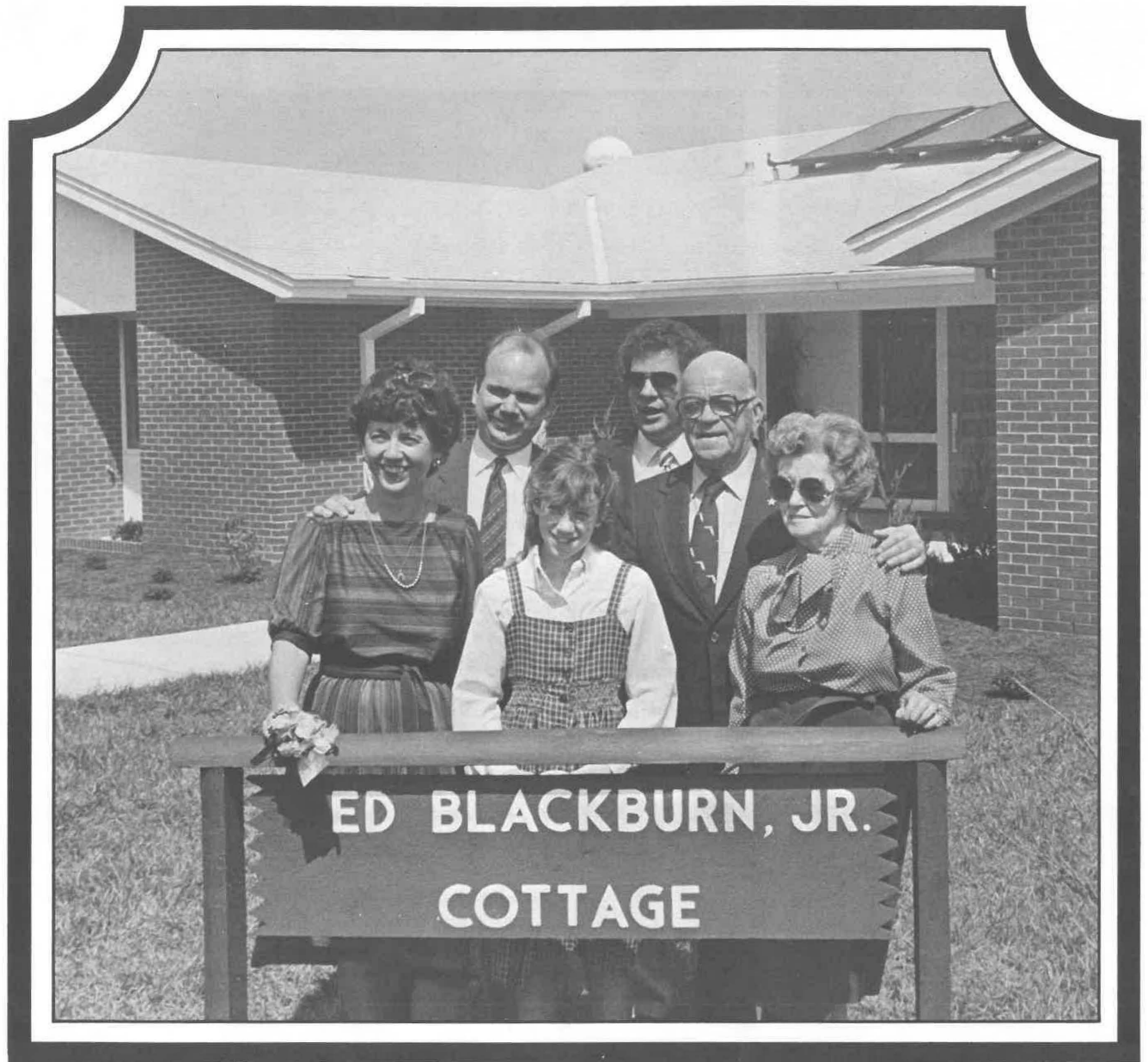

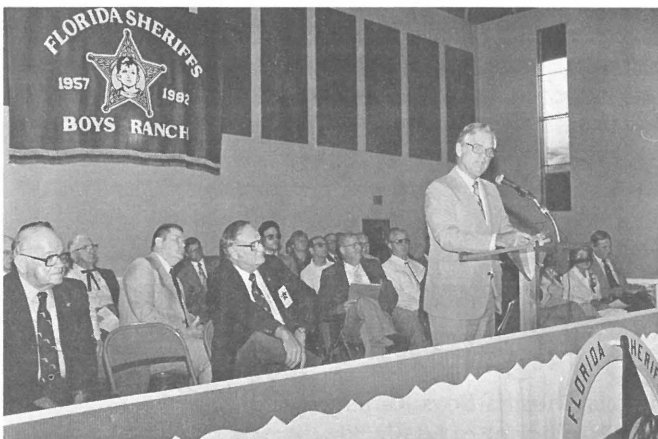
What a Mood! What What a Party!

"You will never, never see a piece of Americana more real . . ." said Lieutenant Governor Wayne Mixson when he gave his impression of the Boys Ranch birthday party. Seated on his immediate right is Berwin Williams, Executive Director of the Florida Sheriffs Association, who introduced Mixson. At the extreme left is former Sheriff Ed Blackburn, Jr., who was highly praised by the Lieutenant Governor for his role as one of the founders of the Boys Ranch.

The Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch celebrated its 25th anniversary during the first three days of October with a mood and a message.

The mood was euphoric — as folksy and nostalgic as a Norman Rockwell painting. Everything seemed to rhyme. Life was all sunshine and sentimentality. Handshakes were hardy, smiles were broad, and pecks on the cheek were downright puckery.

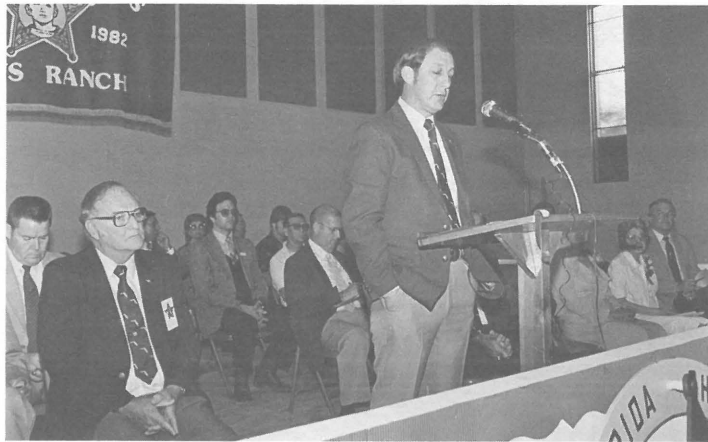
