has learned the importance of a solid education. Jon is a caring and respectful young man with a strong ambition to attend college. Even though computers are his first love, he plans to study math and science. He believes they are the keys to the best jobs in the future.

Jon will be the first to tell you he is not perfect. By most measures, though, his turn-around has been remarkable. His current accomplishments reflect a strong personal commitment to making positive choices in his life.

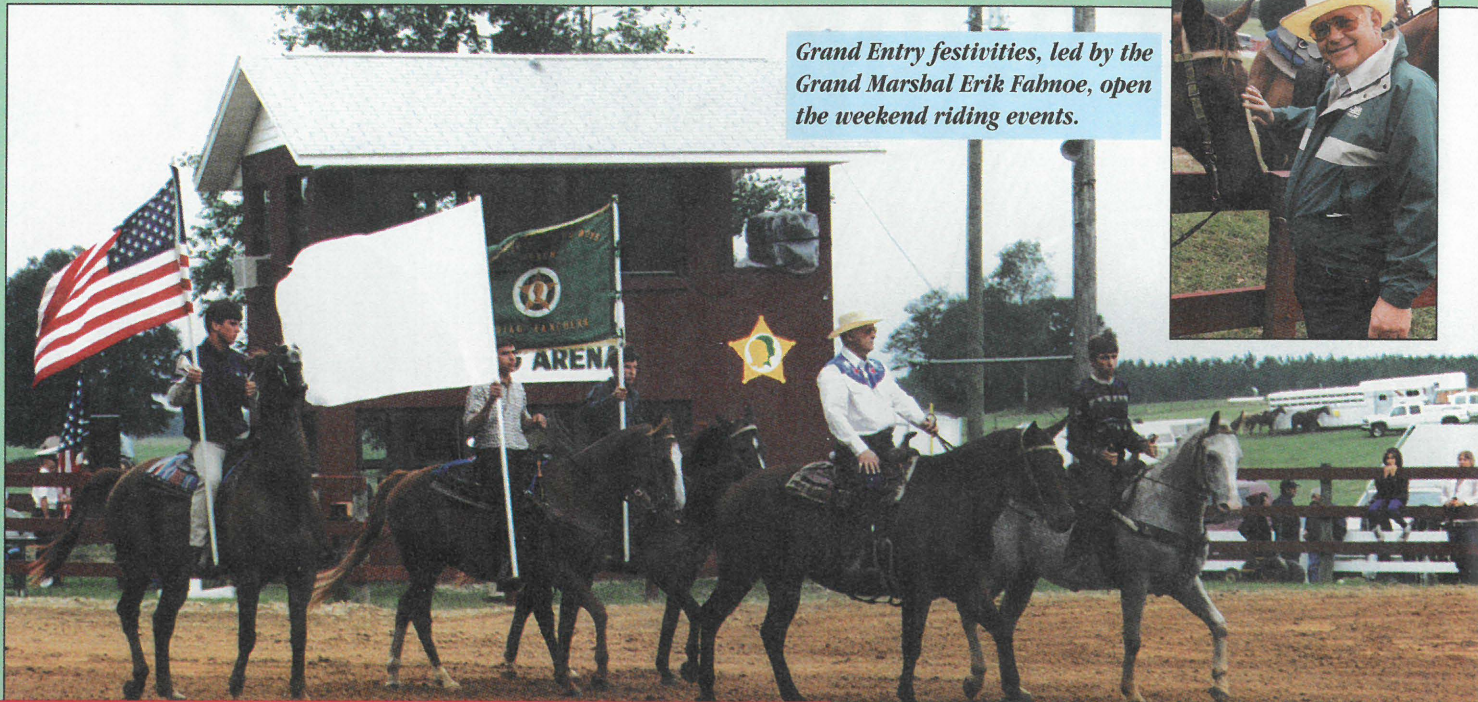

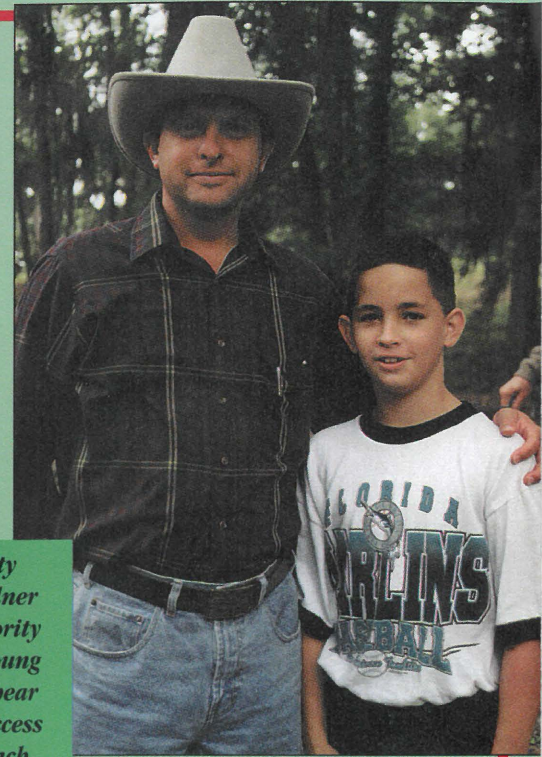
One of the favorite events during Open House weekend is the delicious BBQ served on the banks of the Suwannee River.

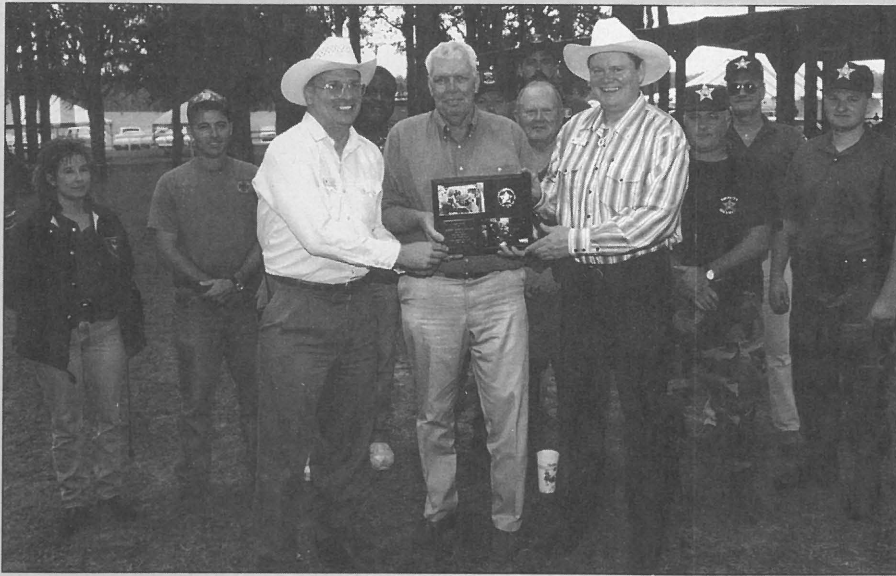

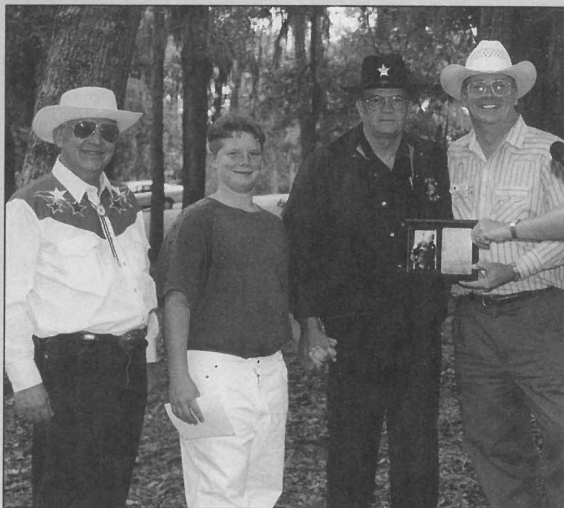


A Time to say "Thank You"

