


President's Perspective

one important activity at the Boys Ranch which teaches youth proper values, a strong work ethic and helps build the positive relationships, responsibility and respect they need to succeed.






Weathering the Storm

Now You See It. Now You Don't -**Youth Ranches** property was submerged due to torrential rains and storms brought on by a unique weather phenomenon called, El Nino.




nfortunately, the same bizarre weather patterns that have ravaged much of the nation, and the rest of the world, have also severely affected life at some of the Youth Ranches residential campuses. Flooding has been the main culprit. The Suwannee River remains many feet above flood stage, while the dock at the Youth Camp/Barberville remains underwater, swallowed by a lake usually used by campers for canoeing. Luckily, no one has been injured during the unpredictable storm season, but property damage is mounting.


"We have actually been lucky ... it could have been a lot worse," says Youth Ranches President Harry K. Weaver. "I have confidence our donor family will respond quickly in this time of crisis with gifts to help make major repairs."

Along with severe flooding, high winds and heavy rains have also caused extensive damage to Youth Ranches properties. The roof on Merrill Cottage at the Boys Ranch was crushed when hurricane-force wind gusts downed trees throughout the campus. Fortunately, none of the boys were hurt when the pine smashed through their roof, but the fall has left a gaping hole and a pile of broken timber to repair.

"All of the boys have shown tremendous pride in the campus," says Mr. Weaver. "Everyone has pitched in with the clean-up effort . . . it has truly taken teamwork."




says Arthur. "I had to do certain things, like work and study. Now, I have really learned to love and enjoy them."

In my mind, I have a dream, to always play on the winning team; To use wisely all I've seen, and reach my goals with self-esteem.


In my mind, I have a fear, of falling back towards the rear; But I remember, I'm in the clear, my friends, my teachers, my peers are near.




A River of Dreams

Reuniting and repairing broken families is a primary concern of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. Unfortunately, many needy youth are unable to return home due to unhealthy circumstances. These deserving boys and girls must find love, shelter and guidance in other places; these youngsters are cared for by "moms" and "pops"; these underprivileged kids live in cottages and call the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches home.

When Rancher Michael graduates from Suwannee High School in less than two years, he will have spent nearly a decade, almost half his life, in the loving care of the Youth Ranches. Michael entered the program at the Florida Sheriffs Caruth Camp (then a unique wilderness camping program) as a youngster in desperate need of guidance and special attention. It was at the camp, under those therapeutic conditions, he discovered his love of nature and learned the value of the environment.









"I remember canoe trips at Caruth," says Michael. "The river was always peaceful and quiet...it always gave me time to think."

After a productive stay at the Caruth Camp, Michael graduated to the Boys Ranch located on the banks of the majestic Suwannee River. This comprehensive residential program offered grand new experiences and a healthy home environment to continue his growth and maturation. Michael even quickly discovered his primary passion while working on the farm.

"I love animals," says Michael. "Caring for them is special to me."

By feeding cows and bulls, and by mowing and clearing pastures, teens like Michael learn a proper work ethic, sense of responsibility

and self-respect. Performing duties on the farm help youngsters develop in other areas of their life as well. Since joining the Boys Ranch, Michael has received many campus recognitions including the Agriculture, Most Improved and Best Worker Awards.

"I want to go to college and become a herpetologist," says Michael.




"It's someone who studies reptiles and amphibians."

Today, Michael is able to canoe a different river, a river of peace, satisfaction and promise; it is a river of dreams, a river of dreams come true.






hey've grown," he says. "I remember when we planted those trees; they were no more than three feet tall . . . it brings back lots of memories."

"Everything I learned at the Ranch I use in my life today," says Tom. "Honesty, integrity, hard work, church . . . to be there when family or friends need me, and most importantly, how to swallow my pride."

After spending much of his childhood shuffling between nearly 20 foster and temporary homes, Tom credits the Boys Ranch and its extraordinary caregivers, some of whom remain today, with grounding

Today, with a wife and two teenage children of his own, Tom continues to dedicate his life to his loved ones, his community and the boys who now look to him for guidance.

"Family comes first," says Tom. "I enjoy working with the boys, going to chapel on Sundays . . . bringing my family to service."



Perhaps it was Tom's maturity, quick-thinking and pure heroics which illustrates his own words best. When one of the worst fires in Boys Ranch history accidentally erupted in Conn Cottage by a forgotten candle, it was Tom who, through pillows of black smoke, checked each room in the house to make certain all of his housemates had woken and made it out of the cot-

Boys and girls interact in a unique classroom environment, building social skills, peer relationships, and the ability to participate effectively in their respective grade levels.

Now, thanks to the generosity of the late Ruth Bell, a loyal Youth Ranches supporter during her lifetime, a new Learning Center will be built at the Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota and named in her honor. It will help future Ranchers improve their educations and redirect their lives.

"Miss Bell never married and often spoke of the Youth Ranches as her true 'family," says Dr. Bill Aust. "For her commitment and love, we will be forever grateful."



Leader of the Pack: Pig Plays Mother Goose


A seeing-eye pig? You have to see it, to believe it!



Cry Those Happy Tears



This year, the Youth Ranches says "goodbye, good luck and congratulations," to three of its long-time residents; three boys that have learned many lessons and grown into fine young men.


Rancher B. K. won many awards, received numerous honors and gained a lifetime of memories and friends during his time at the Boys Ranch.






