expression, and attention span.

Since attending a special group session that acquainted the Campers with today's popular writers, some of the boys are hooked on the idea of becoming famous authors. One young man is literally teaching himself to write by sounding-out words and letters, and using the Learning Center computer's spell-check as a guide.

"The boy's progress has been remarkable," notes Mr. Smigel. "Some of the students that were once hesitant to read in class, now *volunteer* to lead lessons; their spelling has improved; their writing has strengthened."

Special group field trips to historical sites such as Fort Sumter or ancient Indian tribal lands, also provide opportunities for Campers to study the basics of math, history, geography, reading, and writing. By calculating expenses, working out itinerary, preparing a budget, and capturing their experiences on paper, Caruth Campers are exposed to a unique teaching method

where "homework" takes the form of practical knowledge and "hands on" experience.

The imagination of a young boy will come to life when he discovers the joys of learning at the Florida Sheriffs Caruth Camp. Each day, boys are realizing their dreams and becoming young men; learning the road to maturity and responsibility; discovering that through education and literacy, you can accomplish whatever goals you set out to reach.




As I sit at my desk, I watch and think . . . Of these young adults, through perseverance of heart and mind; through the struggles; the attempts;


#### After 22,000 miles, through 25 states, in only four months... "Reverse" Is Moving Forward

Dale Culverson — slightly unshaven, baseball cap tipped back to the sky — is reliving a moment of self discovery . . .

"It was during a training session," recalls Dale. "My rig was stopped at a traffic light, when we unexpectedly started rolling backwards. I managed to stop quickly, but ever since then, I've been known as 'Reverse.'"

Dale lived at the Boys Ranch throughout the 1980s, spending time at both Lewis and Saunders cottages, respectively. Mom and Pop Whitehead were pleased he dropped by to say hello. "At one point in time, he was a young man with very little focus," says Mom Whitehead. "It's so nice to see him so excited, to have a direction and a passion in his life."

Driving a 25-ton semi down the lonely, open highways of misty mornings, steamy days, and darkened nights may not be one of the most glamorous of professions — Dale is first to admit that. "It's a living, but it's also something I enjoy. I'm

happy with how things have turned out. There has to be truck drivers in this world . . . I'm just happy to be one of them."

There are many restrictions for drivers to know, functions to learn, and laws to obey while at the wheel — just holding onto it being the first. "You don't just jump in a rig one day and start driving," says Dale. "I went to school to become a driver; I studied; I practiced; I learned how to repair my truck, adjust the brakes, secure the load, fill-out the proper logs. I have four licenses just in order to drive...legally and safely."

Dale's experiences have also been an inspiration to Jeff, a teenage Boys Ranch resident interested in becoming a truck driver as well. Does all that driving scare him? "Nah, I know I'll love it," says Jeff.

So, how does Dale manage to concentrate, driving up to 500 miles a day? "He keeps me company," says Dale with a smile, patting his young mutt. "'Dog' always comes along for the ride."

Newman attributes the extraordinary success of his food company to two policies. First, he insists on top quality products without the addition of artificial ingredients or preservatives. Second, and perhaps most importantly, he donates ALL profits — after taxes — to educational and charitable organizations around the world.

Since its founding in 1982, Mr. Newman has given away approximately \$62 million — one hundred percent of after-tax profits — to needy, charitable organizations. Mr. Newman reviews all the requests for funding, and personally selects the groups and organizations that receive contributions annually. He is continually searching for organizations outside of the charity mainstream that help those who often cannot help themselves.

Recently, Newman has focused his attentions on children's issues and, as part of last year's \$6 million profit, he personally selected the Florida Sheriffs





# WHAT AN OPPORTUNITY . . . Store that is!

When the first Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Opportunity Store opened its doors in 1987, no one could have imagined what a positive impact it would have on the youth of our state.

In just eight years, the Youth Ranches network of Opportunity Stores has reached four (Live Oak, Stuart, Crystal River, and Delray Beach, the latest addition).

Dedicated to preventing juvenile delinquency, the Opportunity or Thrift Stores have provided a creative way for donors to give items other than cash to raise funding to help troubled, neglected, and underprivileged children of Florida.

The Delray Beach store, like the other Opportunity Stores around the state, offers everything from apparel to appliances and electronics to jewelry. "The money that comes from the four thrift stores is used to support the Ranches and help the kids," says retired Palm Beach County Sheriff Richard Wille. "Our goal is to get these neglected children back into a stable living environment in their communities and with their families."

With broad smiles crossing the faces of campers, friends, and families, the Florida Sheriffs Caruth Campers welcomed all to their campus. Recently named the "Hoedown in the Hammock," this special event brought hundreds of people out for good food, fellowship, and fun.

Throughout the day, many of the boys had the chance to help others see and understand their life at Caruth. The American Council on Gift Annuities meets every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.