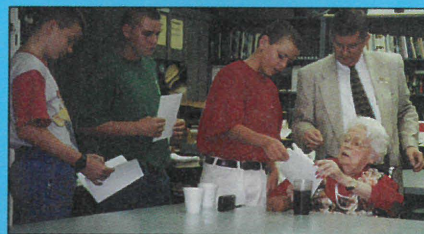
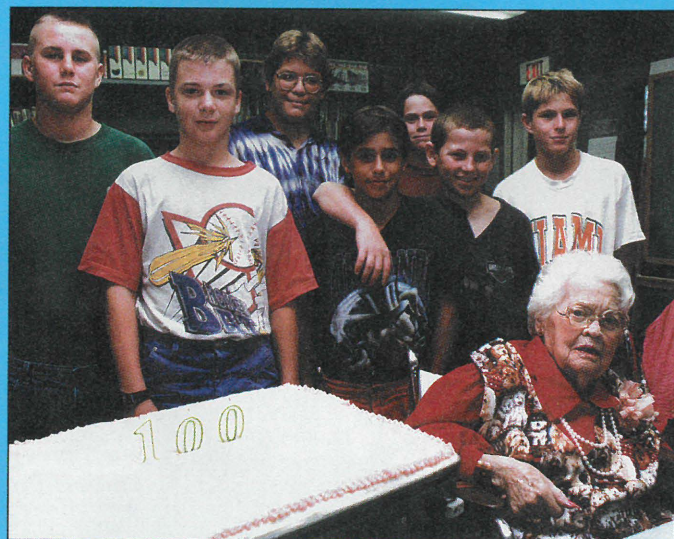
In preparation for our 40th Anniversary celebration, we would like to honor and express our appreciation to many special friends who continue to support the youngsters in our care.