The message was a brother to the mood. It proclaimed that old fashioned American virtues are still alive . . . that people of all ages can still find joy in simple shared pleasures . . . that we are still a nation of self-reliant volunteers.

Perhaps not all of the nearly 4,000 guests sensed the mood or the message, but Lieutenant Governor Wayne Mixson did almost as soon as he arrived. The revelation came to him while he was watching the grand entry parade at the horse show arena, and he described it later when he delivered the anniversary address.

"I was out there a while ago when the horses came into the arena," he told a packed audience in the Boys Ranch gymnasium. "I saw those colorful flags, and the beautiful rolling fields, and the streaming sunshine . . .

the cool and comfortable day, and that clear trumpet piercing the sky and filtering up through those straight pines . . .

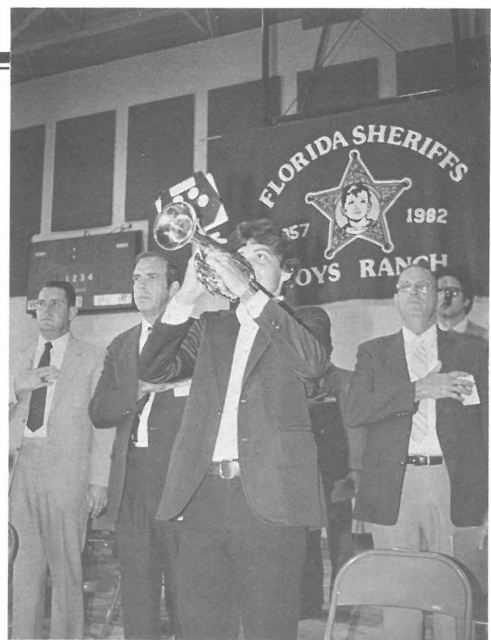
“And I said to a newspaper editor from Jacksonville who was out there writing . . . I said ‘You had better catch it, because you will never, never see a piece of Americana more real than you have caught right out there right now!

