


## **President's Perspective**

Danny excelled in the on-campus work program at the Boys Ranch. The structured environment and vocational skills he learned have helped him develop a strong work ethic and eagerness to succeed. These qualities landed him a job at the Youth Ranches Opportunity Store in Live Oak.

Danny's love of the outdoors and Florida's unique citrus industry have led him to a wonderful job opportunity. He is looking forward to moving out on his own and continuing his education.



At one time or another, most, if not all, have taken time to sit on the peaceful banks of the serene Suwannee River. It is a very thoughtful place; the only sounds are those of the songbirds happily singing, the wind in the ancient oaks, and perhaps a fish leaping from the cool waters. So whether in 1957 or 1997, for forty years the majestic Suwannee River has helped heal troubled lives and brought about boyhood joy.

signed to teach youth teamwork and encourage imaginations to solve various problems facing the group. The youth will also practice teamwork paddling a canoe across the still waters of the lake. Some youngsters will experience the thrill of riding a horse for the first time. Others will enjoy the cool waters of the swimming pool on a hot summer afternoon.

Since 1981, our generous donor family has made it possible for over 5,500 hurting and troubled youngsters to attend summer camp. Young boys and girls spend 5 days with caring counselors and dedicated Deputy Sheriffs, who help them begin the healing of wounds from abuse, neglect, and other problems. Many of the youth who attend camp carry scars from broken homes and broken dreams. These youngsters have little hope in life and need a guiding hand and loving support.

Summer camp is designed to enhance self-

esteem, strengthen peer relationships, and build selfconfidence. It also gives these unfortunate boys and girls a chance in which to be carefree, enjoy life, and learn there is hope; they can follow a path to a better and brighter future.

At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, we have a long-term investment in children. We teach them a strong work ethic, traditional values, and help them plan for the future. We make sure our children have the skills necessary to lead productive, lawabiding lives, and make a positive contribution to the community.

At the Boys Ranch, many acres of planted pine trees offer valuable lessons including forestry management, wildlife conservation, and planning for the future. The mature pine



trees provide a habitat for wildlife, prevent erosion, and provide a future income for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Most of the pine trees are planted by tractor in long rows. However, small areas are planted by the young men who participate in the farm work program. The boys work in teams of two. One places the trees on the ground where they should be planted, and the other walks behind with a tool designed to make planting quick and easy. Together the Ranchers plant the young seedlings in the ground. As the day of work ends, a youngster can survey the land seeing the fruits of his labor. Looking upward he can also appreciate those who came before him and planted the pines which will help provide for his future.




#### Mobile Missionaries lend a helping hand






