President's Perspective

A message from Harry K. Weaver,
President of the Florida Sheriffs
Youth Ranches

I never cease to get excited about the annual Open House and Horse Show held at the Boys Ranch each year, the first full weekend in October.

This past event held on October 2, 3, and 4, 1998, was no exception. A record crowd of people, old friends, new friends, donors, families, old staff, new staff, Sheriffs, and Board members, gathered to enjoy the festivities.

Oh yes, there was a record number of horses registered for the event, too — 589 horses, to be exact.

Quite often, during Open House activities, I hear a personal and heartwarming story that has happened to one of the Boys Ranch residents or an alumnus.

I'd like to share the following inspirational story:

While I was sitting and talking with Youth Ranches friends on the banks of the beautiful and historic Suwannee



River as it lazily winds along four miles of Boys Ranch property, a Boys Ranch alumnus came to me and said, "I have someone I would like you to meet." This particular alumnus was one of three brothers who needed the Boys Ranch's help in the early 60s. Each lived at the Boys Ranch for a number of years; each graduated from Suwannee High School; and each has become productive members in their respective communities. They have all handled great personal challenges with dignity and class. Their life-long efforts have resulted in highly commendable outcomes.

I then met a sister whom the brothers had just found and never seen. Her own family attended the Open House as well as some of the family members of the brothers.

What a glorious and happy occasion for me! You can imagine what it all meant to the brothers and their newfound sister.

To our Donor Family, we say thanks again for small and large miracles. I really wish you could experience the joy first hand of such events, but you can take pride in the fact that you make it all happen with your commitment, concern and generosity. Thank you!

Presidential Update

After months of careful scrutiny, the Presidential Selection Committee has decided to recommend Roger O. Bouchard, Jr., to the Board of Directors for consideration as the next President of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. The Board of Directors' next meeting will be held on Thursday, November 19, 1998, and it is expected that action will be taken on this date regarding the Committee's recommendation.

Mr. Bouchard is currently the Vice President of Program. He was employed on July 9, 1990, as the Resident Director of the Boys Ranch. On April 1, 1992, he was promoted to his current position. Prior to coming to the Youth Ranches, Mr. Bouchard had worked in direct childcare and social services in Florida, Alabama, Hawaii, and Guam.

He possesses a Master's Degree in Social Work. His wife, Sheila, is a Social Worker for the Hamilton County Schools in Jasper. They have two sons, Gabe and Josh, who are students at the University of Florida; and a daughter, Amy, who is a sophomore at Suwannee High School.

A Florida native, Mr. Bouchard grew up in the Clearwater area, where his parents still reside.

ON THE MOVE

Since the establishment of a mobile camping unit, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has been available to help more and more needy children. With proven therapeutic camping activities like arts and crafts, initiative games and a portable Challenge Course, Project Harmony: "Takin' It To The Streets" expands the Youth Ranches' ability to reach more children in desperate need of supervision and guidance.

Bringing Kids A New "Challenge"


"Keep moving," one girl calls out to another on her team as they walk from beam to beam, balancing on heel and toe to reach the end of the Challenge Course activity. "Here, take my hand." The two girls wobble, but don't fall down. Through teamwork, trust and the support of a helping hand, they both make it to the other side of the board safely.

With only a few blocks and four pieces of wood, mobile camp counselors can create an instant "Piranha Lake" adventure, one of the same challenges campers face at both the Youth Camp and Caruth Camp. Balancing on thin, wooden planks that rest between zig-zagged blocks, and with only a limited amount of boards to work with, campers must use teamwork, communication and ingenuity to design a strategy for getting across the "dangerous" moat.

But, no matter what the location, whether it be deep in the woods and pines of a forest, or in an empty patch of grass along a neighborhood sidewalk, it is truly remarkable to witness the excitement and camaraderie which develops in underprivileged boys and girls


now more than ever.





It takes a special individual to create something from nothing. "Barely anything was growing," says Rancher Matt. "It was a great spot."

At the Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota, at-risk boys have created something from nothing. Through the leadership, ingenuity and hard work of "Pop" Jenkins and many young Ranchers, a magnificent rock garden was constructed in a barren portion of the Aurora Cottage yard. After years of patient planning and building, the special garden has become an intricate maze of cement ponds, rolling waterfalls and stone paths.

But, even with its lighthouse and waterfalls and windmill, the most unique aspect of the garden project is its participants. After all, the rock garden is an

ongoing collaboration by the boys. As new youth enter the program, they typically add their own personal "handprints" to the garden. All of the boys who pass through the doors of the Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota contribute ideas, suggestions, time and effort into improving, as well as expanding the campus garden.