“I mean this is what it’s all about. Tall straight timbers . . . the inspiration to build tall, straight men. That’s the mission of this great institution. That’s the accomplishment of this great institution. I was so carried away that I wanted to throw away my prepared speech and make one about that, but I won’t do that altogether.”

Mixson spoke of the Boys Ranch as a shining example of what volunteers can accomplish. “That’s the American way,” he said, and he went on to praise the thousands of loyal supporters who have “poured out their resources and themselves in love and compassion to help young people become strong men.

“We have drifted as a people too far away from the volunteerism that characterized our country,” he

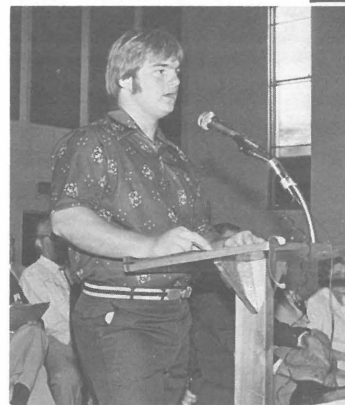

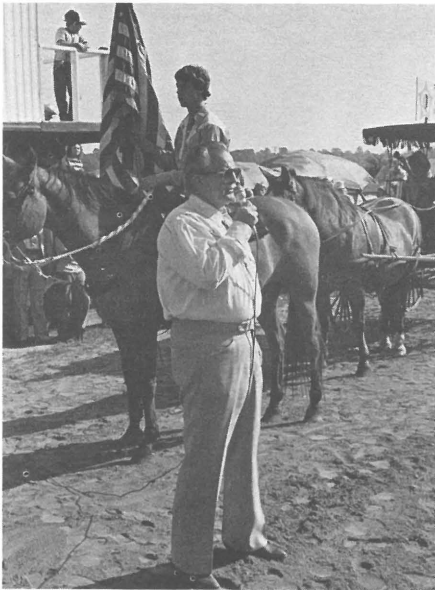

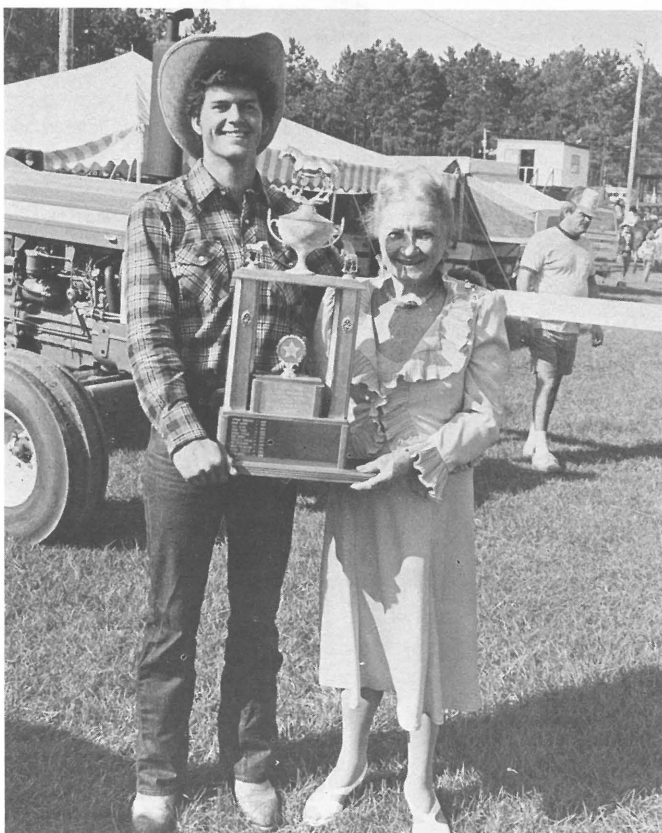
Although confined to a wheelchair by recent knee surgery, Rancher Billy Dowell insisted upon carrying out his anniversary program assignment. He delivered the invocation.

added, quoting President Ronald Reagan. "We have in a sense abdicated and turned over to the government things that used to be functions of the community and the neighborhood.