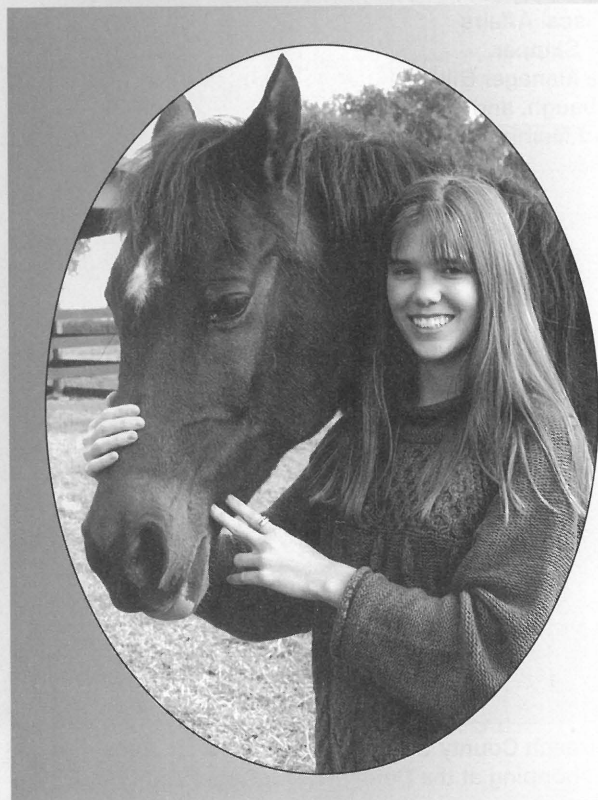
DON'T QUIT

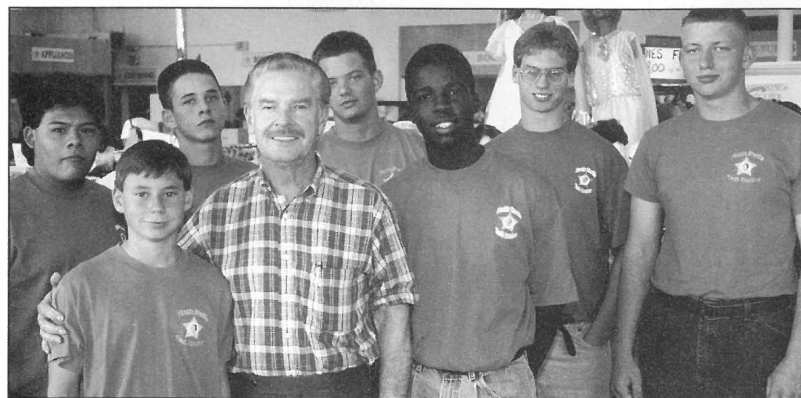


Opportunity Store Hosts Customer Appreciation Day

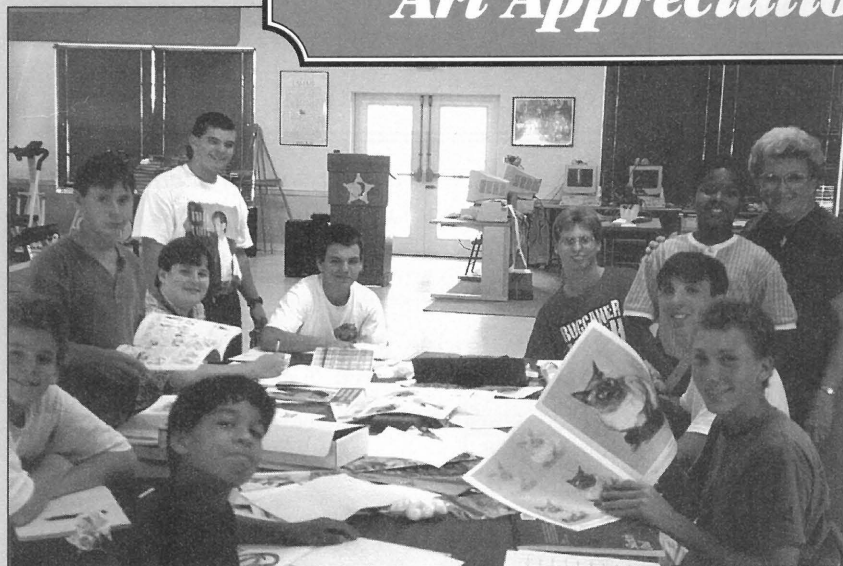

Charitable Gift Annuity



The charitable gift annuity allows you to give to our troubled boys and girls and also provides you and/or someone you designate with a reliable income for life.

A sizeable portion of your gift (cash, stocks, bonds, or mutual funds) is immediately tax deductible and a portion of the annuity income is tax-free during normal life expectancy. The agreement is irrevocable and is supported by the assets of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

The amount of the annuity income is based on the

amount of the gift and the age of the annuitant. Typically, the older you are, the greater the amount you receive.

Organizations permitted to issue gift annuity agreements are required by state law to meet stringent financial standards. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in the state of Florida to receive a permit number, which is DAAP-74-1.

The American Council on Gift Annuities meets every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.

His sister is very seriously ill and this allowed him to be a kid again. It also allowed me a week of not worrying about him while I was at the hospital with my daughter.