"I couldn't have done this without the boys," says Pop Jenkins. "They should be proud of what they've accomplished."

The unique project has even paved the way for other smaller versions. Many of the boys have taken the initiative and started working on another rock garden only a dozen feet from the first. "We wanted

to build our own garden," says newcomer Bill. "It really gives us the chance to do something together . . . something that makes us feel like a family."

Undoubtedly, by participating in such an ambitious project, troubled boys build self-esteem, understand the value of work, and form strong relationships with their cottage parents. Today, the rock gardens stand as a monument to the dedication, diligence and sacrifice by all of the Youth Ranch boys. It will serve as inspiration for all the boys to come.

"Working on the rock garden has taught me you can accomplish what you want in life," says Israel. "It makes me feel I can achieve things I thought weren't possible."

through their participation, and ultimate completion, of such unique summer challenges.

Crafting Needy Youth Into Law-Abiding Citizens Takes Art

Helping disadvantaged boys and girls reach short-term goals increases self-esteem, builds self-confidence and boosts their opportunity to enjoy a successful, productive future. By providing simple, exciting activities like arts and crafts, youth learn to express themselves and develop their own sense of creativity. Making clay crafts, napkin rings, and paper ornaments for the Christmas tree inspire a child's imagination and oftentimes define childhood memories.

Maintaining a youngster's attention requires innovation and enthusiasm. Camp counselors are trained to establish specific guidelines and standards, but are also encouraged to allow children the freedom to paint, draw, color or construct scenes which mean the most to them. Participating in group art projects allows troubled boys and girls the opportunity to re-direct anger and sorrow, unlock new places trapped in their imagination, and experience the pleasures of creating their own personal pieces of art.

If It Ain't Broke . . .

Like the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches existing camping facilities and established programs, the mobile camping initiative follows a specific and proven activity schedule. It is segmented carefully into various recreational, environmental, and educational class periods throughout the day. The Challenge Course, environmental awareness discussions, initiative games, slip 'n slide, racial tolerance workshops, and arts and crafts are repeated daily. Special law enforcement demonstrations and field trips are also planned as healthy alternatives.

This well-designed, well-rounded set of varied activities provides the greatest encouragement and support for deserving youth. By using such a prescribed balance, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has learned the value even one week can play in the education and ultimate survival of a troubled child.

It Takes A Village . . .

It requires dedicated individuals and careful planning to help establish life-saving alternatives for disadvantaged boys and girls. Communities, concerned citizens, friends, family, donors, law enforcement officers and civic leaders often raise much-needed funds to help provide these valuable services to Florida's children.

These same caring individuals have also helped establish and expand the Project Harmony: "Takin' It To The Streets" program. By building strong partnerships between local Sheriff's Offices and community organizations like the YWCA, the Youth Ranches will continue to reach more needy children


throughout the state each summer. Alachua, Bradford, Dade and Duval counties have already embraced the goals and activities of this unique, therapeutic camping experience. The Grand Mariner Foundation and Browning Ferris Industries have also helped sponsor separate sessions during the summer.

"It's (Takin' It To The Streets) a wonderful idea," says Duval County Sheriff Nat Glover. "By bringing their (Youth Ranches) unique camping activities to these children, they are creating self-confidence and winning attitudes in youngsters that would not otherwise have an opportunity to enjoy this type of summer camp."

Preventative Medicine

Noticing the warning signs displayed by many at-risk youth is the first step toward prevention, education and intervention. The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches is dedicated to preventing delinquent behavior by providing healthy alternatives, positive role models, strong ethical standards and esteem-building activities. Initiative programs like Project Harmony: "Takin' It To The Streets" are designed to reach troubled youngsters before dangerous decisions and actions become the only option.

Through new statewide initiatives, innovative ideas and proven programs, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches continues its crusade. Perhaps, if we remain on the move, delinquency, neglect and insecurity will no longer know where to find helpless boys and girls.

Real Heroes don't wear capes, but many wear the Sheriff's Star

Many of us forget, even take for granted, the unique nature and often dangerous duties our local law enforcement officers face. At any moment, on any call, no matter how routine the infraction or situation, every day, all across the country, officers risk their lives to serve and protect citizens like you and me, strangers, yet anonymous friends.