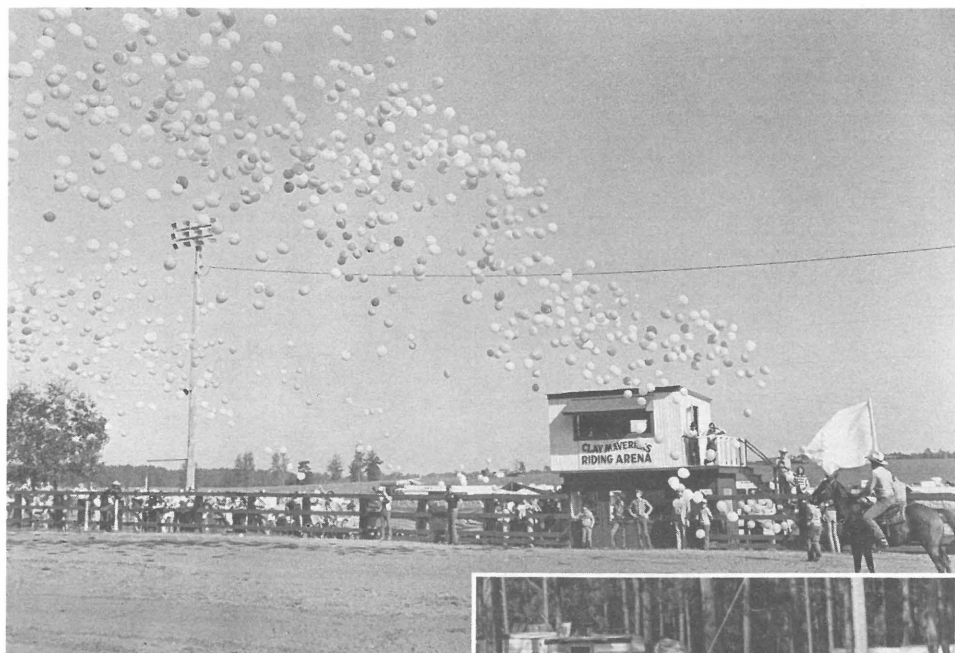
Volunteerism . . . can take over and do things that are not being done very well by the government."

Mixson praised the founders of the Boys Ranch, and particularly Ed Blackburn, Jr., former Sheriff, lawmaker and state official. He said boys and girls, men and women are living rich, productive lives as a result of the founders' efforts.

"The state and our nation are reaping the harvest of the seeds that were planted here. The shadow of this institution is a lengthening shadow, pointing the way through the deserts of many of our failures."

After quoting a newspaper column in which Erma Bombeck described the kind of nightmare world that would exist if volunteerism ever died out, Mixson added: "It won't be that way. The dream won't be a nightmare because a rising tide of Ed Blackburns and folks like that won't let it be."

Blackburn also spoke during the anniversary rites, calling the roll of Boys Ranch founders, and drawing special

attention to former Sheriffs Don Genung, Otho Edwards, Willis McCall, Bill Taff, Monroe Brannen and Broward Coker, who were on the speaker's platform.

He expressed regret that Tommy Musgrove, the Suwannee County farmer who donated the original building site, and J. L. McMullen, Live Oak businessman who served as a Boys Ranch trustee and treasurer for many years, were not able to attend.

Honoring the memory of founders who are deceased, Blackburn mentioned former Sheriffs Hugh Lewis, Ross Boyer, Don McLeod, Maurice Linton, John Spottswood and Leslie Bessenger.

He described Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund President Harry Weaver as a near miracle man, and praised him for the professional staff he has assembled. Then he said: "It makes no difference what we say here. What makes a difference is what they do here. And, as for me, let it suffice to say that my cup runneth over."

Blackburn saluted the Boys Ranch alumni "for the honor they bring back to this Ranch . . . by serving as good citizens and good Americans."

