The Sotatee name combines the counties SaraSOTA and ManaTEE, and commemorates the joint effort of each county and its Sheriff.

This work, resulting in a new home for ten children, so inspired Mr. and Mrs. McCune that they personally funded another important need on campus. Their gift also made good use of the time and talents of the workers on campus, and added a second building project to the list. The new McCune Staff House will enable a caring couple to help provide 24-hour supervision for the children.

Yet another individual, Mrs. Robson, joined in and provided the money necessary to equip and furnish the entire Sotatee Cottage.


So many caring people made this a reality! So many believe these young lives are worth the investment!



n an imperfect world, it is unfortunate that young children so often become young victims, suffering abuse and neglect at the hands of family and friends entrusted to protect them. The mere existence of these unthinkable acts offer little opportunity for troubled youth to escape unhealthy family relationships. But, among the despair of broken families, through the guiding wisdom and absolute kindness of those who truly care, at-risk youngsters and needy brothers and sisters are receiving the chance to heal delicate wounds. Together, through a unique program at the Youth Ranch/Safety Harbor, families are overcoming obstacles and repairing broken hearts and broken lives.

Roy arrived at Safety Harbor two and a half years ago, several grade levels behind his peers in school. In only a short time, under the steady supervision of concerned counselors and supportive staff, he has experienced dramatic improvements. "Roy literally finished four grade levels in two years," says Youth Ranches Resident Director Joe Ballard. "He wasn't content to simply 'get by'

either; he passed with practically all As."

Thanks to the Ranch's unique atmosphere and commitment to reuniting broken families by keeping brothers and sisters together, Roy has excelled in all phases of campus life. Since moving on campus, he has received a scholarship to become certified in catamaran sailing, joined a local youth basketball league, and developed a passion for fishing. "Roy has been taking care of his own exotic fish and tank," says Youth Ranches Supervisor of Recreation Brad Gregory. "He is also responsible for the care of the rabbits on campus and one of only two trained in the maintenance of the pool; he's just a true leader and one of the hardest workers we have."

As 1993-94 Turnaround Student of the Year at Safety Harbor Middle School and the 1994 Resident Director Award recipient, the key to Roy's early success has been

the result of amazing dedication as well as the special bond he shares with his two sisters, also residing on campus. "Roy has quite a sense of responsibility to his sisters," continues Mr. Ballard. "In all practicality, he's the man of the family . . . being a positive role model is very important to him."

Jennifer also arrived at Safety Harbor two and a half years ago, unsure about the future. Like her brother, she has flourished through the Ranch's dedication to supporting the special needs of neglected brothers and sisters. Jennifer has earned the Resident Director Award, and certification in

catamaran sailing. In addition, through a unique scholarship program, Jennifer was eligible for professional instructions in runway modeling and ballroom dancing. "Jen loves the chance she's had to model," says Mom Wagner. "It has been such a self-esteem builder; I can see her confidence grow each time she walks down the platform."

Today, Jennifer is busy setting goals and enjoying the possibilities of a new and positive future. At only fourteen, she recently was only one of two selected to participate in a federally-funded program through the local division of Youth Employment Services, an organization that sponsors ambitious children who wish to get a taste of the working world, but are not legally of age to seek employment. "I can't wait until I'm old enough to work," says Jennifer. "Since I was nine years old, I've wanted to practice criminal law."





Trish arrived at Safety Harbor two and a half years ago, virtually a non-reader. Through the helping hand of supportive friends and teachers, Trish's vocabulary has improved tremendously and her grades have sky-rocketed. "I have been so impressed with Trish's progress," says Mr. Ballard. "She does everything we ask, never complains."

With Roy and Jennifer living by her side, this youngest of the three has benefitted from the influence of her siblings and has also gained the confidence and courage to explore new interests. "Roy and she spend a lot of valuable time together fishing, sailing, shooting baskets," reports Mr. Ballard. "The two even repainted their cottage office together."

With guitar always nearby, Trish has also uncovered a talent for music. During a recent talent show competition held on campus, Trish was hoping to perform 27 acts. "We had to compromise at five," smiles Mr. Ballard. "She is just so full of spirit and promise."