Unfortunately, confrontations can, and oftentimes do, end in violence, even bloodshed. Too often, one of our own Deputies loses their life in the line of duty. But, when tragedies like these rock local communities, it becomes our own duty and responsibility to honor the fallen, the real heroes.

On July 8, Seminole County Deputy Sheriff Eugene A. "Stetson" Gregory was killed by a gunman after responding to a routine call regarding a dispute between a Geneva man and his landlord. Law enforcement officers, friends and family members are still in shock, and continue to mourn as well as attempt to make sense of Gregory's untimely death.

As the life and legacy left by Deputy Gregory is recalled, one special time, one special place, stands out. Several years earlier, Seminole County Sheriff Don Eslinger supported Deputy Gregory's request to attend the Florida Sheriffs

Youth Ranches Summer Camp. He served in this assignment as he had in all others, faithfully working to affect a positive change in the lives of deserving boys and girls.

After returning from Summer Camp, where the theme taught is, "Law Officers Are Your Friends," Deputy Gregory wrote this note to the Sheriff:

Dear Sheriff Eslinger,

"I wanted to thank you for giving me the opportunity to attend the Summer Youth Camp in Barberville. It was quite an experience. One I will not forget. The boys attending this camp are in need of role models, someone to spend quality time with them. A week at camp offers them a small taste of this. Hopefully, it is enough for them to consider alternatives to the path they are travelling down. Thank you again for the chance you gave me to be there for them."

Because of the impact this experience had on Deputy Gregory, his wife and family asked all memorial gifts be given to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. Additionally, a special "Memorial Benefit Ride and Barbecue" was arranged to pay tribute to Gregory's memory as well as his many accomplishments. The caravan stretched from Casselberry to Fort Mellon Park, where it ended with a barbecue and dedication ceremony. The event was sponsored by the Nam Knights Motorcycle Club, Bikers Offering Options to Bikers, and the Seminole County Sheriff's Office. It raised over \$3,000 for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches boys and girls toward the prevention of juvenile delinquency and neglect.

It is the pursuit of justice that drives them into a lifelong commitment to law enforcement. Whatever their bureau, district, or precinct; whether they are Sheriff's Deputies, Police Officers, or State Troopers, the men and women of our law enforcement communities are dedicated to serve and protect all of us.

But, it takes special individuals to realize the growing need for prevention, to seize the opportunity to stop crime and delinquency before it starts. It takes foresight and bravery to want to intervene, and implement daring initiative programs that challenge traditional thought as well as public opinion. Luckily, for the sake and citizens of Florida, daring law enforcement ambassadors had the courage to grow.

For decades, Florida's Pinellas County has been home to a special team of men - four men - four Sheriffs from different generations, with different leadership styles, but with

similar goals. Sheriffs like Don Genung, Bill Roberts, Gerry Coleman and Everett Rice have supported and even

inspired the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, and its mission to prevent juvenile delinquency and develop lawful, productive citizens through a broad range of family-centered services.

In fact, it was Sheriff Don Genung, along with Youth Ranches President Harry K. Weaver, who originally helped establish the Youth Ranch/Safety Harbor, located in Pinellas County. The inspiration for this unique residential program site was its desire to reunite broken families, allowing brothers and sisters the opportunity to remain together. Today, thanks to those four Sheriffs and the positive nature of the program, hundreds of lost children have found a home, and had the ability to work through problems with siblings by their side.

"Quite often, through the constraints of the system, many children had to be separated, and placed in different homes," remembers Sheriff Don Genung. "There was a desperate need to keep these brothers and sisters together."

But, the idea of a co-ed, residential campus was simply the unwatered seed of hope until D.A. Salls, a resident of

Clearwater, volunteered to donate a cow to the Boys Ranch. As Youth Fund President Harry K. Weaver and former Pinellas County Sheriff Don Genung visited with Mr. and Mrs. Salls over the months, one cow became three, and the skies soon opened. Sprinkle to drizzle to downpour, the seed was drowning in generosity. It was apparent the Salls were interested in supporting the Ranches vital work with neglected children and broken families.

After the Salls' entire herd of cattle found a new home at the Boys Ranch, talks continued, and it was discovered that their house was "too big" for just the two of them. In 1976, that seed of hope had sprouted into a beanstalk of opportunity when the Salls agreed to donate their house and its property to help begin a co-ed program that would reunite brothers and sisters.

"We are committed to the Youth Ranches and its service to Florida's children," says Sheriff Everett Rice. "Pinellas County will always help needy boys and girls throughout the state."