Boys Ranch Alumni Association President Robert Knight told the audience former Ranchers are proud of

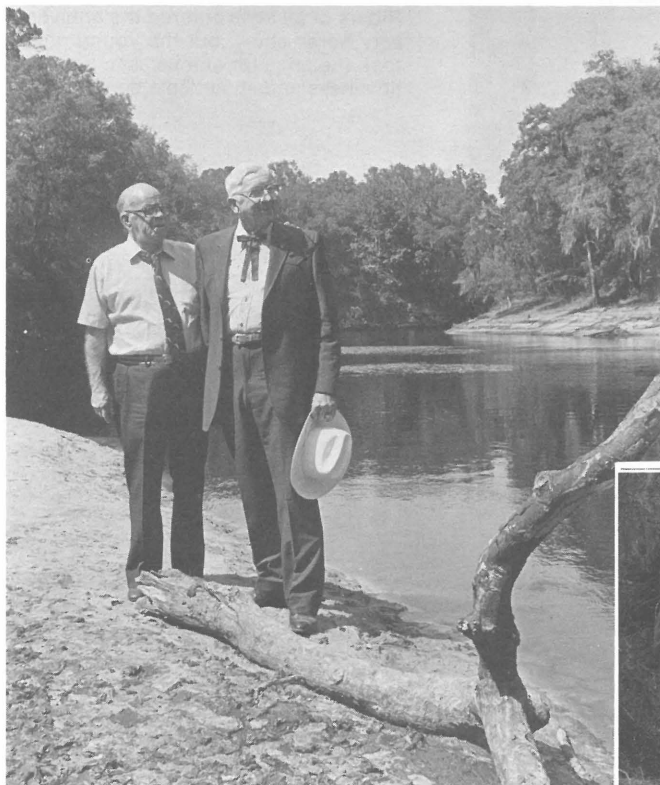

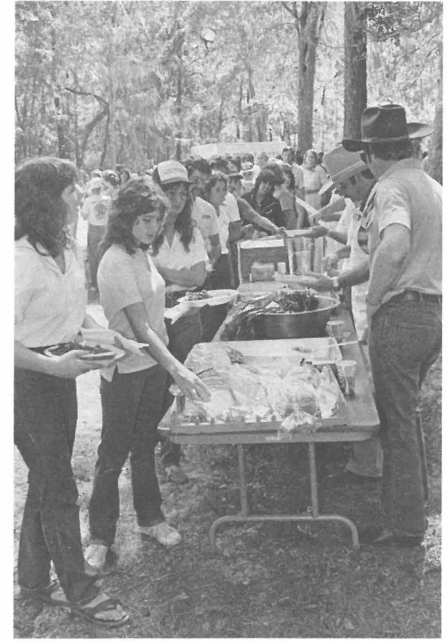

the part they have played in the history of the Boys Ranch, and they are looking forward to participating in its future growth.

Shortly thereafter a brief ribbon-cutting ceremony was held at the Ed Blackburn, Jr., cottage — the ninth and final residence facility in a master plan that came off the drawing board more than 20 years ago.

Old timers noted that the Boys Ranch had come full circle, since Blackburn had broken ground for the first cottage in 1958, and was now cutting the ribbon to open the last one.

The anniversary celebration opened on Friday, October 1, when guests began filling up the campground near the arena with their tents, motor homes, campers and horse trailers. They were greeted, as usual, with heaping plates of chicken pilau cooked in an iron pot over an open fire.

Street dances were held on the Boys Ranch campus Friday and Saturday nights.

The traditional anniversary horse show, with events for children and adults, began Friday evening and ended Sunday afternoon, with time out for eating and sleeping. The 422 horses and ponies entered in the show set a new record. So did the general attendance of almost 4,000 guests.

After the anniversary rites in the gymnasium and the ribbon-cutting ceremony at the Ed Blackburn, Jr., residence cottage, the crowd drifted down to the Suwannee River for an old fashioned barbecue.

On Saturday evening there was a sentimental reunion of former Sheriffs, Ranchers and Ranch staff members. Some long-time supporters of the Ranch also mingled.

Sunday morning, not long after sunrise, a small crowd gathered at the arena for an outdoor worship service.