Roy, Jennifer, and Trish arrived at Safety Harbor two and a half years ago, together. Under the warm sunshine of an afternoon, or the cool shadows of an evening sunset, the three now walk and talk, together; fish and sail, together; play and work, together; laugh and cry, together. These deserving brothers and sisters have learned to overcome many obstacles; together they have been given the chance to be a family. "We really do see this as our home," says Roy. "It's the best place to be, the same kids with the same problems . . . in fact, this is the longest I've ever been in one place . . . and, with my sisters." Blossoming Future! Trish is all smiles since arriving at Safety Harbor to live with her brother and sister.


N.A.R.I. – Restoring Hope to Youth Ranches Youth

The National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI) Tampa Bay Area Chapter recently agreed to help the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches with the restoration of a 2,400 squarefoot home which was donated by Lee and Shirlee McCauley and moved to the Youth Ranches 32acre Safety Harbor campus. N.A.R.I. is the only national trade association dedicated to serving residential and commercial remodeling professionals.

The recently relocated home will currently be used as a Youth Ranch staff residence, and will mean increased supervision for the children in residence. Perhaps in the future, it will serve as an independent living facility for older youth.

In order to be moved to the new site, the home was literally cut in half, loaded on a trailer, and driven from Dunedin to Safety Harbor. Due to the nature of such an undertaking, significant repair and construction work was needed to restore the house back to its original, liveable condition.

Mark Cagni, a Director with the local N.A.R.I. chapter, says his organization is delighted to be involved with the project. "Our membership is made up of individuals who are dedicated to the promotion of professionalism in this Building for the Future! The National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI) Tampa Bay













Inside this hunter green post office, orange nylon mail bags stand stuffed and leaning against the walls and floor. Mailpersons work busily at their stations, sorting, sifting, and delivering parcels to their appropriate slots; in the hands of these faithful employees rest the kind words of loved ones, the well-wishes of friends on special birthdays, many congratulations, and the fate of hopeful job-seekers. Their movements are well orchestrated, well planned, and perfectly directed by

A Postman Who Truly Delivers

"We make 25,000 deliveries daily," says Wayne Fidler, Leesburg United States Post Office Clerk Supervisor and Boys Ranch Alumni. "With hundreds of routes to organize and over 80 mail carriers to supervise, it is my responsibility to make sure the mail gets out on time, every day."

Wayne Fidler began his tenure with the Leesburg Post Office as a City Clerk and has witnessed enormous changes throughout the surrounding county. "A population explosion in recent years required us to move into this new facility five years ago," says Mr. Fidler. "In fact, we've already practically grown out of this 26,000 square foot building; I never imagined that would ever happen."

Today, the Leesburg branch office processes over 300 feet of mail per day, making it one of the most prolific and efficient offices in the state. With the advent of full computer-automation next sum-

mer, that number will continue to exceed expectations. Recently, the post office was voted number two in the region, in volume, deliveries, and customer service. "We are evaluated periodically through a random sample survey of patrons in the area," reports Mr. Fidler. "We're very proud to say, that at last inspection, the facility received a 93 out of 100 Customer Service Index rating; the national average is 89."

Public sentiment is also high thanks to a series of special open house celebrations where visiting patrons are cordially invited to take a peak behind the scenes on guided tours of the post office. "Between keeping the public satis-

fied, working with union representatives, and handling local traffic problems around the building, every day is a new and exciting challenge."

The eight years Wayne Fidler spent at the Boys Ranch in the 1960s and 70s remains a fond memory and a primary source of personal inspiration. "I remember, to this day, something Mr. Weaver (then Administrator of the Boys Ranch) used to say to us, 'This place may not be home, but it's the second best thing to it.'"

Living in Pentland Cottage through his years at the Ranch, Mr. Fidler credits his success to numerous caring cottage parents and counselors. "The Ranch was there for me when I needed it, inspired me to receive my education, and helped me get to where I am today.

"Just having a home and settling down," Mr. Fidler continues, "really makes a difference . . . especially when you're a child."

The charitable gift annuity allows you to give to our troubled boys and girls and also provides you and/or someone you designate with a guaranteed periodic payment for life.

A sizeable portion of your gift (cash, stocks, bonds, or mutual funds) is immediately tax deductible and a portion of the periodic annuity payment is tax-free during normal life expectancy. The agreement is irrevocable and is guaranteed by the full assets of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

The amount of the annuity payment is based on the amount of the gift and the age of the annuitant. Typically,

the older you are, the greater the payment.

Organizations that are permitted to issue gift annuity agreements are required by state and federal law to meet stringent financial standards. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in the state of Florida to receive a permit number, which is DAAP-74-1.

The American Council on Gift Annuities meets every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.