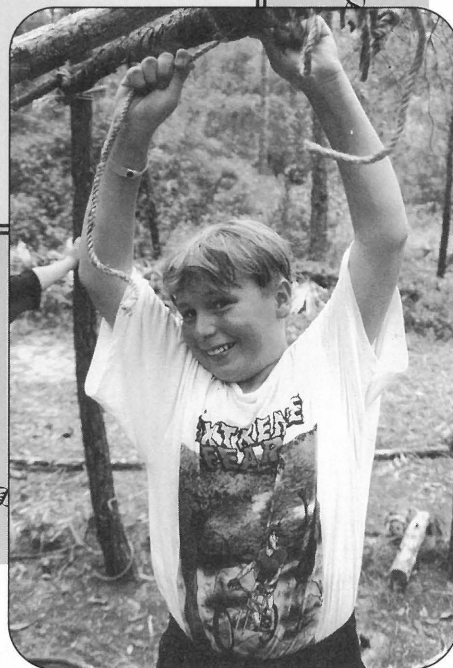

HONOR ROLL

Roster of Builders - To protect our donors from receiving unwanted solicitations and junk mail, we have discontinued printing home towns when we print names. This became necessary after we learned that certain organizations of questionable legitimacy were adding our donors to their mailing lists. As long as the home towns are not revealed, this will be extremely difficult to do. We want our donors to know that we have never permitted other organizations to use our lists of supporters, and we will continue to do everything possible to preserve their privacy.

This Honor Roll gives special recognition to generous supporters of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches and its six child-care programs: the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch,

Youth Villa, Youth Ranch/Safety Harbor, Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota, Youth Camp, and Caruth Camp. Those who give \$250 or more in cash, or \$500 or more in non-cash gifts, receive a Builder Certificate. Those who give \$2,500 or more in cash, or \$5,000 or more in non-cash gifts, receive Lifetime Honorary Membership in the Florida Sheriffs Association. A large wall plaque is awarded to each Lifetime Honorary Member, and gold stars are added when that person's total gifts reach \$5,000 (one star); \$10,000 (two stars); \$15,000 (three stars); \$20,000 (four stars); and \$25,000 (five stars). For gifts of \$50,000 or more, there is the Golden Star Award. Donors of \$100,000 or more receive the Grand Star Award.

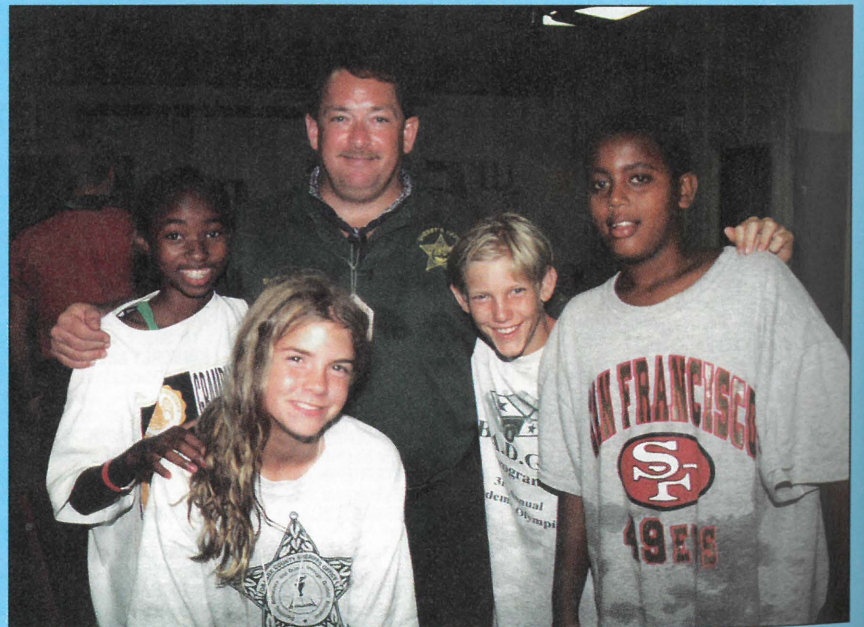


Trust is not an easy lesson to learn, especially when your world has very little of it. These girls from Orange County are breaking down barriers with one another and learning together they can accomplish great things!

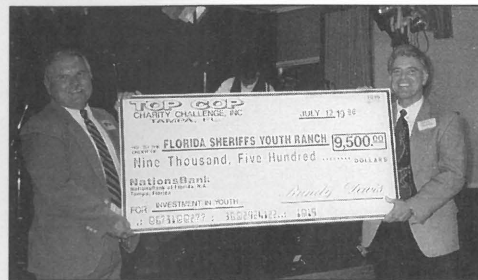