After lunch the horsemen started packing bridles and saddles. Tents were struck. Campfires were doused, and weary members of the Boys Ranch staff began clean-up operations.

The euphoric mood that had prevailed for three extra special days seemed to be evaporating, but the message . . . well, the message lingered on in the fading light, throwing a long shadow toward the future.

Now We Know What It's Like to be A Celebrity in Washington, D.C.

To fly to Washington, D.C. . . . to sit down to lunch with U.S. Senators and Representatives . . . to be interviewed by the press . . . to receive copies of a resolution passed by Congress in your honor . . .

Normally this sort of lionizing is reserved for heroes, celebrities and VIPs; but six youngsters with no claim to fame received "the full red carpet treatment" on September 13, 14, and 15, as part of the festivities celebrating the 25th Anniversary of the Boys Ranch.

It was a memorable trip, and it was made possible by J. P. Hall, Jr., a Green Cove Springs banker with a long-standing sentimental attachment to the Boys Ranch. Hall's father, the late Clay County Sheriff John P. Hall, Sr. was one of the founders of the Boys Ranch. He was also the first treasurer of the Boys Ranch Trust Fund and helped to guide the bold, unique venture through its most perilous days.

The Sheriff's son witnessed the growth of the Boys

Ranch, and after the Sheriff died the son inherited his father's keen interest in the progress of the project. Several months ago the son learned that plans were being made to celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Boys Ranch, and he volunteered to sponsor a trip to the nation's capital for a representative group of boys and girls.

Hall's offer was accepted and arrangements were completed through the combined efforts of Sheriffs and Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund officials.

The six outstanding teen-agers chosen to make the trip were David Henck and Billy Dowell from the Boys Ranch; Debra Dickler and Cindy Landry from the Girls Villa; and Penny Parker and Robert Martinez from the Youth Ranch. Mr. and Mrs. Beck McCoy, who are cottage parents at the Boys Ranch, agreed to go along as chaperones.

The young people and their chaperones flew to Washington on September 13; checked in at the Hospi-

tality House Hotel; and had dinner with a group of Florida Sheriffs and Youth Fund officials. J. P. Hall, Jr. joined them there.

Next day they went to the Capitol building where they had lunch with Florida's Congressional delegation. During the luncheon Representative Charles E. Bennett presented Florida Sheriffs Association President W. A. Woodham with a Congressional resolution commending Sheriffs and Florida citizens for the success of the Boys Ranch.

Representative Don Fuqua, a former Boys Ranch Trustee, presented the visitors with a flag that had been raised over the Capitol. It was accepted by Youth Fund President Harry Weaver and Youth Fund Board Chairman Louie Mims, who is the Sheriff of Polk County.

In response, the visitors presented personalized Boys Ranch Anniversary coffee mugs to the members of Florida's Congressional delegation.

After the luncheon the teen-agers were taken on a special tour of the Capitol by James C. Rodenberg, Special Assistant to U. S. Senator Paula Hawkins. They spent the remainder of that day and part of the next sight-seeing, riding the subway and building a backlog of exciting memories.

Asked by a news reporter what impressed them the

most, the youngsters were temporarily at a loss for words. Finally, one of them blurted out, "The monuments were really neat!" Then off they went to tour the Smithsonian Institution.

Later, as they boarded their flight for the trip home, everyone agreed the Washington visit was an experience "beyond words."

THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH FUND IS . . .

A charitable, non-profit corporation, sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, to manage and operate the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, Youth Ranch, Camping Program and any other youth programs that might later be developed by the Florida Sheriffs Association. An important function of the Youth Fund is the raising, receiving, budgeting, and disbursing of funds for its programs. The Youth Fund and its programs are supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts. Gifts and bequests can be made to the Youth Fund for the exclusive benefit of any single program, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, or Youth Ranch, or they may be made without restriction to be distributed among existing programs as most needed or to be used for the development of new programs at the discretion of the Governing Board. Youth Fund Central Offices are co-located with the Boys Ranch.

BOYS RANCH IS . . .

A residential group child care program for dependent, neglected, or homeless boys between the ages of eight and eighteen. It is not an institution for juvenile delinquents. The Boys Ranch is sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. It was founded in 1957 and currently has approximately 108 boys in residence at any given time. The Boys Ranch is located in North Florida, about halfway between Jacksonville and Tallahassee and nine miles north of the town of Live Oak on County Road 795.

GIRLS VILLA . . .

A similar program for girls located two miles east of Bartow, Florida, on Route 60. Originally conceived by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce of Madeira Beach, Florida, the Girls Villa was adopted as a project of the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1970. The first buildings were completed and the first girls admitted in 1972. There are approximately 50 girls in residence at any given time. Mailing address and telephone number for the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch are the same as for the Youth Fund.

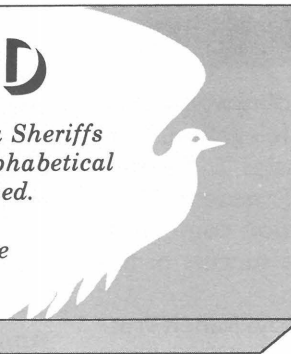
YOUTH RANCH IS . . .

The most recently developed residential group child care program of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund. Also sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, it was opened in 1978. It is located just east of the intersection of the McMullen-Booth Road and County Road 102 near Clearwater, Florida. The Youth Ranch has approximately 30 boys and girls in residence at any given time. It provides care in a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are dependent, neglected, or homeless. Mailing address and telephone number are the same as for the Youth Fund.

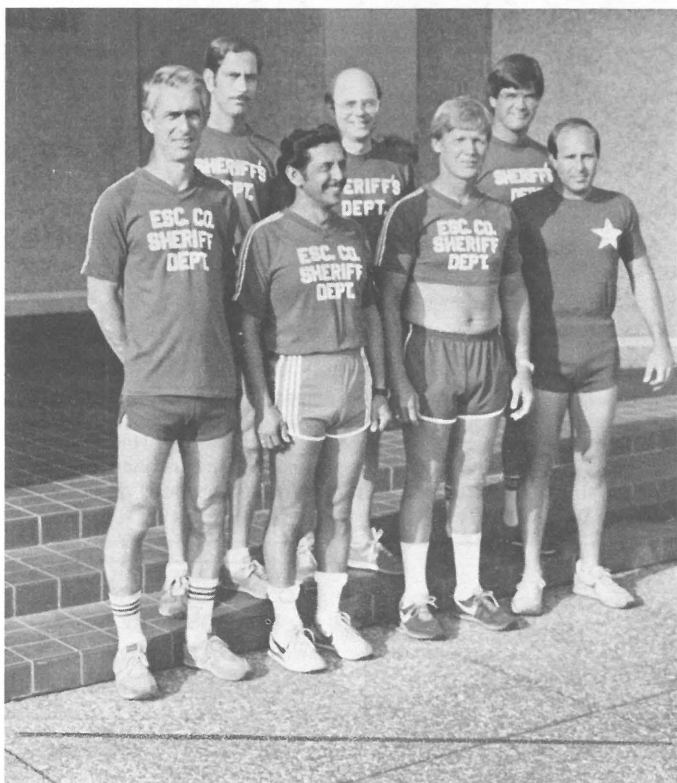

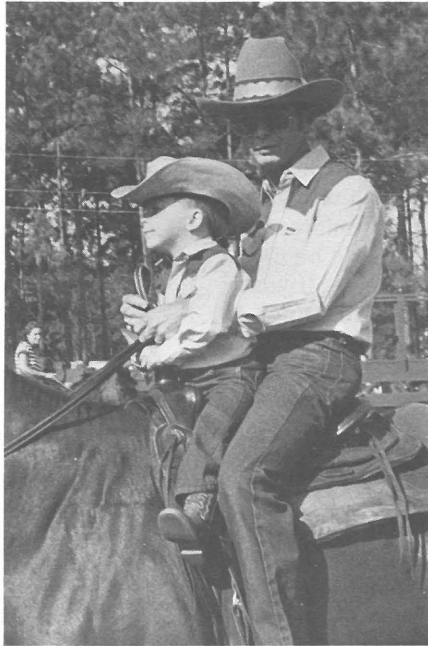
